## INTRODUCTION

The National Institute for Career Service (erstwhile Central Institute for Research and Training in Employment Service) was set up in October, 1964 under Directorate General of Employment (DGE), M/o Labour \& Employment for imparting Research \& Training in Employment Services. The Institute was later expanded in 1970 with additional function of publishing career literature and again in 1987 with added responsibility of occupational research \& promotion of self-employment. Now, the Ministry is implementing the Employment Exchange Mission Mode Project under National eGovernment plan (Ne-GP). Under this Project, NICS-NOIDA (erstwhile CIRTES), has been designated as nodal institute for capacity building under NCS project. In addition, monitoring progress of Model Career Centres and implementation of Young Professional scheme are being dealt by NICS.

## Vision

To be a National Centre of Excellence to provide enhanced employability through Training, Research \& Capacity Building Programme in the area of Employment under National Employment Services.

## Mission

- Enhancing human \& organisational excellence in Employment/ Career Service by organizing various capacity building programmes.
- Effective implementation of various schemes of National Employment Service/ National Career Service for the benefit of various stake holders.
- Monitoring \& evaluation of various schemes of National Career Service project on a sustainable basis.
- Strengthening \& improving the quality of Employment services by empowering and enhancing the capacities of the Employment Personnel with regular capacity building trainings.
- Enhanced employability through capacity building of employment/ career service personnel and developing innovative strategies for career counselling, job -matching and placement.


## Mandate

- Implementation of NCS Project and YP Scheme: NICS is also playing major role in implementing the Young Professional Scheme of M/o Labour and Employment and coordinating the activities of Model Career Center's established at various parts of country under NCS project.
- Organizing Training Programmes for Employment Officers working in various States/UTs.
- Capacity Building: As a Nodal institute for capacity building NICS is responsible for imparting training to all stakeholders of NCS project, viz. YPs, job seekers, employers, counsellors etc.
- Functioning of Model Career Centre established at NICS


## Online Capacity Building /Refresher Training Programme for Employment officers

Capacity Building is the process through which individuals, organisations obtain, strengthen and maintain the capabilities to set and achieve their own development objectives over time. Capacity Building fosters a sense of ownership and empowerment. Also it strengthen the confidence, skills and knowledge of participants of the CBP programmes. NICS, NOIDA being nodal institute for capacity building has been continuously organising Capacity Building Training programmes for Employment Personal working with Employment Exchanges of various states. During this financial year from May, 2020 to November, 2020 NICS had conducted twenty one online CBP programmes for officers of various States.

During December, 2020 NICS had conducted three CBP/ Online Refresher Training Programmes of two days duration for Employment officers, Assistant Directors etc. working with Employment Exchanges of different districts of Assam and Jharkhand states.

NICS, NOIDA had conducted two Online CBP / Refresher Training Programmes for Employment personal on "Career Advisory services during COVID-19" during 03rd-04th December 2020 and 10th-11th December, 2020 respectively. In all 44 officers i.e 22 officers from Assam and 22 officers from Jharkhand have participated in the above mentioned two programmes. Keeping in view the current ongoing pandemic situation and important role being played by NCS for career / Employment related activities the topics of the CBP programme have been kept. Topics like Career opportunities post Covid-19, Overview of NCS with latest updates, Skill Gap Training \& How to conduct online employability training, Importance of Career Counselling during COVID-19 etc have been covered in the above mentioned training programmes. Internal and external faculty of NICS have delivered lectures on above mentioned topics. during training programmes. The training programmes concluded with question and answers session followed by valedictory session. After training programmes all trainees have submitted filled in feedback forms of the training programmes. As per the feedback of the trainees the overall rating of the training programmes is $4.5 / 5$.


* NICS, NOIDA had conducted third Online CBP / Refresher Training Programmes for Employment personal on "promotion of specific activities of Public Employment System - Self Employment, Entrepreneurship \& Labour Market Analysis" during $17^{\text {th }}-18^{\text {th }}$ December 2020 December, 2020. In all 22 officers from Maharashtra have participated in the above mentioned programme. Keeping in view the importance of Self Employment and Entrepreneurship in the Employment market and to motivate job seekers towards Self Employment and entrepreneurship and also to give clear picture to the job seekers about the labour market situation in the current scenario the topics of the CBP programme have been identified and lectures of the same have been kept in the training programme. Topics like: Information Needs for Self-Employment, Recruitment Practices in Private Organization, Labour Market Analysis - Research Methodologies, Soft Skills leads to Wisdom, Self-Employment \& Entrepreneurship (Government initiatives for promoting Entrepreneurship, Government Schemes, EDP institutions, Cluster schemes \& Incubation Scheme) etc. have been covered in the above mentioned training programme. Internal and external faculty of NICS have delivered lectures on above mentioned topics during training programme. The training programme concluded with question and answers session followed by valedictory session Shri M. Peter Johnson DG(S) has given valedictory speech and interacted with trainees and enquired about the quality of training programme. Smt. M. L. Gautam Director I/C, NICS, Sh. R. Aswanikumar, Joint Director, NICS and Sh. M.S Ashok Kumar, Joint Director, NICS also participated in the valedictory session. After training programme all trainees have submitted filled in feedback forms of the training programmes. As per the feedback of the trainees the overall rating of the training programme was 4.5 out of 5 .



## Career Guidance/ Counselling for Jobseekers

One of the important activities of Model Career Centres (MCCs) which are established under NCS project is to provide Career Guidance / Counselling Services to the Job Seekers unemployed youth and Students. The importance of career Counselling /guidance is to provide the right information to job-seekers at right time to enable them to properly use their time for preparing for taking up a vocation as per their skills and qualification. Also these guidance and counselling services are very much useful for identifying the skills which are in demand in the market and to upgrade their skills accordingly by attending skill gap training programmes. MCC located at NICS has been organising various Career Guidance / Counselling programmes for the benefit of job seekers registered with NCS portal.

## Online psychometric testing and counselling Workshop for Jobseekers

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4 (NICS), DGE, Ministry of Labour and Employment, has organised Online psychometric testing and counselling for NCS portal registered Students/ Jobseekers on various career related information via telephonic and WhatsApp call/Chat (through Digital/ Online Mode) from $07^{\text {th }}$ to $17^{\text {th }}$ Dec. 2020. Around 32 Candidates participated in different mode of counselling and many of them undergone psychometric testing (Interest profiler and 16-personalities) and shared their Score, on the basis of test scores, followed by an hour long discussion and counselling. Interpretation was done and participants were able to identify their probable career prospect according to their personality type, interest and job zones.
