INTRODUCTION

The National Institute for Career Service (erstwhile Central Institute for Research and Training in Employment Service) was set up in October, 1964 under Directorate General of Employment (DGE), M/o Labour & Employment for imparting Research & Training in Employment Services. The Institute was later expanded in 1970 with additional function of publishing career literature and again in 1987 with added responsibility of occupational research & promotion of self-employment. Now, the Ministry is implementing the Employment Exchange Mission Mode Project under National e-Government plan (Ne-GP). Under this Project, NICS-NOIDA (erstwhile CIRTES), has been designated as nodal institute for capacity building under NCS project. In addition, monitoring progress of Model Career Centres and implementation of Young Professional scheme are being dealt by NICS.

VISION

To be a National Centre of Excellence to provide enhanced employability through Training, Research & Capacity Building Programme in the area of Employment under National Employment Services.

MISSION

Enhancing human & organisational excellence in Employment/ Career Service by organizing various capacity building programmes.

Effective implementation of various schemes of National Employment Service/ National Career Service for the benefit of various stake holders.

Monitoring & evaluation of various schemes of National Career Service project on a sustainable basis.

Strengthening & improving the quality of Employment services by empowering and enhancing the capacities of the Employment Personnel with regular capacity building trainings.

Enhanced employability through capacity building of employment/ career service personnel and developing innovative strategies for career counselling, job –matching and placement.

Model Career Centre, National Institute for Career Service (NICS), DGE, Ministry of Labour and Employment, organised an Offline Group orientation for jobseekers on 7th July 2022. The field visit was done at Sun Foundation, World Class Skill Centre, (affiliated & accredited by NSDC & SSC) located at ITI Campus, Block EC, Maya Enclave, Hari Nagar, New Delhi. The foundation established in 1998 is engaged in providing skill development for various job roles free of cost.

More than 150+ students who are currently enrolled in various diploma courses such as Fashion Designing, Interior Designing, Field Engineering, Data Entry Operator, Graphic Designing at World Class Skill Centre participated in the event.

Many new candidates were registered at the portal. Interested candidates with relevant skill sets were encouraged to apply for and attend job fair to be held at NICS Noida on 8th July 2022. The session lasted up to two hours & all queries were resolved and relevant information to jobseekers and their teachers was imparted.

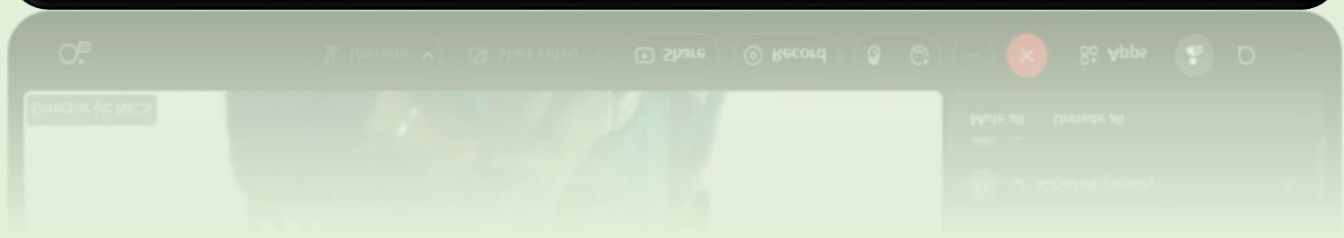
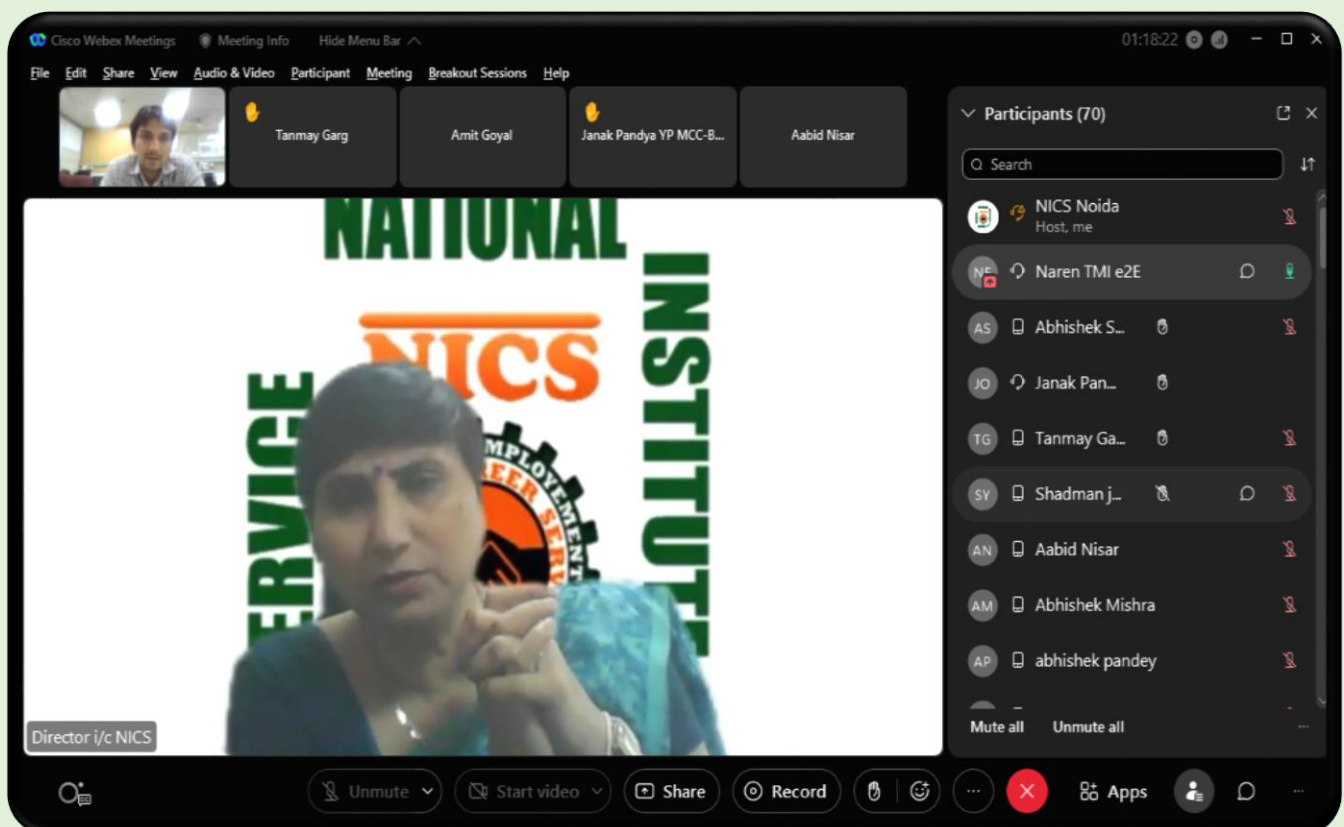

Training on Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maan-dhan (PM- SYM) for Young Professionals – 14th July, 2022

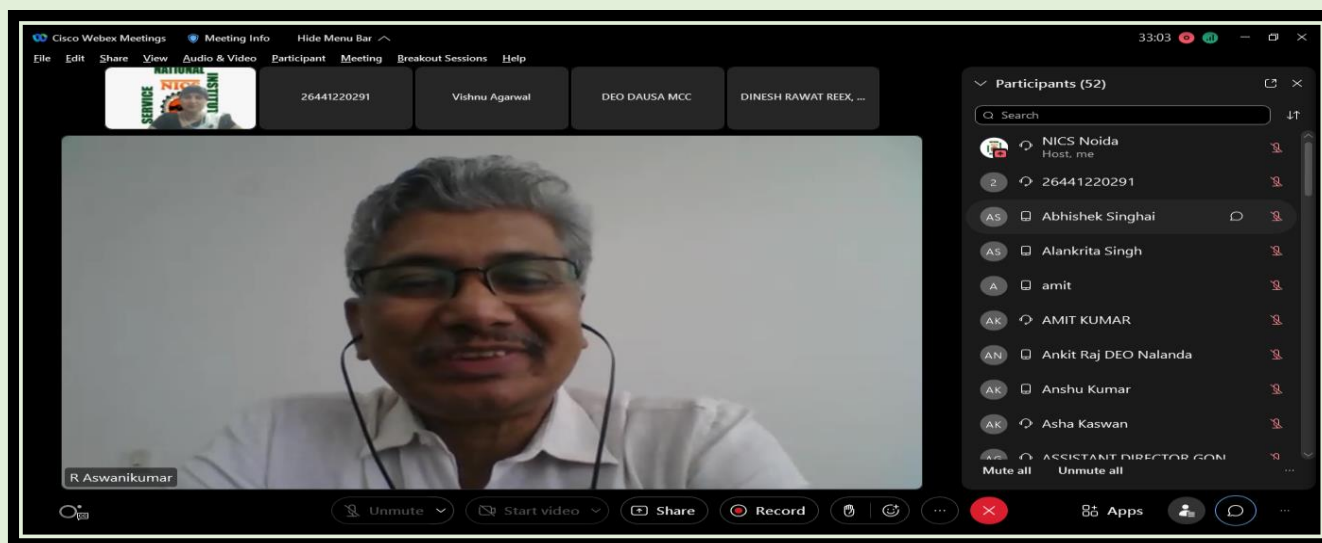
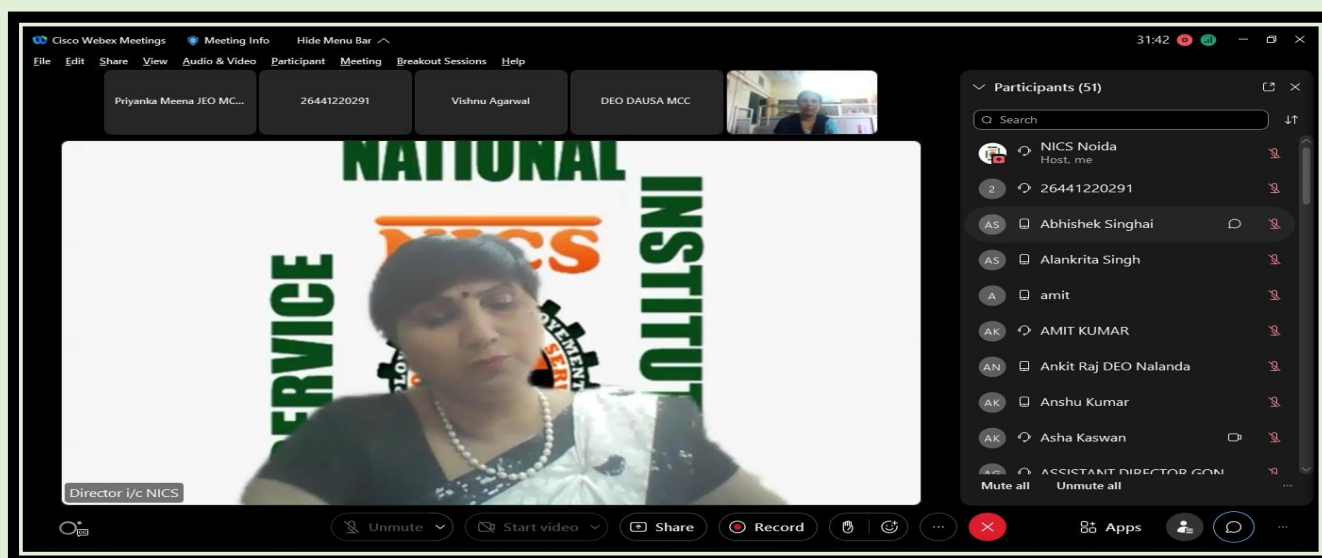
National Institute for Career Service organised a training programme on Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maandhan (PM-SYM) for the newly recruited Young Professionals on 14th July, 2022. Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maandhan (PM-SYM) is a government scheme meant for old age protection and social security of unorganized workers.

The unorganised workers mostly engaged as home based workers, street vendors, mid-day meal workers, head loaders, brick kiln workers, cobblers, rag pickers, domestic workers, washer men, rickshaw pullers, landless labourers, own account workers, agricultural workers, construction workers, beedi workers, handloom workers, leather workers, audio-visual workers and similar other occupations whose monthly income is Rs. 15,000/ per month or less and belong to the entry age group of 18-40 years. They should not be covered under New Pension Scheme (NPS), Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) scheme or Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO). Further, he/she should not be an income tax payer.

Around 78 Young Professionals participated in the training programme.

Online Training Programme for Nodal Officers / Centre Managers on ‘NCS Portal Management & Latest Development’ – 28th July, 2022

National Institute for Career Service organised an Online Training Programme for Nodal Officers/Centre Managers on ‘NCS Portal Management & Latest Development’ on 28th July, 2022. NCSP Management training programme is an attempt to equip all the employment exchange officers with the working knowledge of NCS portal and how this portal can transform the employment services in our country. RECRUITMENT OF YOUNG PROFESSIONALS (11th July, 2022 – 15th July, 2022)

The Ministry of Labour and Employment, Govt. of India, under the Mission Mode Project implemented the National Career Service (NCS) Project for revamping public employment related services. For smooth transformation of these services, Model Career Centres (MCCs) have been set up to provide standardized employment services across the nation. In order to make these MCCs effectively functional, a 'Young Professional Scheme' was launched by Directorate General for Employment (DGE) with an aim to transform the emerging landscape of Employment Services and Career Counselling in India. For Effective functioning of Model Career Centres one Young Professional is being posted at each Model Career Centres located at various parts of the country.



Keeping in view the existing staffing pattern at the Employment Exchanges (EEXs), it was felt that for operationalization of these Model Career Centres, professional manpower would be required to assist in carrying out NCS related activities and to infuse fresh perspective and professionalism in the working environment. Thus, a 'Young Professional Scheme' on the lines of erstwhile Planning Commission, was launched by Directorate General for Employment (DGE) with an aim to utilize the knowledge, energy and fresh way of thinking of these young social leaders to help better transform the emerging landscape of Employment Services and Career Counselling in India.

In this regard, National Institute for Career Services, Noida organized the 7th recruitment drive from 11th July, 2022 to 15th July, 2022.
