National Career Service is a Mission Mode Project launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on 20th July, 2015. It is a one-stop solution that provides a wide array of employment and career related services to the citizens of India. National Career Service is a vibrant platform which aims to transform and strengthen the public employment services in the country. It brings together Job Seekers, Employers, Skill Providers, Career Counsellors, Local Service Providers (LSP's), Career Centers, Placement Organizations, Households and Government Departments on a common platform through the efficient use of information technology.

- Easy accessibility of employment services like staffing, placement and recruitment to all the stakeholders
- Enhancing employability of the workforce by providing them information on training & skilling
- Provisioning of career counselling services
- NCS Portal provides links to Public Disclosure of scores and ranking of candidates in Government recruitment examinations
- Providing information related to job profiles, career paths & employers
- PAN verified institutions and rich database of job seekers
- Career planning and rich career content on over 3500 occupations across 52 sectors
- NCS has partnerships with various private organizations like TCS iON, Qess Corp, HireMee, CSCs, Microsoft etc.
- Around 200 Model Career Centers (MCCs) have been set up across the country till now
- National Career Service Centers for Differently Abled (NCSCs-DA) are being run by DGE across the country
- National Career Service Centers for SCs and STs (NCSC – SCs/STs) for providing employment related training and guidance are also being run by DGE

As on 31st January, 2022, a total of 1,36,69,826 active jobseekers are registered on the NCS Portal. More than 1,78,500 employers are registered on the Portal and the active vacancies count as of the mentioned date is 1,17,764.

***Please be aware that NCS does not charge any fees for Registration on the Portal and its services.**

NCS Portal is undergoing continuous enhancement of its user interface for best utilization of its Online Services and for better user experience. In the month of December, 2021 some key enhancements have been made in the Portal features for the Jobseeker type Users.

For Jobseekers with Incomplete Profiles

Incomplete Profile Pop-up has been added to the profiles of jobseeker type users with incomplete NCS profiles, which will pop up immediately after they login on to the NCS Portal. As shown in the example below, the incomplete Profile Pop-up will show all those fields (like UID Type, UID Number, Date of birth, Educational Qualification, Employment status etc.) that are considered mandatory for NCS Profile completion but have been left incomplete by the jobseeker user at the time of registration on the NCS Portal.



This feature enhancement has been done to ensure that jobseeker users have complete NCS Profiles which in turn will enable NCS Portal to show them relevant jobs in their job searches and send them relevant job recommendations. This feature enhancement will also ensure that the jobseekers get picked up by the Employers with relevant job openings.

As part of its constant ongoing efforts to enrich its database of registered Jobseekers, NCS has done some major integrations in the month of Jan'22.

National Career Service has taken a remarkable leap by integrating with National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC). Under this integration, NSDC certified skilled candidates will get automatically registered on NCS Portal through API integration. The auto-registration process of NSDC candidates on NCS Portal will also include sharing of their NSDC training certifications (like that of PMKVY and other major schemes) under their NCS Profile. Therefore, for any NCS-NSDC jobseeker, Employer will be able to view his NSDC certificate under the jobseeker profile (under the Other Certificates section) against the posted job.

Benefit: The integration will not only help in enhancing job seeker database on NCS Portal but this will also help Employers in better screening of the jobseekers against the posted jobs.

Upcoming Integration: NCS Integration with e-SHRAM

National Career Service is soon integrating with e-SHRAM Portal to help providing jobs to unorganized sector workers and laborers who are registered on e-SHRAM Portal. Under this integration, the registration process on NCS Portal for candidates who are already registered under e-SHRAM Portal will be easier and they will not have to fill any separate registration form. The e-SHRAM candidate will only need to enter his e-SHRAM UAN under registration form of NCS Portal and all the details that are linked with his UAN on e-SHRAM Portal will get auto fill on NCS Portal under his registration form.

National Career Service has been constantly advancing its services to cater to the needs of diverse mix of Employers, Jobseekers and other stakeholders on its Portal. NCS Portal has also been undergoing continuous enhancement of its user interface for best utilization of its Online Services. Below timeline graph shows the major milestones achieved by National Career Service Scheme in different quarters of the calendar year 2021.

- NCS has created separate Jobs Dashboard for each sub-user registered under any particular Employer type user. This has been done to help the sub-user to track the status and manage responses of the jobs posted by him without any mixing with jobs that are posted by other subusers.


Key Portal Enhancements

- A Skill Provider user can now also register itself under Organization Type "Government".
- Provision of Self-activation of NCS account for all NCS Users
- A Career Center user can now download list of participants who participated through NCS Portal in its online job fairs.

Key Portal Enhancements

- Special window has been added on the NCS Portal so that employers (Private and Government) can find relevant jobseekers/professionals in the healthcare sector such as Doctors, Nurses, Ayush Practitioners, etc. based on the key skills and education qualifications. It also helps the jobseekers to search for relevant vacancies in the healthcare sector.
- Incomplete Profile Pop-up has been added to the profiles of jobseeker type users with incomplete NCS profiles, which will pop up immediately after they login on the NCS Portal.

Quarter wise New Jobseeker Registrations in Calendar Year 2021





Above graph shows the trend of New Jobseeker Registrations across different quarters in the calendar year 2021. The graph clearly shows a surge in the count of new jobseeker registrations from 2nd quarter onwards.

The increase is attributed to the registration of jobseekers (mostly with healthcare profile) in large numbers from other job Portals like Naukri.com, Skill India Portal, Freshersworld.com, timesjobs.com. These registrations have been done through API Integration with the mentioned job Portals to create a dedicated health care workforce on NCS Portal with the objective of facilitating "Easy Access, Outreach, Shortlisting and Selection" of Health Care Workforce by an Employer user. This is an initiative by Ministry of Labour and Employment towards COVID-19 resource augmentation. This data can be accessed by Employer users through a special window named "Human Resources for Health Sector" that has been added on Home Page of NCS Portal. Other major contributors towards higher count of jobseeker registrations in the last two quarters of the calendar year 2021 are Career Centers and Live Registrations.

Above graph shows an increasing trend of total vacancies mobilized on NCS Portal across different quarters of the calendar year 2021. As shown in the graph, total vacancies count was higher in the last two quarters and a good number of these vacancies got mobilized on NCS Portal through online job fairs. This indicates that a good number of Employers are taking Portal support for filling their open positions through online Job Fairs.

India holds an important place in the global education industry. India has one of the largest networks of higher education institutions in the world. With ~26.31% of India's population in the age group of 0-14 years, India's education sector provides numerous opportunities for growth. India has over




school going students, more than any other country. It also has one of the largest networks of higher education institutions in the world. Number of colleges in India reached 39,931 in FY19. The number of universities in India reached 1,014 in FY22 (until October 2021), up from 760 in FY15. As of May 17, 2021, number of universities in India reached 988.

Hence, it is clear that Education sector in India remains to be a strategic priority for the Government. The Government has allowed 100% Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in the education sector through the automatic route since 2002.

The Cabinet chaired by the Prime Minister, Mr. Narendra Modi approved the National Education Policy 2020, making way for large scale, transformational reforms in both school and higher education sectors. The policy is built on foundational pillars of Access, Equity, Quality, Affordability and Accountability, and is aligned with the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. As a result, development and recruitment of trained human resource has increasingly gained significance in strengthening the education sector. **(Source: India Brand Equity Foundation, www.ibef.org)**


With continuous growth in this sector, its manpower requirement is also increasing. Around 3.2 lakh of total vacancies from Education sector have been reported to be mobilized on NCS Portal since the Project Inception till 31st January, 2022. Also, the count of Active vacancies on NCS Portal is high for jobs related to Education sector and is found to be nearly 4900 as on 31st January, 2022. The Bar graph shows some of the top Job Titles in Education sector against which maximum job vacancies have been mobilized on the NCS Portal (since inception) by its registered Employers. It can be seen that requirement of Teachers is maximum in the Education sector followed by Tuition Teacher, Computer Teacher and Guest Faculty. This is an insightful graph for jobseekers who are planning their careers in Education Sector.

The Bar graph shows some of the top Job Titles in Education sector against which maximum job vacancies have been mobilized on the NCS Portal by its registered Employers in the calendar year 2021. With rapidly transforming education scenario and Digitalization of services, the requirement of Computer Teachers has increased. As shown in the above graph, requirement of Computer Teachers has been maximum in the Education sector followed by Guest Faculty, Teacher, Admission Counsellor and Academic Mentor.

Amid the COVID-19 Pandemic, NCS has been continuously working to provide employment and career related services to its registered users. On one hand, NCS has been using its online Platform to conduct online Job Fairs & Career Events and on the other hand its wide network of Model Career Centers is also conducting on ground career events. Glimpses of some of the major Career Events and Job Fairs in Jan, 2022 are listed below:

Job Fairs and Career Events: January, 2022

Series of Career events by Model Career Center, DE&CC, Baramulla, Jammu and Kashmir

Model Career Center, DE&CC, Baramulla, Jammu and Kashmir organized a series of career events on 5th January, 2022, 6th January, 2022 and 27th January, 2022. The career seminar on 5th January, 2022 was conducted in collaboration with Nehru Yuva Kendra to create awareness around Self-Employment schemes and Skill Development Programs. More than 70 candidates participated in this session. Model Career Center, DE&CC, Baramulla organized its 2nd career event through online mode on 8th January, 2022 to create awareness around NCS Portal and Startup India in which around 30 candidates participated. The Center organized its 3rd career event through online mode for candidates of ITI Sopore, Baramulla on 27th January, 2022 in which around 50 candidates participated.

Series of Online Training Programs for Employment Personnel by National Institute for Career Service (NICS), Noida

NICS, Noida organized a series of 2 online refresher training programs on 6th- 7th January, 2022 and 27th – 28th January, 2022 for Employment Personnel from states of Kerala and Andhra Pradesh in which around 40 Employment staff participated in total. The training program was addressed by Smt. M. L. Gautam, Director I/C, NICS, Sh. R. Aswani Kumar, Joint Director, NICS, Mrs. Kanta, ADE, NICS, Smt Jayanti Negi, Young Professional. The session majorly covered valuable information on the topics like “Latest updates on NCS Portal”, “Career Counselling Psychological Aid”, “How to conduct online Job Fairs using NCS Portal”, “Recruitment Practices in Private organizations” etc.

Job Fair by Model Career Center, Agartala, West Tripura

Model Career Center, Agartala (District Employment Exchange, Agartala, West Tripura) organized a Job Fair at its premises on 7th January 2022. Hon'ble Minister, Department of Labour (Employment), Welfare of Scheduled Castes, ARD, Govt. of Tripura, Shri Bhagaban Chandra Das, inaugurated the Job Fair along with other dignitaries. Around 9 Employers (2 from outside Tripura & 7 Tripura based Private Employers) participated in this Job Fair to fill around 400 job vacancies for varied job roles. Total 453 candidates participated in the Job Fair and 131 candidates got shortlisted for the next round of recruitment.

Placement Drive by Model Career Center, District Employment Exchange, Tumkur, Karnataka

Model Career Center, District Employment Exchange, Tumkur conducted a Placement Drive on 11th January, 2022. The Placement Drive was organized for various job roles like that of Software Developer, Management Trainee, System Administrator, AutoCAD Engineer for candidates with qualification, Diploma in Civil, E&C etc.. Around 60 candidates participated in the Placement Drive & around 20 candidates got shortlisted for the final round of selection to happen soon.

Placement Drive by Model Career Center, Kanker, Chhattisgarh

Model Career Center, District Employment Exchange, Kanker conducted a Placement Drive on 19th January, 2022. The Placement Drive was organized for job roles like that of Loan Officer and Security Guard for candidates with qualification 8th pass and 12th pass. Around 40 candidates participated in the Placement Drive & around 30 candidates got shortlisted for the final round of selection to happen soon.

रोजगार के अवसर • बेरोजगारों के लिए आईटी लैब में लगेंगे 22 कंप्यूटर, नेशनल कैरिअर सर्विस के माध्यम से ले सकेंगे निशुल्क प्रशिक्षण मॉडल कैरिअर सेंटर के रूप में तैयार होगा जिला रोजगार कार्यालय, काउंसिलिंग के लिए 15 लाख की लागत से बनेगी हाइटेक आईटी लैब

जिले के बेरोजगार युवाओं को रोजगार से जोड़ने के लिए अब जिला रोजगार केंद्र को मॉडल कैरिअर सेंटर रूप में तैयार किया जा रहा है। यहां जिले के करीब 92 हजार से अधिक बेरोजगार युवाओं को ऑनलाइन सीधे कंपनी से मिलाया जाएगा। इसके लिए श्रम विभाग द्वारा नेशनल कैरिअर सर्विस (एनसीएस) के माध्यम से पोर्टल तैयार किया गया है। यहां नियुक्त यंग प्रोफेशनल्स द्वारा बेरोजगार युवाओं को पोर्टल पर रजिस्टर किया जाएगा। इसके बाद पंजीकृत युवा एनसीएस पर पंजीकृत कंपनियों को अपनी बायोडाटा भेज कर कंपनी से सीधे ऑनलाइन संवाद कर सकेंगे। इतना ही नहीं, पोर्टल पर पूरे देश की प्राइवेट कंपनियां पंजीकृत होने के कारण जिले का बेरोजगार प्रदेश से बाहर दूसरे राज्यों की

युवा पोर्टल पर दस्तावेज भी कर सकेंगे सिवयोर

बेरोजगार युवाओं को आवेदन करने में समस्या न हो, इसके लिए एनसीएस पोर्टल पर उन्हें अपने दस्तावेज अपलोड करने की भी सुविधा मिलेगी। ताकि बेरोजगार युवा पोर्टल को शुरू करते ही कहीं से भी कंपनी में आवेदन कर दस्तावेजों की सॉफ्ट कॉपी व बायोडाटा सीधे कंपनी को भेज सकेंगे। इससे बेरोजगारों को बार बार दस्तावेज को साथ रखने की जरूरत नहीं होगी।

कंपनियों में भी आवेदन कर सकेंगे। आवेदन करने की सुविधा भी सेंटर पर निशुल्क उपलब्ध करवाई जाएगी। इसके लिए सरकार द्वारा करीब 15 लाख की लागत से हाइटेक आईटी लैब का भी निर्माण करवाया जाएगा। यहां बेरोजगारों को निशुल्क आवेदन करने की सुविधा

एनसीएस द्वारा बेरोजगार युवाओं और कंपनियों के प्रतिनिधि को एक मंच दिया जाता है। ताकि कंपनी आवेदक का ऑनलाइन इंटरव्यू ले सके। सेंटर पर युवाओं को काउंसिलिंग व हाइटेक लैब तक की सुविधा उपलब्ध होगी।
