It is a one-stop solution that provides a wide array of employment and career related services to the citizens of India. National Career Service is a vibrant platform which aims to transform and strengthen the public employment services in the country. It brings together Job Seekers, Employers, Skill Providers, Career Counsellors, Local Service Providers (LSP's), Career Centers, Placement Organizations, Households and Government Departments on a common platform through the efficient use of information technology.

- Easy accessibility of employment services like staffing, placement and recruitment to all the stakeholders
- Enhancing employability of the workforce by providing them information on training & skilling
- Provisioning of career counselling services
- NCS Portal provides links to Public Disclosure of scores and ranking of candidates in Government recruitment examinations
- Providing information related to job profiles, career paths & employers
- PAN verified institutions and rich database of job seekers

- NCS has partnerships with various private organizations like TCS iON, Qess Corp, HireMee, CSCs etc.

- National Career Service Centers for SCs and STs (NCSC – SCs/STs) for providing employment related training and guidance are also being run by DGE


As on 30th June, 2021, a total of 98,43,838 active jobseekers are registered on the NCS Portal. More than 1,50,800 employers are registered on the Portal and the active vacancies count as of the mentioned date is 1,26,315.

***Please be aware that NCS does not charge any fees for Registration on the Portal and its services.**

NCS Portal is undergoing continuous enhancement of its user interface for best utilization of its Online Services and for better user experience. Some of the key enhancements made in the Portal features in June'2021 have been shared below.

1 For all Stakeholders

NCS users can now Reactivate NCS account on their own once their account is deactivated on NCS Portal. Functionality to Reactivate Account is available on Home Page of NCS Portal, upon clicking which user has to provide some basic details (of self in case of Jobseeker type of Users or of organization in case of Employer type of users) and undergo OTP based mobile verification. Upon successful OTP verification, user account gets reactivated.


2 For Career Center User

A Career Center user can now download list of participants who participated through NCS Portal in its online Job Fairs. For doing so, a Career Center user needs to visit left navigation panel on its login screen. On the left navigation panel, Career Center User needs to click on “View Job Fairs” under Job Fair management and then click on the Download icon against the concerned job fair. The downloaded list will have key details of participants like Mobile number, Email id, Highest Education Qualification, Date of Birth, Address etc. The list can be downloaded any time for reference even after the completion of Job Fair.



3 For Skill Provider User

While registering on NCS Portal, a Skill Provider can now also register with the Organization Type as “Government”, while earlier it could register itself under Organization type “Private” and “Autonomous” only. For registration under Organization type “Government”, the Skill Provider needs to fill TAN number under Identity Information section while filling online registration form on NCS Portal. Once the registration form is submitted, it will undergo verification and approval process by DGET admin.

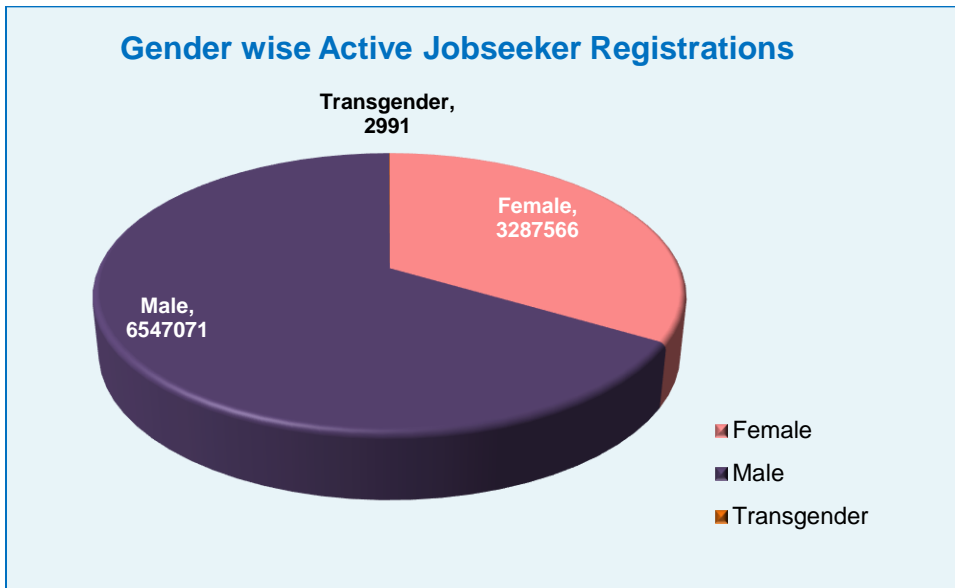

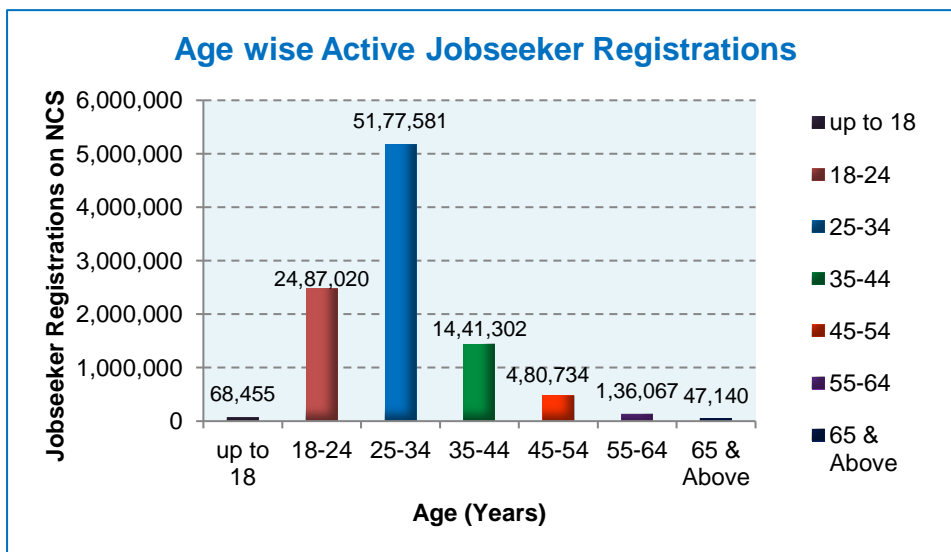
Jobseekers Distribution

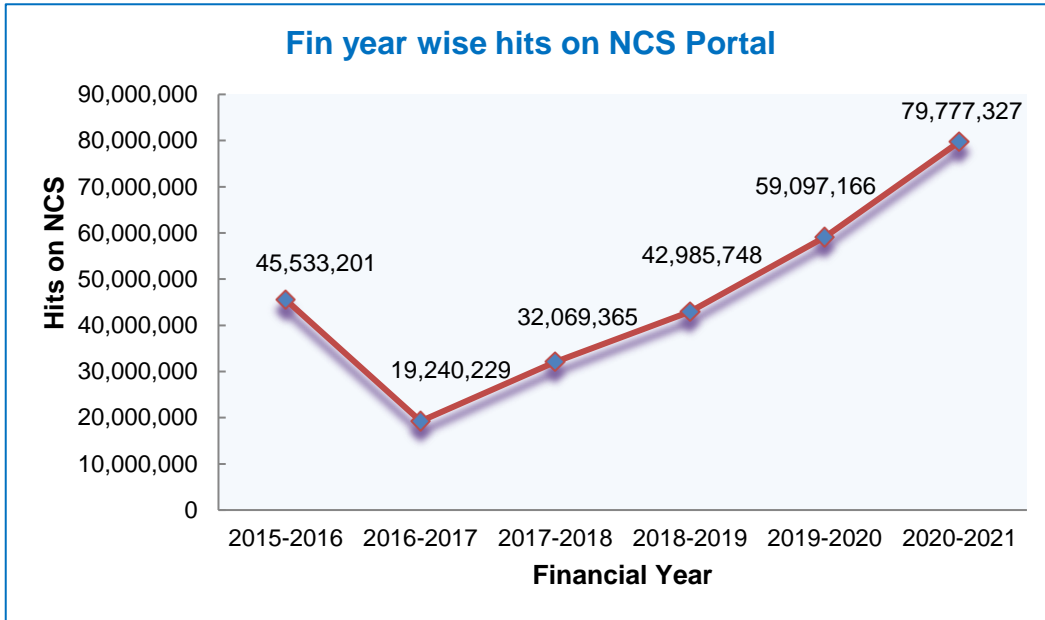
The graph shows the gender wise active jobseeker registrations on NCS Portal. This information will help the employers understand the Portal utility in meeting their gender specific manpower requirements. It can be seen in the graph that more than 32.8 lakhs of Jobseekers registered on Portal are females.

The graph shows the active jobseeker registrations on NCS Portal across different age groups. Figures show more than 24.8 lakhs and more than 51.7 lakhs Jobseekers in the age group of 18 to 24 and 25 to 34 years respectively are registered on the Portal which are the primary working age groups that most Employers seek for meeting majority of their job positions. Jobseekers in age group 35 to 44 who are usually considered for middle and higher management roles are also registered in good numbers of more than 14 lakhs.

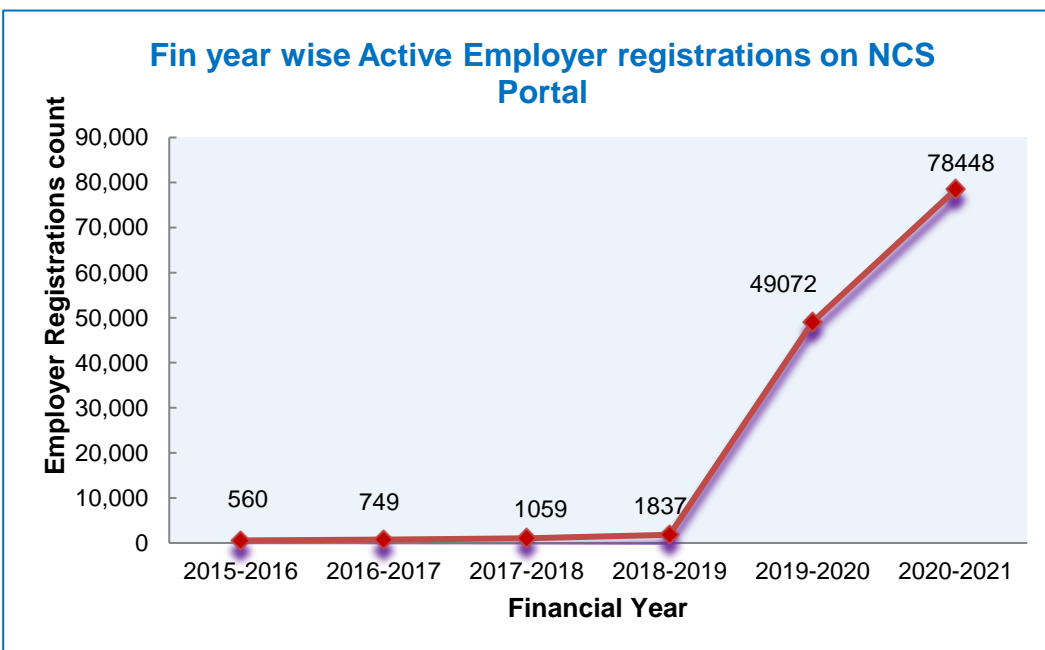

Online Training Programs and many other online career services) on NCS Portal in last 2 years, NCS Portal has witnessed increasing trend in number of hits by its users, which is indicative of growing utilization of NCS Portal by its stakeholders.



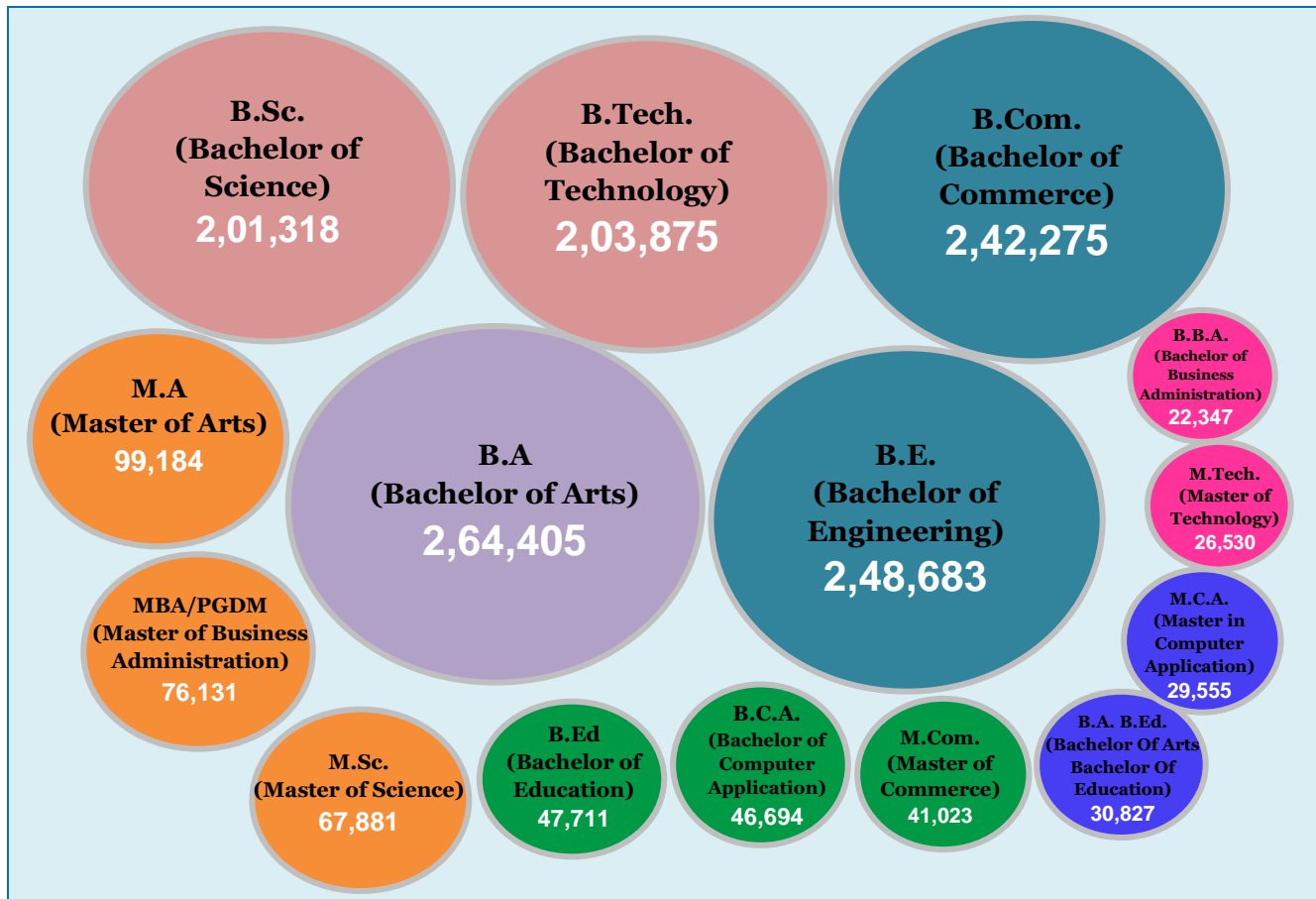

Graph shows the increase in the number of Employer registrations in the last 5 financial years since inception of the Project. It can be seen that increase in Employer Registrations is more during 2019-2021 as a result of number of initiatives taken under NCS scheme. Some of the key initiatives taken were introduction of Online Job Fairs on Portal which really helped the Employers to continue with their hiring activity even during Pandemic, NCS integrated

with EPFO and ESIC Portals in the year 2020 and year 2021 respectively. Apart from these, NCS also integrated with AICTE and AISHE affiliated colleges in the year 2019 to register their passed out students on Portal which attracted good number of Employer registrations on the Portal.

NCS offers a rich pool of graduate and post graduate candidates. Above Bubble graph shows some of the top education streams against which maximum Graduate and Post Graduate jobseekers are registered on NCS Portal. It can be seen in the above infographic that more than 2.6 lakhs of Jobseekers registered on NCS Portal are graduates from B.A stream and more than 2.4 lakhs of jobseekers on Portal are graduates from Bachelor of Engineering. Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Technology graduates are also found to be registered on NCS in good numbers of above 2 lakhs each. Similarly, graph shows jobseeker registrations count as of the mentioned date against other graduate and post graduate education streams. Employers who are looking for qualified graduate and post graduate candidates from particular education streams may refer this infographic to get a broad idea about the Portal utility in meeting their manpower requirements of qualified professionals.

Amid the COVID-19 Pandemic, NCS has been continuously working to provide employment and career related services to its registered users. On one hand, NCS has been using its online Platform to conduct online Job Fairs & Career Events and on the other hand its wide network of Model Career Centers is also conducting on ground career events as and when feasible in the current pandemic situation. Glimpses of some of the major Career Events and Job Fairs are listed below:

Youth Employability Training cum Placement Program by Model Career Center, Tumkur, Karnataka

Model Career Center, Tumkur, Karnataka in collaboration with TCS is conducting online classes for its first batch of Youth Employability Training Program that started late in May, 2021 month. The Center started its operations in February, 2021 under the National Career Service scheme and since then it has been conducting various career programs from time to time. This time the center is conducting 100 hours of online Youth Employability Training program for candidates below the age of 28 years, from SC/ST/OBC and economically weaker sections of the society, who have passed out in the year 2019-2020, 2020-21, 2021-22 from Arts, Commerce & Science streams (B.A, B.SC, B.Com, BBA, BBM, and BCA etc.,). The training program covers imparting the knowledge of Soft skills (General etiquettes) and hard skills (English, Mathematics, Analytical skills & Computer skills). The program also intends to guide the youth for internal as well as external job opportunities. On successful completion of the training, trainees will receive a digital certificate of participation and completion from TCS which will stand as a testimony and accreditation of their employability prospects in the corporate world. More than 80 candidates have been registered for the program and the program is expected to culminate on 27th July, 2021.

Closing Ceremony of Youth Employability Training Program by Model Career Center, Ferozpur, Punjab

Model Career Center, Ferozpur, Punjab organized Closing ceremony for Youth Employability Training Programme on 3rd June, 2021. The Program started in April'21 month with a batch of around 20 candidates below the age of 28 years, from SC/ST/OBC and economically backward classes who have passed out in the year 2019-2021 from B.A. and B.Com streams. The Program covered teaching Communicative English, Corporate etiquettes and soft skills, resume building and interview facing skills, analytical and reasoning skills, basic computer knowledge.

Series of free career webinars by Model Career Center, Ahmedabad, Gujarat

Model Career Center, Ahmedabad has been actively organizing career webinars and job fairs to help youth with their career queries in these uncertain times of global Pandemic. Topics that are picked for these webinars are usually very useful and are based on the trending queries and concerns of the students. In the month of June, 2021 also the center organized a series of career webinars. On 4th June, 2021, the center organized 2 separate webinar sessions on topics "Career in Healthcare Sector" and "Career in Psychology Sector" for graduate candidates. Around 39 and 37 candidates participated in the respective sessions that were addressed by industry experts.

Free Career webinar on Career Opportunities after ITI by Model Career Center, Banswara, Rajasthan

Model Career Center, Banswara organized a webinar on Career Opportunities & NCS Portal awareness on 5th June, 2021 for ITI students. The webinar covered discussion around points like various career opportunities that are available after completing ITI, various career and employment services that are offered by NCS scheme that is being run by Ministry of Labour and Employment, GOI. The webinar also laid emphasis on the importance of effective resume and soft skills for getting a good job and for career progression. Around 27 candidates participated in this session and found it very interactive and useful.

Online Job Fair by Model Career Center, Ayodhya (Faizabad), Uttar Pradesh

Model Career Center, Regional Employment Office, Ayodhya (Faizabad), U.P organized online Job Fair for 10th pass, 12th pass and Graduate pass candidates in the age group of 18-35 years on 9th June, 2021. The Job Fair was organized for around 12 companies for various job roles like Sales, Marketing, Computer Operator, HR Executive, Executive Manager, Security Guard etc. Some of the leading companies that participated in the job fair were Kalyani Solar Power, Arctic Industries etc. More than 1300 candidates participated in the Job Fair and around 90 candidates have been shortlisted so far. For few of the participating companies' initial shortlisting process is still going on and final selection numbers are yet to be announced for most of the companies as interview process is going on.

Online Job Fair conducted by Model Career Center, Gonda, Uttar Pradesh

Model Career Center, Gonda, Uttar Pradesh organized an online Job Fair through NCS Portal, on 15th June, 2021 for 12th pass, ITI and Graduate candidates. Around 10 companies participated in the online Job Fair for hiring candidates under varied Job roles like Sales officer, Business Development Executive, Computer Operator, Administration Executive, Customer Support Associate etc. Around 1200 candidates participated in the Job Fair and submitted their job applications with multiple companies. The initial screening and shortlisting of candidates happened in online mode only and more than 150 candidates got shortlisted. Companies are still working on completing their recruitment process and are yet to come up with the final selection/hiring count of candidates.

Online Career Counselling session by Model Career Center, Baramulla, Jammu and Kashmir

Using its country wide network of Model Career Centers and with its online services, National Career Service is trying to benefit youth in every nook and corner of the country. NCS scheme has one of its Model Career Centers situated at Baramulla district of Jammu and Kashmir that organize career events and programs from time to time for the youth of Jammu and Kashmir. On 16th June, 2021, the Center organized an online Counselling and NCS Portal awareness session for the students of Government Higher Secondary Girls School, Baramulla. Around 40 students participated in the session and learned about various career avenues available after schooling. They also learned about the various career services offered by National Career Service Scheme, which is a mission mode project of Ministry of Labour and Employment, GOI.

National Institute for Career Service (NICS), Noida organized Online Training Program for officers of NCSCs for SC/ST

NICS, Noida organised online training programme for officers of NCSCs for SC/ST (CGC) on “Self Employment & Entrepreneurship Development” on 28th and 29th June, 2021. In total, around 30 officers from different NCSCs-SC/ST (CGC) situated across India participated in this training programme that was addressed by Smt. M. L. Gautam, Director I/C, NICS, Sh. R. Aswani Kumar, Joint Director, NICS and Sh. Sudhir Agarwal, Director-Business Development-Government and Education, Microsoft. The session majorly covered valuable information on the topics like “Latest updates of NCS Portal”, “Recruitment Practices in Private Organizations”, “Soft Skills leads to Wisdom”, “Self-Employment & Entrepreneurship”, “MSME & Employment Generation” etc.

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साइबर सिक्योरिटी प्रोफेशनल्स की बढ़ी डिमांड

साइबर सिक्योरिटी में सुरक्षा उपायों एवं करियर मार्गदर्शन पर वेबीनार सम्पन्न

जिला रोजगार कार्यालय की ओर से साइबरस्पेश, सायबर सिक्योरिटी से सुरक्षा उपायों व इसके करियर अवसरों पर मार्गदर्शन विषयक वेबीनार का आयोजन जिला रोजगार अधिकारी हरीश कुमार नैनकवाल के मार्गदर्शन में किया। कार्यक्रम का मुख्य उद्देश्य युवा साथियों को साइबर अपराध के बारे में सामान्य जानकारी प्रदान करना, इससे बचने के उपाय के साथ ही करियर मार्गदर्शन प्रदान करना रहा।

मुख्य वक्ता राकेश कुमार दांगी यंग प्रोफेशनल ने अपने उद्बोधन में बताया कि वर्तमान समय में साइबर सिक्योरिटी प्रोफेशनल्स की डिमांड बढ़ती जा रही है। साइबर सिक्योरिटी एक ऐसी सुरक्षा है जिसमें हम अपने मोबाइल, कम्प्यूटर, डेक्सटॉप या किसी भी प्रकार से इंटरनेट से जुड़े सिस्टमों के लिए होती है, जिससे की सिस्टम में किसी डाटा या अन्य प्रकार की चोरी को रोका जा सके। साइबर सिक्योरिटी हमले

के बारे में बताया कि इसमें फिशिंग, मेलवेयर, डी डी ओ एस, पाशविक बल के हमले, रैसमवेयर इत्यादि अधिकतर किये जाने वाले हमले हैं। फिशिंग को हम सोशल इंजीनियरिंग हमले भी बोलते हैं इसका उपयोग अपराधियों द्वारा लोगों को विश्वसनीय व्यक्तियों के रूप में विश्वास करने के लिए मूर्ख बनाने के लिए किया जाता है ताकि वे अपनी गोपनीय जानकारी जैसे क्रेडिट कार्ड विवरण, इंटरनेट बैंकिंग क्रेडेणियल और अन्य संवेदनशील डेटा पा सके। उन्होंने बताया कि यह हमले कंप्यूटर, मोबाइल एवं मानव आधारित होते हैं। साथ ही व्हाइट हेट, ग्रे हेट एवं ब्लैक हेट हैकर्स के बारे में जानकारी दी गई। उन्होंने कहा कि आज कोविड -19 के दौर में अधिकतर प्रोफेशनल्स वर्क फ्रॉम होम के तहत ऑनलाईन कार्य कर रहे हैं जिससे साइबर क्राईम की संभावनाएं ज्यादा बढ़ जाती है। इसलिए हमें स्पैम में ई-मेल एवं मोबाइल में मैसेज द्वारा कई बार प्रलोभन दिया जाता कि आपकी लॉटरी खुल गई या अन्य किसी

प्रकार से लेकिन हमें किसी भी आयी हुई लिंक या मोबाइल में मैसेज में मांगी गई जानकारी पर क्लिक नहीं करना है। साथ ही सोशल मीडिया जैसे फेशबुक, इंस्टाग्राम, ट्विटर, पर किसी भी अनजान व्यक्ति द्वारा भेजी गई फ्रेडशिप स्वीकार नहीं करना चाहिए और न ही किसी अनजान लिंक पर क्लिक करना चाहिए। दांगी ने बताया कि जैसा कि हम देख सकते हैं कि हर दिन अपराधों में वृद्धि हो रही है इसलिए इसके एक्सपर्ट की मांग भी बढ़ती जा रही है। उन्होंने बताया कि नेटवर्क एडमिनिस्ट्रेटर जैसे प्रवेश स्तर के पदों से लेकर साइबर सिक्योरिटी आर्किटेक्ट जैसी बड़ पदों पर बहुत स्तर हैं जैसे सुरक्षा आर्किटेक्ट, सिक्योरिटी कंसलटेन्ट, प्रवेश परीक्षक, चीफ प्रॉमिशन सिक्योरिटी अधिकारी, क्रिप्टोग्राफर, सिक्योरिटी एनालिस्ट, सिक्योरिटी इंजीनियर एवं इसके अलावा सिक्योरिटी ऑडिटर, सिक्योरिटी डायरेक्टर, सिस्टम एडमिनिस्ट्रेटर, ईसीडेंट एक्पर्ट, सिक्योरिटी एक्पर्ट इत्यादि के बारे में जानकारी दी।
