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
## PREFACE

This publication of Employment Review is 35<sup>th</sup> in the series of its annual issues being prepared and published by the Directorate General of Employment and Training in the Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India. The information contained in this review is based on data collected through the network of Employment Exchanges in the country under the Employment Market Information (EMI) Programme of the D.G.E.&T., which is a vital source of employment data in the organised sector of our economy.

This Review focuses on the employment situation that prevailed in the organised sector as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2008 and the same has been analysed multi dimensionally by incorporating various factors of employment branch-wise, size-wise, zone-wise, State-wise, industry services sector-wise, etc. Such data will be of great help in the areas of vocational guidance, educational planning, training, manpower planning and monitoring of regular employment generation in the organised sector.

I take this opportunity to express my sincere thanks to State Directorates of Employment and employers for their support in making information available.

I also wish to place on record my sincere appreciation for the work accomplished by officers & staff of EMI Section and Data Processing Unit of Directorate General of Employment & Training under the overall guidance and supervision of Deputy Director General (Employment).

## HIGHLIGHTS

The present Employment Review is 35<sup>th</sup> in the series of Annual Employment Reviews being published by the Directorate General of Employment and Training (DGE&T), Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India, and pertains to the period which ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2008. This Review is based on the information collected through the network of Employment Exchanges in the country under the Employment Market Information (EMI) Programme of the DGE&T, which was initiated more than four decades ago.

### COVERAGE OF EMI PROGRAMME

The EMI Programme relates to the "Organised Sector" of economy. This organised sector covers all establishments in the public sector, irrespective of their size and non-agricultural establishments in the private sector employing 10 or more persons. Information in respect of all the public sector establishments and non-agricultural establishments in the private sector employing 25 or more persons is collected statutorily under the provisions of the Employment Exchanges (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) Act, 1959 and information from smaller non-agricultural establishments in the private sector employing 10-24 persons is collected on voluntary basis.

### ESTABLISHMENTS IN ORGANISED SECTOR

There were 3.21 lakh establishments on the Employer's Register of Employment Exchanges at the end of March 2008. Of these 1.90 lakh were in the public sector and remaining 1.31 lakh in private sector. There was a significant increase in the number of establishments in public sector whereas private sector also recorded a marginal increase in number of establishments. It has registered an overall increase of 5.99 percent during the period 2007-08. The number of establishments in public sector recorded significant increase (9.17%) over the previous year. All constituents of public sector except Local Bodies, Central Government & Quasi Government (State) recorded an increase in the number of establishments. Highest increase was recorded in the State Government (17.27%). The increase of establishments in the private sector was of the order of 1.70 percent. The increase in the number of larger establishments and smaller establishments was recorded as 2.95 percent and 0.68 percent respectively.

### EMPLOYMENT IN THE ORGANISED SECTOR

Employment in the organised sector has gone up from 272.76 lakh in March 2007 to 275.48 lakh in March 2008 recording an increase of 1.0 percent. Public sector employment showed decline of 1.8% whereas Employment in Private sector has shown a significant increase of (6.5%) during 2008 over 2007.

### **EMPLOYMENT IN DIFFERENT ZONES/REGIONS**

- During 2007–2008, Andaman, and Nicobar islands which is kept outside the Zonal Classification recorded a significant negative growth of (4.6%) followed by Eastern Zone (0.71%), Eastern Zone (0.70%), Central and Western Zone (0.6%) each. An increasing trend of employment was observed in North Eastern Zone (4.3%), Southern Zone (3.2%) and Northern Zone (1.4%).

### **EMPLOYMENT IN DIFFERENT INDUSTRY DIVISIONS**

- During 2007-2008, as would be observed from the results shown in Table 8, there was a decline in employment in Electricity, Gas and Water (5.36%) followed by Community, Social & Personal Services (1.80%), Construction (.18%) and Mining and Quarrying(0.24%). On the other hand, there was an increase in employment in Financing, Insurance, Real Estates and Business Services (8.77%), Wholesale & Retail trade and Restaurants & Hotels (6.45%), Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry & Fishing (3.03%), Manufacturing (2.96%), Transport Storage & Communication (0.11%).

### **WOMEN EMPLOYMENT**

- Employment of women in organised sector went up from 53.12 lakh in March 2007 to 55.12 lakh in March 2008, registering an increase of 3.77 percent. Women's employment in public and private sector recorded an increase of 0.74% and 7.75% respectively during 2007 & 2008.

## CHAPTER-I

### EMPLOYMENT MARKET INFORMATION PROGRAMME

#### OBJECTIVES

- 1.1 The main objectives of Employment Market Information (EMI) Programme are: -
- I) to provide information at short intervals about the structure of employment in public and private sectors at the area, state and national levels and also to monitor changes in the levels of employment.
  - II) to present occupational composition and educational profile of employees in the public and private sector establishments.
  - III) to identify occupations which are characteristic to a given industry.
  - IV) to assess manpower shortages in organised sector.
  - V) to make available information required to improve and add to the services offered by the National Employment Service.
  - VI) to monitor the progress in generating employment during the Five Year Plans.

#### COVERAGE

- 1.2 EMI programme was initiated in the year 1955 as a Pilot Project in Delhi, which was subsequently extended to selected areas (Districts) in various States during the Second Five-Year Plan period. The Programme has got a statutory base with the enactment of the Employment Exchanges (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) Act, 1959. The data collected under the EMI programme covers only the organised sector of the economy which inter-alia covers all establishments in the public sector irrespective of their size and non-agricultural establishments in the private sector employing 10 or more persons. While the information from non-agricultural establishments in the private sector employing 25 or more persons is collected under the provisions of EE (CNV) Act, 1959, data from the establishments employing 10-24 persons are collected on a voluntary basis.
- 1.3 Under the EMI programme collection of data is done following the "establishment reporting system". The establishments are required to furnish, at regular intervals, details about the number of persons they employ by gender, vacancies that have occurred and the type of persons, which are in short supply. This information relates only to 'Employers' and 'Employees'. Employers include Owners, Proprietors, Managers, Working Partners, Directors of Firms/Companies who work full time for the firms/companies.



## GEOGRAPHICAL COVERAGE

- 1.4 EMI Programme is being implemented in all the States and Union Territories of the country except Arunachal Pradesh, Sikkim, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Lakshadweep. The programme could not be extended to these States/UTs so far due to administrative reasons. The smaller establishments employing 10-24 persons in private sector in metropolitan areas of greater Mumbai and Kolkata are also not being covered owing to administrative reasons.

## REFERENCE PERIOD

- 1.5 EMI data is furnished by the establishments through ER-I return. The form ER-I is used for the collection of information from the establishments at quarterly intervals ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 30<sup>th</sup> June, 30<sup>th</sup> September and 31<sup>st</sup> December of each year.

## ORGANISATION OF THE PROGRAMME

- 1.6 The information collected through ER-I return is scrutinised, tabulated and analysed at the area, State and national level. The Employment Exchanges prepare Area Employment Market Reviews to indicate employment situation in the organised sector within the district. The State Directors of Employment also prepare State level Employment Reviews showing employment situation prevailing at the State level. At the national level, Employment Reviews are prepared annually by the Directorate General of Employment and Training projecting the overall picture of employment in the organised sector in different States/UTs. The present Employment Review provides information regarding employment in the organised sector during the period 2008-2008. The National Industrial Classification (NIC) 1998 was followed in classifying the employment data by industries.

## LIMITATIONS OF EMI DATA

- 1.7 **EMI Programme does not cover: -**
- a) Employment in un-organized sector.
  - b) Self employment
  - c) Part-time employment
  - d) Employment in agricultural and allied establishments, which furnish employment returns only on voluntary basis.
  - e) Employment in household sector and non-agricultural establishments employing less than 10 workers in private sector.
  - f) Employment in Defence Forces.
  - g) Employment in Indian Embassies and Missions abroad.

**Other limitations of EMI Programme are: -**

- a) The frame of establishments maintained at local Employment Exchange may not be comprehensive in certain cases due to non-inclusion of new and emerging establishments.
- b) There is an element of estimation of employment in respect of non-responding establishments.
- c) Employment created under various beneficiary oriented employment generation schemes/programmes might be erroneously reported under the EMI Programme.

**COVERAGE OF ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE ORGANISED SECTOR AT THE END OF MARCH, 2008.**

- 1.8 On the basis of information furnished by the Directorates of Employment of various States/Union Territories (excluding Jammu & Kashmir, Meghalaya, Mizoram and Daman & Diu) there were 3.15 lakh establishments borne on the Employers' Register as on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2008. Of these, the required employment returns were rendered by 2.07 lakh establishments both in public and private sectors. The rate of response works out to be 65.60% for the period ending March, 2008.
- 1.9 The public sector comprises establishments of Central Government, State Government, Quasi- Government (Central), Quasi-Government (State) and Local Bodies. Under private sector, the establishments are grouped on the basis of number of persons employed therein. Establishments employing 25 or more persons are categorised as larger establishments and those employing 10-24 persons are termed as smaller establishments.

1.10 It is observed from the above table that out of the total of about 1.85 lakh establishments in public sector 66.70% rendered the returns whereas in private sector out of 1.30 lakh establishments 64.05 % rendered the returns. The analysis of the rate of response reveals that in public sector the highest number (79.53%) of establishments in Quasi Government (State) rendered the employment returns followed by Local Bodies (74.54%), Quasi-Govt. (Central) (69.10%), Central Government (64.92%) and State Government Establishments (62.18%). In the private sector, 71.14% of the Larger Establishments and 58.14% of the Smaller Establishments had furnished the employment returns for the period ending March, 2008.

## BRANCHWISE & SIZEWISE DISTRIBUTION OF ESTABLISHMENTS

- 1.11 Table-2 below presents the distribution of establishments by different branches of public and private sectors during the year 2007-2008.

- 1.12 It is seen from the above table that overall there was significant increase in the number of establishments in public sector (9.17%), except Central Government, Quasi Government (State) and Local Bodies which shows decrease in number of establishments during the period 2007-08 whereas number of establishments in the private sector both in larger and smaller establishments maintained positive growth.

### COVERAGE OF ESTABLISHMENTS IN DIFFERENT ZONES / REGIONS :

- 1.13 The entire country has been divided into six Zones / Regions, viz., Northern Zone, Central Zone, Eastern Zone, North-Eastern Zone, Western Zone and Southern Zone. The Andaman & Nicobar Islands is outside the scheme of Zonal Councils embodied in the States Reorganization Act, 1956. Table-3 shows the number of establishments in the six zones and in the Union Territories of A & N Islands.

The above table reveals that the highest percentage increase of establishments in the organised sector in 2008 over 2007 was recorded in the Southern Zone (18.78%) followed by Andaman & Nicobar (12.14%) which is kept outside the Zonal classification. Northern Zone (1.92%), North Eastern Zone (1.07%), Central Zone (0.21%) and Western Zone (0.17%). The percentage of decrease of establishments is recorded in only Eastern Zone (1.02%).

## CHAPTER -II

### EMPLOYMENT IN ORGANISED SECTOR

- 2.1 During the period under review (2007-2008), employment in the organised sector showed a decrease of 1.0%. In absolute terms, employment in the organised sector increased from 272.76 lakh at the end of March 2007 to 275.48 lakh at the end of March 2008.
- 2.2 The sector-wise break-up of employment as on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2008 and percentage change is shown in the following table:

It is revealed from the data contained in the table-4 above that employment in the private sector recorded a significance increase of 6.5% in 2008 over the year 2007 but in public sector employment has shown a negative growth of 1.8% during the same period. The overall increase was 1.0%.

**EMPLOYMENT IN DIFFERENT BRANCHES OF PUBLIC SECTOR :**

- 2.3 The distribution of employment in different branches of the public sector as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2008 is indicated in table-5 below:

An analysis of employment in 2008 over 2007 of different branches of the public sector revealed that the decrease in employment was recorded in all the branches of public sector. The maximum decrease was observed in Local Bodies (7.71%) followed by Central Government(2.21%), Quasi Government (Central) (1.67%), State Government (0.53%) and Quasi Government (State) (0.27%).

## EMPLOYMENT IN PRIVATE SECTOR

2.4 Employment in the private sector is classified by size of establishments. On this basis, the break-up of employment in the private sector by size of establishments is shown in the following table-6.

It may be observed from the table-6 that employment in larger establishments in the private sector has increased by 7.33% whereas Employment in smaller establishments recorded a marginal decreased by 0.29% as on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2008 as compared to corresponding period of previous year. The overall increase in employment in the private sector was of the order of 6.48% during the period under review.



**ZONE-WISE / REGION-WISE EMPLOYMENT IN THE ORGANISED SECTOR**

The above table depicts the zone wise trend in employment in organized sector. There was an increase in employment in North Eastern Zone (4.3%) followed by Southern Zone (3.2%) and Northern Zone (1.4%) whereas Andaman & Nicobar Islands recorded very significant decrease of employment(4.6%) which is kept outside the zonal classification followed by Eastern Zone(0.7%), Central Zone and Western Zone (0.6%) each.

### CHAPTER-III

#### EMPLOYMENT IN STATES AND UNION TERRITORIES

- 3.1 Employment in the organised sector in the country is spread over 31 States/Union Territories. Rest of the States/Uts have not been covered under the programme. Analysis of data with regard to employment in the organised sector by different Zones/Regions has already been made in Chapter II. Each Zone/Region has a group of contiguous States/Union Territories. The main focus of analysis is on the trend of employment in the organised sector in various States/Union Territories under each Zone/Region. Employment in different States/Union Territories under each of the six Zone is shown in Annexure III.

#### NORTHERN ZONE

##### Haryana

- 3.2 Total Employment in the State remained more or less static at 6.67 lakh in March 2008. Employment increased from 2.84 lakh to 2.86 lakh i.e. 0.5% in the private sector. Public Sector in the State during the period under review 2007 & 2008 recorded a decrease of 0.6% only. The State had a share of 2.42% in all India employment in the organised sector.

##### Punjab

- 3.3 Total Employment in the State increased from 8.08 lakh to 8.44 lakh in March 2008, showing an increase of 4.5% over 2007. Employment in public sector increased from 4.97 lakh to 5.20 lakh (4.7%). Private Sector recorded an increase from 3.11 lakh to 3.25 lakh (4.3%). The share of employment in Punjab was 3.07% of the total employment in the organized sector at the end of March 2008.

##### Himachal Pradesh

- 3.4 Employment in the State increased from 3.38 lakh to 3.65 lakh in March 2008 showing an increase of 7.9%. Employment had increased in private sector by 24.8% and public sector recorded an increase of 2.4% during the period under review (2007 & 2008). Himachal Pradesh had a share of 1.33% in all India employment at the end of March 2008.

##### Chandigarh

- 3.5 Total employment in the Union Territory increased from 0.88 lakh in March, 2007 to 1.01 lakh at the end of March 2008 registering an increase of 15.4%. Employment in public sector recorded an increase of 0.8% while in Private sector it increased by 43.5% during 2007 & 2008. The Union Territory contributed only 0.37% of the total organised sector employment at all India level.

### Delhi

- 3.6 Employment in the Union Territory in the organised sector, decreased from 8.30 lakh at the end of March 2007 to 7.91 lakh at the end of March 2008, reflecting a decrease of 4.8%. In the public sector the employment decreased by 7.6% while in the private sector it went up by 2.7%. The Union Territory contributed 2.87% to the total organised sector employment at the all India level.

### Rajasthan

- 3.7 Employment in the State increased from 12.01 lakh in March 2007 to 12.21 lakh in March 2008 registering an increase of 1.7%. In public sector, employment decreased by 0.4% whereas in private sector employment recorded an increase of 9.6%. The share of the State in all-India employment was 4.43% as at the end of March 2008.

### Jammu & Kashmir

- 3.8 Total employment as well as employment in public & private sectors remained static at 2.10, 2.00 and 0.11 lakh respectively in the State at the end of March 2008. The state had a share of 0.76% of all India employment.

## CENTRAL ZONE

### Madhya Pradesh

- 3.9 Total employment in Madhya Pradesh decreased from 10.43 lakh in March 2007 to 9.95 lakh in March 2008 recording a decrease of 4.6%. Public sector employment had gone down from 8.91 lakh to 8.56 lakh registering a fall of 4.0%. The employment in private sector however recorded a decrease of 8.5%. The State had a share of 3.61% of all-India employment in March 2008.

### Chhattisgarh

- 3.10 The total employment in the organised sector increased by 3.5% during 2008 over 2007. In public and private sectors employment was 2.98 lakh and 0.32 lakh respectively at the end of March 2007 whereas employment in Public & Private Sector was 3.07 lakh and 0.35 lakh at the end of March 2008. Public sector employment increased by 3.1% whereas in private sector the employment recorded an increase in employment of 7.1%. The Chhattisgarh State had a share of 1.24% in all India employment as on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2008.

### Uttar Pradesh

- 3.11 Total employment in the State increased from 21.13 lakh in March 2007 to 21.14 lakh in March 2008 recording an increase at the rate of 0.1%. The public sector recorded a decrease at the rate of 0.7% in its employment while in the private sector employment went up by 2.6%. The State accounted for a share of 7.68% of all-India employment at the end of March 2008.

### Uttarakhand

- 3.12 The total employment in the State increased from 2.54 lakh in March 2007 to 2.66 lakh in March 2008 recording an increase of 4.6%. The public sector recorded an increase at the rate of 3.0% while Private sector recorded an increase of 11.9%. The State contributed only 0.96% of the total organised sector employment at all India level.

## NORTH-EASTERN ZONE

### Assam

- 3.13 Total employment in the State had increased from 11.21 lakh in March 2007 to 11.73 lakh in March 2008, recording an increase of 4.6%. In public sector employment went up by 1.1% while in private sector it went up by 7.6%. The State had a share of 4.26% of all India employment.

### Meghalaya

- 3.14 Total employment in this State in organised sector had been of the order of 0.82 lakh. Employment in public sector (0.73 lakh) and private sector (0.09 lakh) remained static in the State at the end of March 2008. Hence, percentage change was not observed. The State had a 0.30% share in all India employment of the organised sector.

### Manipur

- 3.15 Total employment in the State in the organised sector had been order of 0.79 lakh. Employment in public sector (0.76 lakh) and in private sector 0.03 lakh remain static at the end of March 2008. Hence percentage change was not observed. Manipur had a meagre share of 0.29% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

### Mizoram

- 3.16 Employment in the State was static (0.42 lakh) at the end of March 2008 recording no change in total as well as public and private sectors employment. The State's share in all India organised sector employment was only 0.15%.

### Nagaland

- 3.17 Total employment in the organised sector increased from 0.76 lakh at the end of March 2007 to 0.77 lakh at the end of March 2008. The employment in the public sector increased by 0.2% where in private sector it increased by 17.9%. Nagaland had a small share of 0.28% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

### Tripura

- 3.18 Employment in the State had recorded an increase of 10.0% at the end of March 2008. In absolute terms total employment was 1.45 lakh at the end of March 2007 over 1.60 lakh at the end of March, 2008. Public and private sectors employment was 1.47 lakh and 0.13 lakh respectively during the same period. Tripura contributed only 0.58% in the total organised sector employment at all India level.

## EASTERN ZONE

### Bihar

- 3.19 Total employment in the organised sector in the State had gone down from 4.13 lakh at the end of March 2007 to 3.93 lakh at the end of March 2008, showing a decrease of 4.7%. There was a decrease of employment in public sector by 5.1% while in private sector there was an increase of 2.1%. The State's share was 1.43% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

### Orissa

- 3.20 Total employment in the organised sector in the State decreased from 7.03 lakh in March 2007 to 6.64 lakh in March 2008, recording a decrease of 5.5%. The decrease in employment in public sector was of the order of 6.5% while in private sector it showed a growth of 1.2%. The share of the State was 2.41% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

### West Bengal

- 3.21 The organised sector employment in the State increased from 19.32 lakh in March 2007 to 19.37 lakh in March 2008, recording an increase of 0.3%. Employment in public sector has gone down by 2.9% while employment in private sector went up by 5.6%. The overall employment in the State accounted for 7.03% of the total organised sector employment at the all-India level.

### Jharkhand

- 3.22 The employment of this State increased from 15.33 lakh at the end of March, 2007 to 15.55 lakh at the end of March, 2008 recording a growth of 1.4%. The growth of employment in the public sector went down by 0.1% while in it registered a growth of 7.6%. Jharkhand had a share of 5.64% in all India organized sector employment.

## WESTERN ZONE

### Gujarat

- 3.23 Employment in the organised sector in the State was 18.39 lakh in March, 2008 as compared to 18.09 lakh in March 2007. The increase in the organised sector employment was 1.7% during the period under review. There was a decline of 1.3% in employment in the public sector whereas private sector employment increased by 3.9%. The total organised sector employment in the State accounted for 6.68% of the total employment in the organised sector at the all-India level.

### Maharashtra

- 3.24 Employment in the organised sector in the State decreased from 37.46 lakh in March 2007 to 36.82 lakh in March 2008 showing a decrease of 1.7%. In the public sector the decrease in employment was 9.2% whereas employment in private sector increased by 8.7% during the period under review. The total organised sector employment in the State constituted 13.73% of the total organised sector employment at the all-India level during the period under review.

### Goa

- 3.25 The total organised sector employment had gone up from 1.32 lakh at the end of March, 2007 to 1.33 lakh at the end of March 2008 reflecting an increase of 1.1%. In public sector the increase in employment was 0.1% whereas in private sector the employment increased by 2.7%. The State accounted for only 0.48% of the total organised sector employment at the all-India level.

### Daman & Diu

- 3.26 The total organised sector employment in the Union Territory of Daman & Diu remained static at 15 thousand in March 2008 over March, 2008. The Union Territory contributed of the lowest (0.05%) in the total organised sector employment at the all India level.

## SOUTHERN ZONE

### Andhra Pradesh

- 3.27 Employment in the organised sector in the State increase from 20.26 lakh at the end of March 2007 to 20.91 lakh at the end of March 2008 recording an increase of 3.2%. The public sector employment had registered a fall of 0.8% while in the private sector increased by 11.7%. In all India employment figures, the State accounted for 7.59% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

### Karnataka

- 3.28 Organised sector employment in the State went up from 20.81 lakh in March 2007 to 21.47 lakh in March 2008 showing a rise of 3.2%. Employment in the public sector increased by 0.6% while in private sector growth was recorded as 5.7%. The share of Karnataka was 5.96% and 11.08% in all-India public and private sector employment respectively. Karnataka contributed 7.79% in the total organised sector employment at the all India level.

### Kerala

- 3.29 The total organised sector employment in the State went up from 11.06 lakh in March 2007 to 11.18 lakh in March 2008 showing an increase of 1.0%. In the public sector the employment was increased by 1.2% and in private sector it recorded an increase of 0.9%. Kerala contributed 4.06% in the total organised sector employment at the all India level.

### Puducherry

- 3.30 The total employment in the organised sector increased from 66 thousand at the end of March, 2007 to 69 thousand in March 2008 showing a rise of 4.6% during 2007 & 2008. Employment in public sector decreased by 1.6% while in the Private sector it increased by 14.6%. The overall employment in the Union Territory was 0.25% of the all India employment in organised sector.

### Tamil Nadu

- 3.31 In this State, organised sector employment has increase from 22.49 lakh in March, 2007 to 23.41 lakh in March, 2008 indicating growth of 4.1%. There was an increase of employment in public sector to the extent of 0.6%. whereas the employment in the private sector increased by 11.0%. The proportion of organised sector employment as a whole to all-India employment was 8.50% during the year under review.

### Andaman & Nicobar Islands

3.32 The Union Territory is outside the Zonal classification as per the States Reorganisation Act. The employment in the U.T during the period under review decreased from 0.38 lakh at the end of March 2007 to 0.37 lakh at the end of March 2008 registering a fall of 4.6%. The Public sector employment declined by 1.7% while in the Private sector it declined by 42.0%. The Union Territory accounted for 0.13% of the total organised sector employment at the All India Level.



## CHAPTER-IV

### EMPLOYMENT IN INDUSTRIES/SERVICES

- 4.1 A broad picture about the structure of employment in the organised sector, in different industries/services grouped under primary, secondary and tertiary sectors as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2007 & 2008 is presented in the following table: -

It will be observed from table-8 that primary sector comprising agriculture, hunting, forestry & fishing and mining & quarrying industry division showed an over-all increase of 1.51% in employment in 2008 over 2007. Under this sector, agriculture, hunting, forestry and fishing recorded an increase of 3.03%, whereas the mining & quarrying division recorded marginal decrease of 0.24% in 2008 over 2007.

4.2 An over-all increase in employment in secondary sector was 15.53% during 2008 over 2007. Under this Sector, employment in manufacturing recorded an increase of 2.96% whereas electricity, gas & water and construction recorded negative growth of 5.36% and 1.18% respectively.

4.3 The overall increase in employment in the tertiary sector was 0.23% during 2008 over 2007. In this sector a significant increase was recorded in financing insurance, Real Estate & business services 8.77% followed by wholesale and retail trade and restaurants & hotels(6.45%) and transport, storage & communication sector recorded a marginal growth of 0.11% whereas community, social and personal services was recorded negative growth of 1.80%.

## CHAPTER-V

### WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT IN THE ORGANISED SECTOR

- 5.1 Employment of women constitutes an important component of the organised sector employment in the country. The employment of women in the organised sector has gone up steadily over the last ten years. It comprises 20.0% of the total employment in the organised sector in the country as on 31-03-2008. An overview of women's employment is given in the following table: -

It may be observed from the above table that women's employment in the organised sector went up from 48.15 lakh in 1998-98 to 55.12 lakh in 2007-08.

- 5.2 The increase in women employment during the year 2007-08 was of the order of 3.8% as compared to 3.7% increase during the preceding year 2006-07. It may be seen from the table-9 that the share of women's employment to total employment in the organised sector has risen steadily from 17.1% in 1998-99 to 20.0% in 2007-08.

### PATTERN OF WOMEN EMPLOYMENT

- 5.3 The employment of women in public and private sectors from 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2008 over 2007 and percentage changes between two years are presented in the following table-10.

It may be observed from the above table that out of the total 55.12 lakh women employees in the organised sector at the end of March 2008. There were 30.40 lakh in the public sector and the remaining 24.72 lakh in the private sector. Women's employment in public sector and private sector registered an increase of 0.74% percent and 7.75% respectively during the period under reference. There was an overall increase of Women employment in both public and private sector was (3.77%).

**BRANCH-WISE AND SIZE-WISE COMPOSITION OF WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT**

5.4 The distribution of women's employment by different branches of public sector and by size of establishments in the private sector is presented in table-11 below.

The branch-wise distribution of women's employment shows an overall increase in employment in public sector (0.74%) all constituents of Public Sectors except Local Bodies and Central Government recorded positive growth of women employment. The highest Increase was recorded in State Govt. (Quasi)(3.58%) followed by State Government (2.62%) Central Government (Quasi) (2.39%) where as Local Bodies and Central Govt. recorded Negative growth 4.86% and 2.56% respectively. There was an overall Increase of (7.75%) in women's employment in the Private Sector. The appreciable growth in women employment was recorded in larger establishments (9.31%) where as smaller establishment recorded a negative growth of (4.60%) during the period under review.

It may be observed from the above table that women's employment had increased in all Zones. The highest increase was recorded in A & N Islands (7.87%), (which is outside the scheme of zonal classification), followed by Southern Zone (5.14%), North Eastern Zone (4.42%), Northern Zone (3.30%), Western Zone (2.32%), Central Zone (2.26%) and Eastern Zone (1.29%).

### WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT IN STATES/UNION TERRITORIES

5.6 The distribution of women employees by States/UTs. cross-classified by public and private sectors as on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2007 and 2008 is contained in Annexure X. It may be observed that women employment had gone down in the States/UTs. of Bihar (9.33%) followed by Orissa (2.46%), Madhya Pradesh (1.79%) and Delhi (0.72%). There was a significant and substantial growth of women employment noticed in Puducherry (19.78%) followed by Goa (13.74%), Chandigarh(12.98), Himachal Pradesh(8.87), A & N Islands (7.87%), (which is outside the scheme of zonal classification), Tamilnadu(7.02%), Karnataka (6.68%) and Punjab(6.59%) during the period under review (2007-2008).

## WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT IN INDUSTRIES/SERVICES

5.7 The distribution of women's employment by major industries from 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2008 & 2007 is given below:

An analysis of data on women's employment contained in table-13 reveals that there was a decrease in women's employment in Electricity, Gas & Water (6.32%) and in construction (0.81%). While there is an increase in other industry divisions, which were wholesale and retail trade and restaurant & hotels (22.50%), followed by financing, insurance, real estate & business services (15.56%), manufacturing (6.96%), Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry & Fishing (4.0%), transport storage & communication (2.46%), community, social & personal services (0.64%) and Mining & Quarrying (0.48%), during the period under review.
