

The industrial classification used in this review conforms to the Revised National Industrial Classification, 1998 issued by the Central Statistical Organisation (CSO), Government of India.

#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

The present Employment Review is 37<sup>th</sup> in the series of Annual Employment Reviews being published by the Directorate General of Employment and Training (DGE&T), Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India, and pertains to the period which ended on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2010. This Review is based on the information collected through the network of Employment Exchanges in the country under the Employment Market Information (EMI) Programme of the DGE&T, which was initiated more than four decades ago.

#### **COVERAGE OF EMI PROGRAMME**

The EMI Programme relates to the "Organised Sector" of economy. This organised sector covers all establishments in the Public sector, irrespective of their size and non-agricultural establishments in the Private sector employing 10 or more persons. Information in respect of all the Public sector establishments and non-agricultural establishments in the Private sector employing 25 or more persons is collected statutorily under the provisions of the Employment Exchanges (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) Act, 1959 and information from smaller non-agricultural establishments in the Private sector employing 10-24 persons is collected on voluntary basis.

#### **ESTABLISHMENTS IN ORGANISED SECTOR**

There were 3.22 lakh establishments on the Employer's Register of Employment Exchanges at the end of March, 2010. Of these 1.79 lakh were in the Public Sector and remaining 1.44 lakh in Private Sector. There was an increase in the number of establishments both in Public and Private sectors. It has registered an overall increase of 3.98% during the period 2009-10. The number of establishments in Public sector recorded an increase of 1.42% over the previous year. All constituents of Public sector recorded an increase in the number of establishments. The increase in establishments in the Private sector was 7.36%.

#### **EMPLOYMENT IN THE ORGANISED SECTOR**

Employment in the organised sector has gone up from 281.72 lakh in March, 2009 to 287.08 lakh in March, 2010 recording an increase of 1.9 percent. Employment in Public and Private sector recorded an increase of 0.4% and 4.5% respectively, during 2010 over previous year.

#### **EMPLOYMENT IN DIFFERENT ZONES/REGIONS**

During 2009–2010, an increasing trend was observed in Western Zone (3.4%) followed by Northern Zone (1.8%), North - Eastern Zone (1.8%) and Southern Zone (1.8%). Whereas Central Zone and Eastern Zone observed an increase of (0.8%) and (1.1%) respectively. Andaman & Nicobar Islands recorded a decline of (0.8%).

#### **EMPLOYMENT IN DIFFERENT INDUSTRY DIVISIONS**

During 2009-2010, as would be observed from the results shown in Table 8, there was a decline in employment in Transport, Storage & Communication (-1.39%) followed by Electricity, Gas and Water (-0.44%) and Manufacturing (-0.13%). On the other hand, there was an increase in employment in Financing, Insurance, Real Estates and Business Services (11.14%) followed by Wholesale & Retail trade and Restaurants & Hotels (4.80%), Mining and Quarrying (3.02%), Construction (2.70%), Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry & Fishing (2.04%) and Community, Social & Personal Services (1.42%).

#### **WOMEN EMPLOYMENT**

Employment of women in organised sector went up from 55.80 lakh in March, 2009 to 58.59 lakh in March, 2010, registering an increase of 5.0%. Women's employment in Public and Private sector recorded an increase of 3.40% and 6.98% respectively during 2009-10.

#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

This Review is based on the information collected through the network of Employment Exchanges in the country under the Employment Market Information (EMI) Programme of the DGE&T, which was initiated more than four decades ago.

#### **COVERAGE OF EMI PROGRAMME**

The EMI Programme relates to the "Organised Sector" of economy. This organised sector covers all establishments in the Public sector, irrespective of their size and non-agricultural establishments in the Private sector employing 10 or more persons. Information in respect of all the Public sector establishments and non-agricultural establishments in the Private sector employing 25 or more persons is collected statutorily under the provisions of the Employment Exchanges (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) Act, 1959 and information from smaller non-agricultural establishments in the Private sector employing 10-24 persons is collected on voluntary basis.

#### **ESTABLISHMENTS IN ORGANISED SECTOR**

There were 3.22 lakh establishments on the Employer's Register of Employment Exchanges at the end of March, 2010. Of these 1.79 lakh were in the Public Sector and remaining 1.44 lakh in Private Sector. There was an increase in the number of establishments both in Public and Private sectors. It has registered an overall increase of 3.98% during the period 2009-10. The number of establishments in Public sector recorded an increase of 1.42% over the previous year. All constituents of Public sector recorded an increase in the number of establishments. The increase in establishments in the Private sector was 7.36%.

#### **EMPLOYMENT IN THE ORGANISED SECTOR**

Employment in the organised sector has gone up from 281.72 lakh in March, 2009 to 287.08 lakh in March, 2010 recording an increase of 1.9 percent. Employment in Public and Private sector recorded an increase of 0.4% and 4.5% respectively, during 2010 over previous year.

During 2009-2010, as would be observed from the results shown in Table 8, there was a decline in employment in Transport, Storage & Communication (-1.39%) followed by Electricity, Gas and Water (-0.44%) and Manufacturing (-0.13%). On the other hand, there was an increase in employment in Financing, Insurance, Real Estates and Business Services (11.14%) followed by Wholesale & Retail trade and Restaurants & Hotels (4.80%), Mining and Quarrying (3.02%), Construction (2.70%), Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry & Fishing (2.04%) and Community, Social & Personal Services (1.42%).

#### WOMEN EMPLOYMENT

Employment of women in organised sector went up from 55.80 lakh in March, 2009 to 58.59 lakh in March, 2010, registering an increase of 5.0%. Women's employment in Public and Private sector recorded an increase of 3.40% and 6.98% respectively during 2009-10.

CHAPTER

# EMPLOYMENT MARKET INFORMATION PROGRAMME

#### **OBJECTIVES**

- 1.1 The main objectives of Employment Market Information (EMI) Programme are:
  - to provide information at short intervals about the structure of employment in Public and Private Sectors at the area, state and national levels and also to monitor changes in the levels of employment.
  - II) to present occupational composition and educational profile of employees in the Public and Private Sector establishments.
  - III) to identify occupations which are characteristic to a given industry.
  - IV) to assess manpower shortages in organised sector.
  - V) to make available information required to improve and add to the services offered by the National Employment Service.
  - VI) to monitor the progress in generating employment during the Five Year Plans.

#### **COVERAGE**

- 1.2 EMI programme was initiated in the year 1955 as a Pilot Project in Delhi, which was subsequently extended to selected areas (Districts) in various States during the Second Five-Year Plan period. The Programme has got a statutory base with the enactment of the Employment Exchanges (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) [EE(CNV)] Act, 1959. The data collected under the EMI programme covers only the organised sector of the economy which inter-alia covers all establishments in the Public Sector irrespective of their size and non-agricultural establishments in the Private Sector employing 10 or more persons. While the information from non-agricultural establishments in the Private Sector employing 25 or more persons is collected under the provisions of EE (CNV) Act, 1959, data from the establishments employing 10-24 persons are collected on a voluntary basis.
- 1.3 Under the EMI programme collection of data is done following the "establishment reporting system". The establishments are required to furnish, at regular intervals, details about the number of persons they employ by gender, vacancies that have occurred and the type of persons, which are in short supply. This information relates only to 'Employers' and 'Employees'. Employers include Owners, Proprietors, Managers, Working Partners, Directors of Firms/Companies who work full time for the firms/companies.

#### **GEOGRAPHICAL COVERAGE**

1.4 EMI Programme is being implemented in all the States and Union Territories of the country except Arunachal Pradesh, Sikkim, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Lakshadweep. The programme could not be extended to these States/UTs so far due to administrative reasons. The smaller establishments employing 10-24 persons in Private Sector in metropolitan areas of greater Mumbai and Kolkata are also not being covered owing to administrative reasons. 1

#### REFERENCE PERIOD

1.5 EMI data is furnished by the establishments through ER-I return. The form ER-I is used for the collection of information from the establishments at quarterly intervals ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 30<sup>th</sup> June, 30<sup>th</sup> September and 31<sup>st</sup> December of each year.

#### **ORGANISATION OF THE PROGRAMME**

1.6 The information collected through ER-I return is scrutinised, tabulated and analysed at the area, State and national level. The Employment Exchanges prepare Area Employment Market Reviews to indicate employment situation in the organised sector within the district. The State Directors of Employment also prepare State level Employment Reviews showing employment situation prevailing at the State level. At the national level, Employment Reviews are prepared annually by the Directorate General of Employment and Training projecting the overall picture of employment in the organised sector in different States/UTs. The present Employment Review provides information regarding employment in the organised sector during the period 2009-2010. The National Industrial Classification (NIC) 1998 was followed in classifying the employment data by industries.

#### **LIMITATIONS OF EMI DATA**

- 1.7 EMI Programme does not cover:
  - a) Employment in un-organized sector.
  - b) Self employment
  - c) Part-time employment
  - d) Employment in agricultural and allied establishments, which furnish employment returns only on voluntary basis.
  - e) Employment in household sector and non-agricultural establishments employing less than 10 workers in Private Sector.
  - f) Employment in Defence Forces.
  - g) Employment in Indian Embassies and Missions abroad.

#### Other limitations of EMI Programme are: -

- a) The frame of establishments maintained at local Employment Exchange may not be comprehensive in certain cases due to non-inclusion of new and emerging establishments.
- b) There is an element of estimation of employment in respect of non-responding establishments.
- c) Employment created under various beneficiary oriented employment generation schemes/programmes might be erroneously reported under the EMI Programme.

### <u>COVERAGE OF ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE ORGANISED SECTOR AT THE END OF MARCH, 2010.</u>

- On the basis of information furnished by the Directorates of Employment of various States/Union Territories (excluding Jammu & Kashmir, Manipur, Mizoram, Daman & Diu and Puducherry) there were 3.17 lakh establishments borne on the Employers' Register as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2010. Of these, the required employment returns were rendered by 2.12 lakh establishments both in Public and Private Sectors. The rate of response works out to be 66.83% for the period ending March, 2010.
- 1.9 The Public Sector comprises establishments of Central Government, State Government, Quasi-Government (Central), Quasi-Government (State) and Local Bodies. Under Private Sector, the establishments are grouped on the basis of number of persons employed therein. Establishments employing 25 or more persons are categorized as larger establishments and those employing 10-24 persons are termed as smaller establishments.



1.10 It is observed from the above table that out of the total of about 1.74 lakh establishments in Public Sector (70.49%) rendered the returns whereas in Private Sector out of 1.43 lakh establishments (62.35%) rendered the returns. The analysis of the rate of response reveals that in Public Sector the highest number (73.08%) of establishments in Local Bodies rendered the employment returns followed by State Government (72.40%), Quasi-Government (State) (71.67%), Quasi-Government (Central) (66.69%), Central Government (62.89%). In the Private Sector, (71.22%) of the Larger Establishments and (55.01%) of the Smaller Establishments had furnished the employment returns for the period ending March, 2010.

#### **BRANCHWISE & SIZEWISE DISTRIBUTION OF ESTABLISHMENTS**

1.11 Table-2 below presents the distribution of establishments by different branches of Public and Private Sector during the year 2009-10.

1.12 It is seen from the above table that the total number of establishments increased by 3.98%. All the branches of Public Sector have shown a positive growth except Quasi-Govt.(State) whereas Private Sector (larger and smaller establishments) maintained a positive growth during the period 2009-10.

#### **COVERAGE OF ESTABLISHMENTS IN DIFFERENT ZONES/REGIONS:**

1.13 The entire country has been divided into six Zones / Regions, viz., Northern Zone, Central Zone, Eastern Zone, North-Eastern Zone, Western Zone and Southern Zone. The Andaman & Nicobar Islands is outside the scheme of Zonal Councils embodied in the States Reorganization Act, 1956. Table-3 shows the number of establishments in the six zones and in the Union Territory of A & N Islands.

The above table reveals that the highest percentage increase of establishments in the organised sector in 2010 over 2009 was recorded in the Western Zone (15.88%) followed by Northern Zone (2.95%), Eastern Zone (1.96%). The decline has been recorded in Southern Zone (0.42%), North Eastern Zone (0.37%) and Central Zone (0.21%). Andaman & Nicobar Islands, which is kept outside the scheme of zonal classification, remain static.


- 2.1 During the period under review (2009-2010), employment in the organised sector showed an increase of 1.9%. In absolute terms, employment in the organised sector increased from 281.72 lakh at the end of March, 2009 to 287.08 lakh at the end of March, 2010.
- 2.2 The sector-wise break-up of employment as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2010 and percentage change is shown in the following table:

It is revealed from the data contained in the table-4 that employment in the Private Sector recorded a significant increase of 4.5% in 2010 over the year 2009 while in Public Sector, employment has shown marginal growth of 0.4% during the same period. The overall increase was 1.9%.



### **EMPLOYMENT IN DIFFERENT BRANCHES OF PUBLIC SECTOR**



An analysis of employment in 2010 over 2009 of different branches of the Public Sector revealed that the increase was observed in Quasi Government (Central), State Government and in Local Bodies as 1.66%, 1.59% and 0.77% respectively, whereas Central Government and Quasi Government (State) showed a decline of (4.09%) and (0.47%) respectively.

2.4 Employment in the Private Sector is classified by size of establishments. On this basis, the break-up of employment in the Private Sector by size of establishments is shown in the following table-6.



#### **EMPLOYMENT IN PRIVATE SECTOR**



It may be observed from the table-6 that employment in larger establishments in the Private Sector has increased by 4.22% whereas employment in smaller establishments recorded an increased of 7.17% as on 31st March, 2010 as compared to corresponding period of previous year. The overall increase in employment in the Private Sector was of the order of 4.52% during the period under review.

There was a decrease of employment in Public Sector by 1.8% and in Private Sector there was a decrease of 0.6%. The State's share was 1.47% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

#### Orissa

3.20 Total employment in the organised sector increased from 7.15 lakh in March, 2009 to 7.27 lakh in March, 2010 recording an increase of 1.7%. The employment in Public Sector marginally decreased by 0.4% while in Private Sector it showed a positive growth of 14.1%. The share of the State was 2.53% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

#### **West Bengal**

3.21 The organised sector employment in the State decreased from 19.34 lakh in March, 2009 to 19.27 lakh in March, 2010 recording a decrease of 0.3%. Employment in Public Sector has gone down by 1.5% while employment in Private Sector went up by 1.4%. The overall employment in the State accounted for 6.71% of the total organised sector employment at the all-India level.

The main focus of analysis is on the trend of employment in the organised sector in various States/Union Territories under each Zone/Region. Employment in different States/Union Territories under each of the six Zone is shown in Annexure III.

#### **NORTHERN ZONE**

#### Haryana

Total Employment in the State had marginally decreased from 6.70 lakh to 6.67 lakh in March, 2010 showing a decrease of 0.5% over 2009. Employment in Public Sector decreased from 3.79 lakh to 3.78 lakh (0.3%). Whereas employment in the Private Sector decreased from 2.90 lakh to 2.89 lakh (0.6%). The State had a share of 2.32% in all India employment in the organised sector.

#### Punjab

3.3 Total Employment in the organized sector in the state had gone up from 7.88 lakh at the end of March, 2009 to 8.26 lakh at the end of March, 2010, showing an increase of 4.8%. There was an increase of employment in both Public and Private Sector 6.9% and 1.9% respectively. The State had a share of 2.88% in all India employment in the organised sector.

#### **Himachal Pradesh**

Total employment in the state increased from 3.72 lakh to 3.88 lakh in March, 2010 showing an increase of 4.2%. Employment had increased in Private Sector by 5.3% and the Public Sector recorded an increase of 3.8% during the period under review (2009-10). Himachal Pradesh had a share of 1.35% in all India employment at the end of March, 2010.

#### Chandigarh

3.5 Total employment in the Union Territory recorded a decrease from 1.04 lakh at the end of March, 2009 to 1.00 lakh at the end of March, 2010 registering a decrease of 4.2%. Employment in Public Sector recorded a decrease of 4.9% and in Private Sector it decreased by 3.4% during 2009-10. The Union Territory contributed only 0.35% of the total organised sector employment at all India level.

#### <u>Delhi</u>

3.6 Total Employment increased from 8.43 lakh at the end of March, 2009 to 8.61 lakh at the end of March, 2010, registering an increase of 2.2%. In the Public Sector, employment increased by 0.7% while in the Private Sector it increased by 5.7%. It contributed 3.0% to the total organised sector employment at the all India level.

#### Rajasthan

3.7 Employment in the State increased from 12.57 lakh to 12.69 lakh in March, 2010 registering an increase of 1.0%. In Public Sector, employment decreased by 0.3% while in Private Sector employment recorded an increase of 5.1%. The share of the State in all India employment was 4.42% as at the end of March, 2010.

#### Jammu & Kashmir

Total employment as well as employment in Public & Private Sectors remained static at 2.10, 2.00 and 0.11 lakh respectively in the State at the end of March, 2010. The state had a share of 0.73% of all India employment.

#### **CENTRAL ZONE**

#### Madhya Pradesh

Total employment in Madhya Pradesh decreased from 10.08 lakh in March, 2009 to 9.94 lakh in March, 2010 recording a decline of 1.3%. Public Sector employment had decreased from 8.61 lakh to 8.47 lakh registering a decrease of 1.7%, whereas the employment in Private Sector recorded a marginal increase of 0.7%. The State had a share of 3.46% of all-India employment in March, 2010.

#### **Uttar Pradesh**

3.10 Total employment in the State increased from 21.21 lakh in March, 2009 to 21.53 lakh in March, 2010 recording an increase at the rate of 1.5%. The Public Sector recorded an increase at the rate of 1.0% in its employment while in the Private Sector employment went up by 3.0%. The State accounted for a share of 7.50% of all-India employment at the end of March, 2010.

#### Uttarakhand

3.11 The total employment in the State increased from 2.61 lakh in March, 2009 to 2.88 lakh in March, 2010 recording an increase of 10.3%. The Public Sector recorded an increase at the rate of 1.6% while Private Sector recorded an increase of 44.1%, as a large number of establishments have been set up in Private Sector in the state which cause to increase large employment in the Private Sector. The State contributed 1.00% of the total organised sector employment at all India level.

#### **Chhattisgarh**

3.12 The total employment in the organised sector decreased by 4.4% during 2010 over 2009. In Public and Private Sectors employment was 3.09 lakh and 0.35 lakh respectively at the end of March, 2009 whereas employment in Public & Private Sector was 2.93 lakh and 0.36 lakh respectively at the end of March, 2010. Employment in Public Sector recorded a decrease of 5.1% while employment in the Private Sector has shown an increase of 2.6% during the reference period. The Chhattisgarh State had a share of 1.14% in all India employment as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2010.

#### **NORTH-EASTERN ZONE**

#### Assam

3.13 Total employment in the State increased from 10.89 lakh in March, 2009 to 11.14 lakh in March, 2010, recording an increase of 2.3%. In Public Sector employment increased by 0.8% while in Private Sector employment increased by 3.7%. The State had a share of 3.88% of all India employment.

#### **Meghalaya**

3.14 Total employment in this State in organised sector increased from 0.41 lakh in March, 2009 to 0.43 lakh in March, 2010 recording an increase at the rate of 6.7%. Employment in Public Sector recorded an increase of 2.6% while in Private Sector employment shown an increase of 42.4%. The State had a 0.15% share in all India employment of the organised sector.

#### <u>Manipur</u>

3.15 Total employment in the State in the organised sector had been order of 0.79 lakh. Employment in Public Sector (0.76 lakh) and in Private Sector (0.03 lakh) remained static at the end of March, 2010. Hence, percentage change was not observed. Manipur had a meagre share of 0.27% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

#### Mizoram

3.16 Employment in the State was static at 0.42 lakh at the end of March, 2010 recording no change in total as well as Public and Private Sectors employment. The State's share in all India organised sector employment was only 0.14%.

#### **Nagaland**

3.17 Total employment in the organised sector increased from 0.76 lakh at the end of March, 2009 to 0.79 lakh at the end of March, 2010. The employment in the Public Sector increased by 3.4% whereas in Private Sector it increased by 3.5%. Nagaland had a small share of 0.27% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

#### **Tripura**

3.18 Employment in the State had recorded a decrease of 2.4% at the end of March, 2010. In absolute terms total employment was 1.44 lakh at the end of March, 2009 while it was 1.41 lakh at the end of March, 2010. Employment in Public and Private Sectors recorded 1.37 lakh and 0.04 lakh respectively during the same period. Tripura contributed only 0.49% in the total organised sector employment at all India level.

#### **EASTERN ZONE**

#### Bihar

3.19 Total employment in the organised sector in the State decreased from 4.30 lakh at the end of March, 2009 to 4.23 lakh at the end of March, 2010, showing a decrease of 1.7%. There was a decrease of employment in Public Sector by 1.8% and in Private Sector there was a decrease of 0.6%. The State's share was 1.47% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

#### Orissa

3.20 Total employment in the organised sector increased from 7.15 lakh in March, 2009 to 7.27 lakh in March, 2010 recording an increase of 1.7%. The employment in Public Sector marginally decreased by 0.4% while in Private Sector it showed a positive growth of 14.1%. The share of the State was 2.53% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

#### West Bengal

3.21 The organised sector employment in the State decreased from 19.34 lakh in March, 2009 to 19.27 lakh in March, 2010 recording a decrease of 0.3%. Employment in Public Sector has gone down by 1.5% while employment in Private Sector went up by 1.4%. The overall employment in the State accounted for 6.71% of the total organised sector employment at the all-India level.

#### <u>Jharkhand</u>

3.22 The employment of this State increased from 15.55 lakh at the end of March, 2009 to 16.08 lakh at the end of March, 2010 recording an increase of 3.4%. The employment in Public Sector increased by 2.3% while in Private Sector it showed a growth of 7.9%. Jharkhand had a share of 5.60% in all India organized sector employment.

#### **WESTERN ZONE**

#### <u>Gujarat</u>

3.23 Employment in the organised sector in the State was 19.05 lakh in March, 2009 as compared to 19.82 lakh in March, 2010. The increase in the organised sector employment was 4.0% during the period under review. There was a decrease of 1.6% in employment in the Public Sector whereas Private Sector employment increased by 8.1%. The total organised sector employment in the State accounted for 6.90% of the total employment in the organised sector at the all-India level.

#### <u>Maharashtra</u>

3.24 Employment in the organised sector in the State increased from 41.22 lakh in March, 2009 to 42.55 lakh in March, 2010 showing an increase of 3.2%. In the Public Sector the decrease in employment was 2.0% due to V.R.S. and retirements whereas employment in Private Sector increased by 8.8% since special drive of new establishments search was conducted during the year 2009-10. The total organised sector employment in the State constituted 14.82% of the total organised sector employment at the all-India level during the period under review.

#### <u>Goa</u>

3.25 The total organised sector employment had gone up from 1.38 lakh at the end of March, 2009 to 1.40 lakh at the end of March, 2010 reflecting an increase of 1.3%. In Public Sector the increase in employment was 0.9% whereas in Private Sector the employment increased by 1.8%. The State accounted for only 0.49% of the total organised sector employment at the all-India level.

#### Daman & Diu

3.26 The total organised sector employment in the Union Territory of Daman & Diu remained static at 15 thousand in March, 2010 over March, 2009. The Union Territory contributed the lowest 0.05% in the total organised sector employment at the all India level.

#### **SOUTHERN ZONE**

#### Andhra Pradesh

3.27 Employment in the organised sector in the State increased from 20.76 lakh at the end of March, 2009 to 21.82 lakh at the end of March, 2010 recording an increase of 5.1%. The Public Sector employment had registered a growth of 7.0% while in the Private Sector employment increased by 1.6%. In all India employment figures, the State accounted for 7.6% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

#### Karnataka

3.28 Organised sector employment in the State went up from 22.34 lakh in March, 2009 to 22.85 lakh in March, 2010 showing a rise of 2.3%. Employment in the Public Sector increased by 0.9% while in Private Sector showed an increase of 3.5%. Karnataka contributed 7.96% in the total organised sector employment at the all India level.

#### <u>Kerala</u>

3.29 The total organised sector employment in the State declined 11.32 lakh in March, 2009 to 11.11 lakh in March, 2010 showing a decrease of 1.8%. In the Public Sector the employment decreased by 0.1% and in Private Sector it recorded a decrease of 3.9%. Kerala contributed 3.87% in the total organised sector employment at the all India level.

#### **Puducherry**

3.30 The total employment in the organised sector remained static at 69 thousand at the end of March, 2010 over March, 2009. The overall employment in the Union Territory was 0.24% of the all India employment in the organised sector.

#### Tamil Nadu

3.31 In this State, organised sector employment increased from 23.62 lakh in March, 2009 to 23.65 lakh in March, 2010 indicating marginal increase of 0.1%. There was an increase of employment in Private Sector by 2.3%. whereas the employment in the Public Sector decreased by 1.1%. The proportion of organised sector employment as a whole to all-India employment was 8.24% during the year under review.

#### Andaman & Nicobar Islands

3.32 The Union Territory is outside the Zonal classification as per the States Reorganisation Act. The employment in the U.T. during the period under review decreased by 0.8%. The Public Sector employment decreased by 0.8% while in the Private Sector it marginally increased by 0.4%. The Union Territory accounted for 0.13% of the total organised sector employment at the all India Level.



#### **EMPLOYMENT IN INDUSTRIES/SERVICES**



It will be observed from table-8 that primary sector comprising agriculture, hunting, forestry & fishing and mining & quarrying industry division showed an over-all increase of 2.50% in employment in 2010 over 2009. Under this sector, agriculture, hunting, forestry and fishing recorded an increase of 2.04%, whereas the mining & quarrying division recorded an increase of 3.02% in 2010 over 2009.

- 4.2 An over-all increase in employment in secondary sector was 0.16% during 2010 over 2009. Under this Sector, employment in manufacturing recorded a decrease of -0.13% whereas electricity, gas & water recorded decline of -0.44%. The Construction industry showed an increase of 2.70%.
- 4.3 The overall increase in employment in the tertiary sector was 2.62% during 2010 over 2009. In this sector, a significant increase was recorded in Financing, Insurance, Real Estate & business services 11.14% followed by wholesale and retail trade and restaurants & hotels 4.80% and community, social and personal services 1.42% whereas transport storage and communication recorded a negative growth of -1.39%.


# WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT IN THE ORGANISED SECTOR

It comprises 20.4% of the total employment in the organised sector in the country as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2010. An overview of women's employment is given in the following table: -

It may be observed that women's employment in the organised sector went up from 49.53 lakh in 2000-01 to 58.59 lakh in 2009-10.



The increase in women employment during the year 2009-10 was of the order of 5.0% as compared to 1.23% increase during the preceding year 2008-09. It may be seen from the table-9 that the share of women's employment to total employment in the organised sector has risen steadily from 17.9% in 2000-01 to 20.4% in 2009-10.



It may be observed from the above table that out of the total 58.59 lakh women employees in the organised sector at the end of March, 2010, there were 31.96 lakh in the Public Sector and the remaining 26.63 lakh in the Private Sector. Women's employment in Public Sector and Private Sector registered an increase of 3.40% and 6.98% respectively during the period under reference. There was an overall increase of Women employment in both Public and Private Sector was 5.0%.



## BRANCH-WISE AND SIZE-WISE COMPOSITION OF WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT

5.4 The distribution of women's employment by different branches of Public Sector and by size of establishments in the Private Sector is presented in table-11 below.

The branch-wise distribution of women's employment shows an overall increase in employment in Public Sector (3.20%) in all constituents of Public Sectors except Central Government which recorded negative growth of women employment. The highest increase was recorded in State Government Quasi (7.60%) followed by Central Government Quasi (5.76%), Local Bodies (3.68%) and State Government (2.38%). Whereas Central Government recorded a negative growth (1.64%). There was an overall increase of (8.68%) in women's employment in the Private Sector. The women employment recorded a growth of (5.11%) in larger establishments and (41.69%) in smaller establishments during the period under review.

It may be observed from the above table that women's employment had increased in all Zones except A & N Islands. The highest increase was recorded in Western Zone (18.77%) followed by Central Zone (3.90%), Northern Zone (3.71%), Eastern Zone (1.89%), Southern Zone (1.39%) and North Eastern Zone(1.23%). A&N Islands recorded a negative growth of (0.29%).

#### **WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT IN STATES/UNION TERRITORIES**

The distribution of women employees by States/UTs cross-classified by Public and Private Sectors as on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2009 and 2010 is contained in Annexure-X. It may be observed that women employment had gone down in the States/UTs of Chattisgarh (1.24%), Kerala (1.99%), Bihar (0.71%) and A&N Islands (0.29%) [which is outside the scheme of zonal classification]. There was a significant and substantial growth of women employment in Maharashtra (25.73%) followed by Himachal Pradesh (16.77%), Uttarakhand (14.82%) and Meghalaya (9.31%).



## **WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT IN INDUSTRIES**



An analysis of data on women's employment contained in table-13 reveals that there was an overall increase in women employment in industries. Mining & Quarrying recorded highest increase of (33.60%) followed by Electricity, Gas & Water (12.77%), Construction (12.74%), Financing, Insurance, Real Estate and Business Services (10.35%), Whole sale and Retail Trade and Restaurant and Hotels (8.34%), Community, Social & Personal Services (4.94%), Manufacturing (4.09%), Transport, Storage and Communication (3.69%) and Agriculture, Hunting, forestry and fishing recorded (1.80%).
