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
PREFACE

This publication of Employment Review is 33rd in the series of its annual issues being prepared and published by the Directorate General of Employment and Training in the Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India. The information contained in this review is based on data collected through the network of Employment Exchanges in the country under the Employment Market Information (EMI) Programme of the D.G.E.&T., which is a vital source of employment data in the organised sector of our economy.

This Review focuses on the employment situation that prevailed in the organised sector from March 2003 to March 2006 and the same has been analysed multi dimensionally by incorporating various factors of employment branch-wise, size-wise, zone-wise, State-wise, industry services sector-wise, etc. Such data will be of great help in the areas of vocational guidance, educational planning, training, manpower planning and monitoring of regular employment generation in the organised sector.

I take this opportunity to express my sincere thanks to State Directorates of Employment and employers for their support in this endeavour.

I place on record my appreciation of work done by the officers & staff of EMI Section and Data Processing Unit of Directorate General of Employment & Training for accomplishing this task under the overall guidance and supervision of Deputy Director General(Employment).

HIGHLIGHTS

- The present Employment Review is 33rd in the series of its Annual Employment Reviews being published by the Directorate General of Employment and Training (DGE&T), Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India, and pertains to the years 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2006 ending 31st March of each year. This Review is based on the information collected through a network of Employment Exchanges in the country under the Employment Market Information (EMI) Programme of the DGE&T, which was initiated more than four decades ago.

COVERAGE OF EMI PROGRAMME

- The EMI Programme relates to the "Organised Sector" of economy. This organised sector covers all establishments in the public sector, irrespective of their size and non-agricultural establishments in the private sector employing 10 or more persons. Information in respect of all the public sector establishments and non-agricultural establishments in the private sector employing 25 or more persons is collected statutorily under the provisions of the Employment Exchanges (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) Act, 1959 and information from smaller non-agricultural establishments in the private sector employing 10-24 persons is collected on voluntary basis.

ESTABLISHMENTS IN ORGANISED SECTOR

- There were 3.02 lakh establishments on the Employer's Register of Employment Exchanges at the end of March 2006. Of these 1.74 lakh were in the public sector and remaining 1.27 lakh in private sector. There was increase in the number of establishments in both public sector and private sector. It has registered an overall increase of 2.8 percent during the period 2005-06. The public sector establishments increased from 1.72 lakh at the end of March 2005 to 1.74 lakh at the end of March 2006 recording an increase of 1.2 percent. All constituents of public sector except Central Government recorded an increase in the number of establishments. Number of establishments in Central Government in 2006 remained constant as compared to 2005. The increase of establishments in the private sector was of the order of 5.0 percent. The increase of larger establishments and smaller establishments were recorded as 4.8 percent and 5.1 percent respectively.

EMPLOYMENT IN THE ORGANISED SECTOR

- Employment in the organised sector has gone up from 264.58 lakh in March 2005 to 269.93 lakh in March 2006 recording an increase of 2.02 percent. Public and private sectors employment showed an increase of 1.01 and 4.18 percent respectively during 2005 & 2006. Employment in the private sector has risen significantly as compared to public sector.

EMPLOYMENT IN DIFFERENT ZONES/REGIONS

- During 2005-2006, Southern Zone and Central Zone recorded a negative growth (0.9 % and 0.2%) in employment. There was an increasing trend of employment in North Eastern Zone (7.3%) followed by Eastern Zone (4.2%), Western Zone (2.7%) and Northern Zone (2.0%).

EMPLOYMENT IN DIFFERENT INDUSTRY DIVISIONS

- During 2005-2006 as would be observed from the results shown in Table 8, there was a decrease in employment in transport, storage and communication (2.2%) whereas there was an increasing trend of employment in mining and quarrying (13.5%), financing, insurance, real estate and business services (6.4%), agriculture, hunting, forestry & fishing (2.8%), wholesale & retail trade and restaurants & hotels (2.0%), community, social & personal services (1.9%), construction (1.4%), manufacturing (0.9%) and electricity, gas and water(0.2%).

WOMEN EMPLOYMENT

- Employment of women in organised sector went up from 50.16 lakh in March 2005 to 51.21 lakh in March, 2006 registering an increase of 2.1 percent. Women's employment in public and private sector recorded an increase of 2.8% and 1.1% respectively during 2005&2006.

CHAPTER-I

EMPLOYMENT MARKET INFORMATION PROGRAMME

OBJECTIVES

- 1.1. The main objectives of Employment Market Information (EMI) Programme are :-
- I) to provide information at short intervals about the structure of employment in public and private sectors at the area, state and national levels and also to monitor changes in the levels of employment.
 - II) to present occupational composition and educational profile of employees in the public and private sector establishments.
 - III) to identify occupations which are characteristic to a given industry.
 - IV) to assess manpower shortages in organised sector.
 - V) to make available information required to improve and add to the services offered by the National Employment Service.
 - VI) to monitor the progress in generating employment during the Five Year Plans.

COVERAGE

- 1.2. EMI programme was initiated in the year 1955 as a Pilot Project in Delhi, which was subsequently extended to selected areas (Districts) in various States during the Second Five-Year Plan period. The Programme has got statutory base with the enactment of the Employment Exchanges (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) Act, 1959. The data collected under the EMI programme covers only the organised sector of the economy which inter-alia covers all establishments in the public sector irrespective of their size and non-agricultural establishments in the private sector employing 10 or more persons. While the information from non-agricultural establishments in the private sector employing 25 or more persons is collected under the provisions of EE (CNV) Act, 1959, data from the establishments employing 10-24 persons are collected on a voluntary basis.
- 1.3. Under the EMI programme collection of data is done following the "establishment reporting system". The establishments are required to furnish, at regular intervals, details about the number of persons they employ by gender, vacancies that have occurred and the type of persons, which are in short supply. This information relates only to 'Employers' and 'Employees'. Employers include Owners, Proprietors, Managers, Working Partners, Directors of Firms/Companies who work full time for the firms/companies.

GEOGRAPHICAL COVERAGE

- 1.4. EMI Programme is being implemented in all the States and Union Territories of the country except Arunachal Pradesh, Sikkim, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Lakshadweep. The programme could not be extended to these States/UTs so far due to administrative reasons. The smaller establishments employing 10-24 persons in private sector in metropolitan areas of greater Mumbai and Kolkata are also not being covered owing to administrative reasons.

REFERENCE PERIOD

- 1.5. EMI data is furnished by the establishments through ER-I return. The form ER-I is used for the collection of information from the establishments at quarterly intervals ending 31st March, 30th June, 30th September and 31st December of each year

ORGANISATION OF THE PROGRAMME

- 1.6. The information collected through ER-I return is scrutinised, tabulated and analysed at the area, State and national level. The Employment Exchanges prepare Area Employment Market Reviews to indicate employment situation in the organised sector within the district. The State Directors of Employment also prepare State level Employment Reviews showing employment situation prevailing at the State level. At the national level, Employment Reviews are prepared annually by the Directorate General of Employment and Training projecting the overall picture of employment in the organised sector in different States/UTs. The present Employment Review provides information regarding employment in the organised sector for the period ending 31st March 2003 to 31st March 2006. The National Industrial Classification (NIC) 1998 was followed in classifying the employment data by industries.

LIMITATIONS OF EMI DATA

- 1.7. **EMI Programme does not cover: -**
- a) Employment in un-organized sector.
 - b) Self-employment
 - c) Part-time employment
 - d) Employment in agricultural and allied establishments, which furnish employment returns only on voluntary basis.
 - e) Employment in household sector and non-agricultural establishments employing less than 10 workers in private sector
 - f) Employment in Defence Forces.
 - g) Employment in Indian Embassies and Missions abroad.

Other limitations of EMI Programme are: -

- a) The frame of establishments maintained at local Employment Exchange may not be comprehensive in certain cases due to non-inclusion of new and emerging establishments
- b) There is an element of estimation of employment in respect of non-responding establishments.
- c) Employment created under various beneficiary oriented employment generation schemes/programmes might be erroneously reported under the EMI Programme.

**COVERAGE OF ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE ORGANISED SECTOR AT THE
END OF MARCH, 2006.**

- 1.8. On the basis of information furnished by the Directorates of Employment of various States/Union Territories(excluding Jammu & Kashmir, Meghalaya, Mizoram and Daman & Diu) there were 2.97 lakh establishments borne on the Employers' Register as on 31st March 2006. Of these, the required employment returns were rendered by 2.03 lakh establishments both in public and private sectors. The rate of response works out to be 68.2% during the year 2005-06.
- 1.9. The public sector comprises establishments of Central Government, State Governments, Quasi-Government (Central), Quasi-Government (State) and Local Bodies. Under private sector, the establishments are grouped on the basis of number of persons employed therein. Establishments employing 25 or more persons are categorised as larger establishments and those employing 10-24 persons are termed as smaller establishments.

1.10. It is observed from the above table that out of the total of about 1.70 lakh establishments in public sector 73.0% rendered the returns whereas in private sector out of 1.27 lakh establishments 61.8 % rendered the returns. The analysis of the rate of response reveals that in public sector the highest number (75.2%) of establishments in Quasi Government (States) rendered the employment returns followed by State Govts. (75.0%), Local Bodies (73.8%), Quasi-Govt. (Central) (69.5%) and Central Govt establishments (63.6%). In the private sector, 68.8% of the Larger Establishments and 56.0% of the Smaller Establishments had furnished the employment returns for the period ending March, 2006.

BRANCH-WISE & SIZE-WISE DISTRIBUTION OF ESTABLISHMENTS

1.11. Table-2 below presents the distribution of establishments by different branches of public and private sectors as on 31st March 2003 to 31st March, 2006.

1.12. It is seen from the above table that there was an increase in the number of establishments in all branches of the public sector except Central Government establishments wherein growth of establishments decreased between 2003&2004 but remained static during the period 2005 & 2006. Establishments in the private sector also maintained positive growth.

COVERAGE OF ESTABLISHMENTS IN DIFFERENT ZONES / REGIONS :

1.13. The entire country has been divided into six Zones / Regions, viz., Northern Zone, Central Zone, Eastern Zone, North-Eastern Zone, Western Zone and Southern Zone. The Andaman & Nicobar Islands is outside the scheme of Zonal Councils embodied in the States Reorganisation Act, 1956. Table-3 shows the number of establishments in the six zones and in the Union Territories of A & N Islands.

The above table reveals that the highest percentage increase of establishments in the organised sector in 2006 over 2005 was recorded in the Western Zone (7.8%) followed by Eastern Zone (5.6%) Southern Zone (1.4%), Northern Zone (0.7.1%), Central Zone (0.2%) and North Eastern Zone (0.2.%). There was a decrease of 16.7% in Andaman & Nicobar which is kept outside the Zonal classification. The number of establishments according to the States/Union Territory Administrations is contained in Annexure-I.

CHAPTER -II

EMPLOYMENT IN ORGANISED SECTOR

- 2.1 During the period under review (2005-2006), employment in organised sector showed an increase of 2.02%. In absolute terms, employment in the organised sector increased from 264.58 lakh at the end of March 2005 to 269.93 lakh at the end of March 2006.
- 2.2 The sector-wise break-up of employment from 31st March 2003 to 31st March, 2006 and percentage change is shown in the following table:

It is revealed from the data contained in the table-4 above that employment in the public sector recorded an increase of 1.01% in 2006 over the year 2005. Private sector employment has also shown a growth of 4.18% during the same period. The overall increase was 2.02%.

EMPLOYMENT IN DIFFERENT BRANCHES OF PUBLIC SECTOR :

2.3 The distribution of employment in different branches of the public sector as on 31st March, 2003 to 31st March, 2006 is indicated in table-5 below:

An analysis of employment in 2006 over 2005 of different branches of the public sector revealed that the increase in employment was recorded in all the branches of public sector except Central Government and Quasi Government (State) wherein employment decreased by 2.68% and 0.97% respectively. The maximum increase (5.62%) was recorded in Quasi Government (Central) followed by State Governments (1.37%) and Local Bodies (0.02%).

EMPLOYMENT IN PRIVATE SECTOR

- 2.4 Employment in the private sector is classified by size of establishments. On this basis, the break-up of employment in the private sector by size of establishments is shown in the following table-6.

It may be observed from the table-6 that employment in larger establishments in the private sector has increased by 4.21% and in smaller establishments by 3.98% as on 31st March 2006 as compared to corresponding period of previous year. The overall increase in employment in the private sector was of the order of 4.18% during the period under review. Overall employment trend shows rise in employment scenario in private sector except in 2004 which is in consonance with growth in economy.

ZONE-WISE / REGION-WISE EMPLOYMENT IN THE ORGANISED SECTOR
 2.5 Table-7 below provides the distribution of employment classified by Zones/Regions:

The above table depicts the zone wise trend in employment in organised sector. There was a decrease of 0.9 percent and 0.2 percent in employment in Southern zone and Central zone respectively during 2006 over 2005. Among others zones maximum increase was recorded in Eastern zone (7.3%), followed by Northern Eastern zone (4.2%), Western zone (2.7%) and Northern zone (2.0%).

CHAPTER-III

EMPLOYMENT IN STATES AND UNION TERRITORIES

3.1 Employment in the organised sector in the country is spread over 31 States/Union Territories. Rest of the States/UTs have not been covered under the programme. Analysis of data with regard to employment in the organised sector by different Zones/Regions has already been made in Chapter II. Each Zone/Region has a group of contiguous States/Union Territories. The main focus of analysis is on the trend of employment in the organised sector in various States/Union Territories under each Zone/Region. Employment in different States/Union Territories under each of the six Zone is shown in Annexure III.

NORTHERN ZONE

Haryana

3.2 Total Employment in the State increased from 6.48 lakh in March 2005 to 6.49 lakh in March 2006 recording an increase of 0.2%. Employment increased from 2.58 lakh to 2.61 lakh i.e. 1.3% in the private sector. Public sector in the State during the period under review 2005&2006 recorded a decrease of 0.5% only. The State had a share of 2.43% in all India employment in the organised sector.

Punjab

3.3 Employment in the State increased from 7.73 lakh to 8.37 lakh in March 2006 showing an increase of 8.3% over 2005. Employment in public sector increased from 5.20 lakh to 5.54 lakh (6.6%). Private sector also recorded an increase from 2.53 lakh to 2.83 lakh (11.7%). The share of employment in Punjab was 3.14% of the total employment in the organized sector at the end of March 2006.

Himachal Pradesh

3.4 Employment in the State decreased from 3.17 lakh to 3.15 lakh in March 2006 showing a decrease of 0.6%. Employment had increased in private sector by 10.6% and the public sector recorded a decrease of 3.2% during the period under review (2005&2006). Himachal Pradesh had a share of 1.18% in all India employment at the end of March 2006.

Chandigarh

3.5 Total employment in the Union Territory declined from 0.89 lakh at the end of March 2005 to 0.88 lakh at the end of March 2006. Employment in both public and private sectors decreased by 1.4% and 1.1% respectively during 2005&2006. The Union Territory contributed only 0.33% of the total organised sector employment at all India level.

Delhi

- 3.6 Employment in the Union Territory in the organised sector, had decreased from 8.31 lakh at the end of March 2005 to 8.26 lakh at the end of March 2006, reflecting a decrease of 0.6%. In the public sector the employment decreased by 1.6% while in the private sector it went up by 2.2%. The Union Territory contributed 3.10% to the total organised sector employment at the all India level.

Rajasthan

- 3.7 Employment in the State increased from 11.81 lakh in March 2005 to 12.05 lakh in March 2006 registering a growth of 2.1%. In public sector, employment increased by 1.5% whereas private sector employment recorded an increase of 4.0%. The share of the State in all-India employment was 4.52% as at the end of March 2006.

Jammu & Kashmir

- 3.8 Total employment as well as employment in public & private sectors remained static at 2.10, 2.00 and 0.11 lakh respectively in the State at the end of March 2006. The state had a share of 0.78% of all India employment.

CENTRAL ZONE

Madhya Pradesh

- 3.9 Total employment in Madhya Pradesh decreased from 10.71 lakh in March 2005 to 10.57 lakh in March 2006 recording a decrease of 1.3%. Public sector employment had gone down from 9.15 lakh to 9.06 lakh registering a fall of 1.0% as well as private sector also recorded a decrease in employment of 3.0%. The State had a share of 3.92% of all-India employment in March 2006.

Chhattisgarh

- 3.10 The total employment in the organised sector was marginally increased by 0.3% during 2006 over 2005. In public and private sectors employment was 3.09 lakh and 0.32 lakh respectively. Public sector employment increased by 0.4% whereas private sector recorded a decrease of 0.3% in its employment. The Chhattisgarh State had a share of 1.26% in all India employment as on 31st March 2006.

Uttar Pradesh

- 3.11 Total employment in the State increased from 20.88 lakh in March 2005 to 20.90 lakh in March 2006 recording an increase at the rate of 0.1%. The public sector recorded a decrease at the rate of 0.9% in its employment while in the private sector employment went up by 3.9%. The State accounted for a share of 7.74% of all-India employment at the end of March 2006.

Uttarakhand

- 3.12 The total employment in the State increased from 2.61 lakh in March 2005 to 2.64 lakh in March 2006 recording an increase of 1.0%. The public sector and private sector recorded increase at the rate of 1.1% and 0.2% respectively. The State contributed only 0.98% of the total organised sector employment at all India level.

NORTH-EASTERN ZONE

Assam

- 3.13 Total employment in the State had increased from 11.12 lakh in March 2005 to 11.51 lakh in March 2006, recording an increase of 3.5%. In the public sector employment went down by 1.4% while in private sector employment increased by 8%. The State had a share of 4.27% of all India employment.

Meghalaya

- 3.14 Total employment in this State in organised sector had been of the order of 0.82 lakh. Employment in public sector (0.73 lakh) and private sector (0.09 lakh) remained static in the State at the end of March 2006. Hence, percentage change was not observed. The State had a 0.30% share in all India employment of the organised sector.

Manipur

- 3.15 Employment in the State declined from 0.81 lakh to 0.79 lakh at the end of March 2006 over March 2005. Total decrease in employment was 2.1%. The public sector employment decreased by 2.5% and private sector was increased by 7.9%. Manipur had a meagre share of 0.29% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

Mizoram

- 3.16 Employment in the State was static (0.42 lakh) at the end of March 2006, recording no change in total as well as public and private sectors employment. The State's share in all India organised sector employment was only 0.15%.

Nagaland

3.17 Total employment in the organised sector reflected an increase from 0.72 to 0.76 lakh in 2005&2006. Total employment was increased by 5.3% whereas public sector by 5.3% and private sector by 4.5%. Nagaland had a small share of 0.28% in the total organised sector employment in the country

Tripura

3.18 Employment in the State had recorded appreciable growth of 18.4% at the end of March 2006 over March 2005. In absolute terms total employment was 1.46 lakh at the end of March 2006 over 1.23 lakh at the end of March, 2005. Tripura contributed only 0.54% in the total organised sector employment at all India level. Public and private sectors employment was 1.34 lakh and 0.12 lakh respectively during the same period.

EASTERN ZONE

Bihar

3.19 Total employment in the organised sector in the State had gone down from 5.27 lakh at the end of March 2005 to 4.31 lakh at the end of March 2006, showing a decrease of 18.3%. There was a decrease of employment in public as well as private sectors by 17.9% and 23.9% respectively. The State's share was 1.60% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

Orissa

3.20 Total employment in the organised sector in the State decreased from 7.50 lakh in March 2005 to 7.38 lakh in March 2006, recording a decrease of 1.6%. The decrease in employment was of the order of 1.8% and 0.5% in public and private sectors respectively. The share of the State was 2.73% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

West Bengal

3.21 The organised sector employment in the State decreased from 20.39 lakh in March 2005 to 20.30 lakh in March 2006, recording a decrease of 0.4%. Employment in public sector has gone down by 2.8% but however employment in private sector went up by 3.6%. The overall employment in the State accounted for 7.52% of the total organised sector employment at the all-India level.

Jharkhand

- 3.22 The employment of this State increased from 10.42 lakh at the end of March, 2005 to 14.77 lakh at the end of March, 2006 recording an appreciable growth of 41.7%. The growth of employment in the public and private sector was recorded as 34.7% and 83.4% respectively. Jharkhand had a share of 5.47% in all India organised sector employment.

WESTERN ZONE

Gujarat

- 3.23 Employment in the organised sector in the State was 17.60 lakh in March, 2006 as compared to 16.94 lakh in March 2005. The increase in the organised sector employment was 3.9% during the period under review. There was an increase of 8.6% in employment in the private sector whereas public sector employment marginally decreased by 0.9%. The total organised sector employment in the State accounted for 6.52% of the total employment in the organised sector at the all-India level.

Maharashtra

- 3.24 Employment in the organised sector in the State increased from 35.41 lakh in March 2005 to 36.07 lakh in March 2006 showing an increase of 1.6%. In the public sector the increase in employment was 0.1% whereas employment in private sector increased by 4.6% during the period under review. The total organised sector employment in the State constituted 13.36% of the total organised sector employment at the all-India level during the period under review.

Goa

- 3.25 The total organised sector employment had gone up from 1.12 lakh at the end of March, 2005 to 1.27 lakh at the end of March 2006 reflecting an increase of 13.6%. In public and private sector the increase in employment was of the order of 15.9% and 9.7% respectively. The State accounted for only 0.47% of the total organised sector employment at the all-India level.

Daman & Diu

- 3.26 The total organised sector employment in the Union Territory of Daman & Diu remained static at 15 thousand in March 2006 over March, 2005. The Union Territory contributed of the lowest (0.05%) in the total organised sector employment at the all India level.

CHAPTER-IV

EMPLOYMENT IN INDUSTRIES/SERVICES

4.1 A broad picture about the structure of employment in the organised sector, in different industries/services grouped under primary, secondary and tertiary sectors as on 31st March, 2003 to 31st March 2006 is presented in the following table: -

Jharkhand

- 3.22 The employment of this State increased from 10.42 lakh at the end of March, 2005 to 14.77 lakh at the end of March, 2006 recording an appreciable growth of 41.7%. The growth of employment in the public and private sector was recorded as 34.7% and 83.4% respectively. Jharkhand had a share of 5.47% in all India organised sector employment.

WESTERN ZONE

Gujarat

- 3.23 Employment in the organised sector in the State was 17.60 lakh in March, 2006 as compared to 16.94 lakh in March 2005. The increase in the organised sector employment was 3.9% during the period under review. There was an increase of 8.6% in employment in the private sector whereas public sector employment marginally decreased by 0.9%. The total organised sector employment in the State accounted for 6.52% of the total employment in the organised sector at the all-India level.

Maharashtra

- 3.24 Employment in the organised sector in the State increased from 35.41 lakh in March 2005 to 36.07 lakh in March 2006 showing an increase of 1.6%. The total organised sector employment in the State constituted 13.36% of the total organised sector employment at the all-India level during the period under review.

Goa

- 3.25 The total organised sector employment had gone up from 1.12 lakh at the end of March, 2005 to 1.27 lakh at the end of March 2006 reflecting an increase of 13.6%. In public and private sector the increase in employment was of the order of 15.9% and 9.7% respectively. The State accounted for only 0.47% of the total organised sector employment at the all-India level.

Daman & Diu

- 3.26 The total organised sector employment in the Union Territory of Daman & Diu remained static at 15 thousand in March 2006 over March, 2005. The Union Territory contributed of the lowest (0.05%) in the total organised sector employment at the all India level.

SOUTHERN ZONE

Andhra Pradesh

- 3.27 Employment in the organised sector in the State had gone down from 20.43 lakh at the end March 2005 to 19.85 lakh at the end of March 2006 recording a decrease of 2.8%. The public/private sectors employment had registered a fall of 0.5% and 7.8% in employment respectively. In the all India employment figures, the State accounted for 7.63% and 6.77% in the public and private sector respectively and 7.35% in the total organised sector employment in the country.

Karnataka

- 3.28 Organised sector employment in the State went up from 18.62 lakh in March 2005 to 19.17 lakh in March 2006 showing a rise of 2.9%. Employment in the public sector had gone down by 0.7% and in the private sector growth was recorded as 7.7%. The share of Karnataka was 5.79% and 9.82% in all-India public and private sector employment respectively and 7.10% in the total organised sector employment at the all-India level.

Kerala

- 3.29 The total organised sector employment in the State went down from 11.40 lakh in March 2005 to 11.11 lakh in March 2006 showing a fall of 2.5%. The public sector employment slightly increased by 0.1% and the private sector recorded a decrease of 5.5%. Kerala contributed 4.12% in the total organised sector employment at the all India level.

Pondicherry

- 3.30 The total employment in the organised sector increased from 58 thousand at the end of March, 2005 to 62 thousand in March 2006 showing a rise of 7.4% during 2005&2006. Employment in public and private sectors had increased by 0.4% and 23.4% respectively. The overall employment in the Union Territory was 0.23% of the all India employment in organised sector.

Tamil Nadu

- 3.31 In this State, organised sector employment has gone down from 22.79 lakh in March, 2005 to 22.38 lakh in March, 2006 indicating a decrease of 1.8%. There was a decrease of employment in private sector and public sector to the extent of 4.1% and 0.6% respectively. The proportion of organised sector employment as a whole to all-India employment was 8.29% during the year under review.

Andaman & Nicobar Islands

3.32 The Union Territory is outside the Zonal classification as per the States Reorganisation Act. The employment in the State during the period under review almost remained static at 0.38 lakh showed low variation in employment at the end of March 2006 over March 2005. Total increase in employment was 1.6%. The public sector employment marginally increased from 0.35 lakh to 0.36 lakh whereas employment in private sector more or less remained static at 0.03 lakh during 2005&2006. The Union Territory accounted for 0.14% of the total organised sector employment at the All India Level.

CHAPTER-IV

EMPLOYMENT IN INDUSTRIES/SERVICES

- 4.1 A broad picture about the structure of employment in the organised sector, in different industries/services grouped under primary, secondary and tertiary sectors as on 31st March, 2003 to 31st March 2006 is presented in the following table: -

It will be observed from table-8 that primary sector comprising agriculture, hunting, forestry & fishing and mining & quarrying industry division showed an over-all increase of 7.3% in employment in 2006 over 2005. Under this sector, agriculture, hunting, forestry and fishing recorded an increase of 2.8%, whereas the mining & quarrying division recorded an increase of 13.5% in 2006 over 2005.

- 4.2 An over-all increase in employment in secondary sector was 0.8% during 2006 over 2005. Under this Sector, employment in manufacturing, construction and electricity, gas & water divisions showed a rise of 0.9%, 0.2% and 1.4% respectively.
- 4.3 The overall increase in employment in the tertiary sector was 1.7% during 2006 over 2005. In this sector a decline of 2.2% in employment was recorded in transport, storage & communication while financing, insurance, real estate & business services recorded a growth of 6.4% followed by 2.0% in wholesale and retail trade, hotel & restaurants and 1.9% in community, social & personal services.

CHAPTER-V

WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT IN THE ORGANISED SECTOR

- 5.1 Employment of women constitutes an important component of the organised sector employment in the country. The employment of women in the organised sector has gone up steadily over the last ten years. It comprises 19.0% of the total employment in the organised sector in the country as on 31-03-2006. An overview of women's employment is given in the following table: -

It may be observed from the above table that women's employment in the organised sector went up from 47.16 lakh in 1996-97 to 51.21 lakh in 2005-06.

- 5.2 The increase in women employment during the year 2005-06 was of the order of 2.1% as compared to 1.7% increase during the preceding year 2004-05. It may be seen from the table -9 that the share of women's employment to total employment in the organised sector has risen steadily from 16.5% in 1996-97 to 19.0% in 2005-06.

PATTERN OF WOMEN EMPLOYMENT

- 5.3 The employment of women in public and private sectors as on 31st March, 2003 to 2006 and percentage changes between two years i.e. 2006 over 2005 are presented in the following table-10.

It may be observed from the above table that out of the total 51.21 lakh women employees in the organised sector at the end of March 2006, 30.03 lakh were in the public sector and the remaining 21.18 lakh in the private sector. Women's employment in public sector and private sector registered an increase of 2.8 percent and 1.1 percent respectively during the period under reference.

BRANCH-WISE AND SIZE-WISE COMPOSITION OF WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT

The branch-wise distribution of women's employment shows an overall increase in employment in public sector except a decrease in Central Government and State Govt.(Quasi). The decrease in Central Govt. women employment was from 251.5 thousand in 2003 to 243.3 thousand in March, 2006. Similarly, the decrease from 257.8 to 247.4 thousand was observed in State Govt.(Quasi). The appreciable growth in women employment was recorded in Central Govt. (Quasi) (4.5%), State Government (3.4%), Local Bodies (2.4%) and State Govt. (Quasi) (1.1%) in public sector. There was an overall increase of 2.8 percent in women's employment in the public sector during the period under review. In the private sector, women's employment registered a marginal growth of 3.3% in "Smaller Establishments" and 0.8% in "Larger Establishments". The overall increase in women employment in private sector was 1.1% during the period under review.

It may be observed from the above table that women's employment had increased in all Zones except in the case of Southern Zone wherein employment decreased by 1.7. The highest increase was recorded in Eastern Zone (9.0%) followed by Northern Zone (5.5%) North-Eastern Zone (4.7%) Western Zone (4.3%) and Central Zone (2.2%). Women employment in Andaman & Nicobar Island, (which is out side the scheme of zonal classification) recorded an increase of 11.9%.

WOMEN'S EMPLOYMENT IN STATES/UNION TERRITORIES

5.6 The distribution of women employees by States/UTs. cross-classified by public and private sectors as on 31st March 2005 and 2006 is contained in Annexure IX. It may be observed that in the States/UTs. of Bihar (29.10%), Goa (23.20%), Andhra Pradesh (8.00%), Kerala (4.86%) Chandigarh (1.33%) and Madhya Pradesh (0.58%). Women employment had gone down. There was a significant and substantial growth of women employment noticed in Jharkhand (46.14%), Tripura(25.69%), Nagaland (14.97%), Punjab (13.68%), Uttaranchal (13.25%), Andaman & Nicobar (11.92%), Puducherry (10.85%), Rajasthan (8.02%), Maharashtra (5.94%), Orissa (5.85%), Assam(3.43%) and West Bengal (3.33%) during the period under review (2005-2006).

An analysis of data on women's employment contained in table-13 reveals that there was a decrease in women's employment in manufacturing (4.9%) and wholesale and retail trade and restaurant & hotels (2.0%). While there is an increase in other industry divisions, which were mining & quarrying (10.5%) followed by financing, insurance, real estate & business services (9.7%), community, social & personal services (3.5%), agriculture, hunting, forestry & fishing (2.9%), electricity, gas & water (1.3%) construction (0.6%) and transport storage & communication (0.2%).
