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Quarterly Bulletin on Employment and Unemployment Indicators

1. Introduction

1.1 Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) of NSO

1.1.1 Considering the importance of availability of labour force data at more frequent time intervals, National Statistical Office (NSO) launched Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) in April 2017. On the basis of PLFS, Quarterly Bulletins are brought out, corresponding to different quarters of the survey period, giving estimates of labour force indicators, viz., Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR), Worker Population Ratio (WPR), Unemployment Rate (UR), distribution of workers by broad status in employment and industry of work in the Current Weekly Status (CWS) for the urban areas. Ten Quarterly Bulletins corresponding to the quarter ending December 2018 to the quarter ending March 2021 have already been released.

Besides the Quarterly Bulletins, Annual Reports are brought out covering both rural and urban areas giving estimates of all important parameters of employment and unemployment in both usual status (ps+ss) and current weekly status (CWS). Three Annual Reports¹ corresponding to the periods July 2017 - June 2018, July 2018 - June 2019 and July 2019 - June 2020 have also been released.

This Bulletin for the quarter ending June 2021 is the eleventh in the series.

1.2 Indicators presented in this Bulletin

1.2.1 In this Bulletin indicators of employment and unemployment in current weekly status (CWS) are presented for the urban areas separately for the periods:

- April – June 2020
- July – September 2020
- October – December 2020
- January – March 2021
- April – June 2021

1.3 PLFS fieldwork during COVID-19 pandemic:

The fieldwork of PLFS was suspended first time from 18.03.2020 due to Covid-19 pandemic. The fieldwork of the pending samples for January - March 2020 and for April – June, 2020 was resumed on 1st June 2020. Due to the 2nd wave of Covid-19, the field work of PLFS was suspended from 19.04.2021 in most parts of the country. The field work was gradually resumed in the first week of June 2021 with due adherence to Covid related restrictions.

Although schedules were canvassed later, on both occasions of resumption of field work, the information was asked with respect to the actual reference period which would have been adopted if there were no pandemic. Thus, there was no break in the flow of information collected for any quarter except that informants were approached at a later date due to the unavoidable situation. Field work for collection of information in respect of the FSUs allotted for the quarter April-June 2021 was completed by 30.09.2021 for the first visit samples and by 30.06.2021 for revisit samples.

Since the resumption of fieldwork in June 2020, canvassing of revisit schedules was undertaken in telephonic mode as per actual reference periods of the samples. For about 94.23% of the revisit schedules for the period April-June, 2021, information was collected over the telephone. The telephonic mode was adopted in order to minimize the physical interaction with informants so as to contain spread of Covid virus and to cope up with pandemic related restrictions.

Some experiences and difficulties faced after resumption of field work in June 2021 are given below:

- i. Some informants hesitated in providing information to the Survey Enumerators during visits to the households for physical canvassing of the Schedules and were not willing to devote the requisite time due to the threat of Covid-19 pandemic. Informants were sensitised and motivated to provide information. However, this delayed the field work.
- ii. Some informants were reluctant to provide information (in respect of revisit Schedules) over telephone. In such cases, subsequent physical field visits were undertaken for collection of requisite data, which added to the delay in completion of field work, as public transport facility in most areas were limited during the survey work.
- iii. Pandemic related precautionary restrictions on movement, etc., continued for a long time even after the 2nd wave of Covid, in some Eastern and North Eastern States; and hence the field work got delayed. However, the canvassing was done with retrospective referencing in all the delayed samples.

These aspects may be kept in mind while using the estimates of PLFS for the concerned quarters.

2. Key findings

2.1 Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR) in current weekly status

2.1.1 Labour force refers to the part of the population which supplies or offers to supply labour for pursuing economic activities for the production of goods and services and therefore, includes both ‘employed’ and ‘unemployed’ persons. Labour Force Participation Rate (LFPR) is defined as the percentage of population in the labour force. Labour force according to *current weekly status* (CWS) is the number of persons either employed or unemployed on an average in a week of 7 days preceding the date of survey. In Statement 1, estimates of LFPR in CWS are presented.

2.2 Worker Population Ratio (WPR) in current weekly status

2.2.1 Worker Population Ratio (WPR) is defined as the percentage of workers in the population. The workforce measured in CWS gives the average picture of the workforce in a short period of one week during the survey period. The estimate of workforce in the CWS provides the number of persons who worked for at least 1 hour on any day during the 7 days preceding the date of survey. In Statement 2, estimates of WPR in current weekly status are presented.

2.3 Distribution of workers in current weekly status by broad status in employment

2.3.1 The workers in current weekly status are classified into three broad categories according to their status in employment. These broad categories are: (i) *self-employed*, (ii) *regular wage/salaried employee* and (iii) *casual labour*. Within the category of *self-employed* two sub-categories have been made as follows: (i) *own account worker and employer* combined together and (ii) *unpaid helper in household enterprises*. In Statement 3, distribution of the workers of age 15 years and above in CWS by status in employment are presented. It may be noted that self-employed persons who did not work either due to sickness or due to other reasons though they had self-employment work are included in column 4 of this Statement. Thus, the estimates given in column 4 may be higher than the sum of the estimates in column 2 and column 3.

2.4 Distribution of workers in current weekly status by broad industry of work

2.4.1 Three broad industries of work which have been considered here are agriculture sector (NIC-2008 codes 01-03), secondary sector including mining and quarrying (NIC-2008 codes 05-43) and tertiary sector (NIC-2008 codes 45-99). Distribution of workers of age 15 years and above in CWS, in these three broad industries of work are in Statement 4.

2.5 Unemployment Rate (UR) in current weekly status

2.5.1 *Unemployment rate (UR)* is defined as the percentage of unemployed persons in the *labour force*. The estimates of unemployed in CWS give an average picture of unemployment in a short period of 7 days during the survey period. According to the *current weekly status (CWS)* approach, a person was considered as unemployed in a week if he/she did not work even for 1 hour on any day during the reference week but sought or was available for work at least for 1 hour on any day during the reference week. In Statement 5, estimates of Unemployment Rate in CWS for the periods are presented.

3. Sample Size

3.1 Sample Size in urban areas in each of the survey period April – June 2020, July – September 2020, October – December 2020, January – March 2021 and April – June 2021:

In urban areas, a rotational panel sampling design was used and in this rotational panel scheme each selected household in urban areas is visited four times – one with first visit schedule and other three with revisit schedule. In the Table below, the sample size in terms of FSUs (Urban Frame Survey blocks), households and persons in urban areas is given, separately for each of the survey period April – June 2020, July – September 2020, October – December, 2020, January – March 2021 and April – June 2021. It may be noted that in each of these periods, besides the first visit sample (25 per cent of total sample size), samples in respect to three revisits (75 per cent of total sample size) were also surveyed.
