National Career Service

National Career Service is a Mission Mode Project launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on 20th July, 2015. It is a one-stop solution that provides a wide array of employment and career related services to the citizens of India. National Career Service is a vibrant platform which aims to transform and strengthen the public employment services in the country. It brings together Job Seekers, Employers, Skill Providers, Career Counsellors, Local Service Providers (LSP's), Career Centers, Placement Organizations, Households and Government Departments on a common platform through the efficient use of information technology.

- Easy accessibility of employment services like staffing, placement and recruitment to all the stakeholders
- Enhancing employability of the workforce by providing them information on training & skilling
- Provisioning of career counselling services
- NCS Portal provides links to Public Disclosure of scores and ranking of candidates in Government recruitment examinations
- Providing information related to job profiles, career paths & employers
- PAN verified institutions and rich database of job seekers
- Career planning and rich career content on over 3500 occupations across 52 sectors
- NCS has partnerships with various private organizations like TCS iON, Quess Corp, HireMee, CSCs, Microsoft etc.
- Around 200 Model Career Centers (MCCs) have been set up across the country till now
- National Career Service Centers for Differently Abled (NCSCs-DA) are being run by DGE across the country
- National Career Service Centers for SCs and STs (NCSC SCs/STs) for providing employment related training and guidance are also being run by DGE

As on 30th August, 2021, a total of 90,30,177 active jobseekers are registered on the NCS Portal. More than 1,62,800 employers are registered on the Portal and the active vacancies count as of the mentioned date is 1,87,672.

NCS-Microsoft Integration

Considering the huge demand for workforce trained on digital skills, National Career Service has joined hands with Microsoft, to train job-seekers registered on NCS Portal on digital skills, with a focus on rural and socially disadvantaged youth. The Training course named, Microsoft DigiSaksham is available free of cost for NCS registered Jobseekers.

Training Program Brief:

Microsoft DigiSaksham is a Virtual Instructor-led Training Program (that is supported by a Master Trainer and Subject Matter Expert) on "in demand" courses under Microsoft office and technologies. Program at the pilot stage includes courses, namely: Excel, Python, Azure, Java and Security Fundamentals. With further program enhancements over a period of time, more useful and professional learning courses on Digital skills shall be planned to be added under NCS-Microsoft Integration.

Under this training mode, an NCS registered jobseeker can access and learn from MCT (Microsoft Community Training) platform that has been integrated with NCS Portal.

In Person Training at Model Career Centers:

Apart from the above mentioned online training programs, there is also provision for Physical/Instructor led classroom training that will be delivered in batches through selected Model Career Centers.

NCS-Microsoft Integration

Process for undertaking NCS-Microsoft DigiSaksham Training Program

I. Target Audience for the Program:

- The Training Program targets jobseekers who are registered on NCS Portal and are from Rural, Semi-Urban and Socially Disadvantaged communities
- **Age-** 18+ years
- Educational qualification: 12th and above for Microsoft DigiSaksham and for in person training to happen at MCCs, minimum qualification requirement is Diploma, Graduation and above

II. Registration and Enrollment for the Program:

Step 1:

To register for the Training Program, visit Home Page of NCS Portal (www.ncs.gov.in)

Step 2:

Click on the button/tab given at the top of the NCS Home Page, naming "Microsoft DigiSaksham". When clicked, this will open a pop-up window with a link to undertake the course. Upon clicking the link, NCS Portal login screen will appear

Step 3:

Once logged in on NCS Portal as a jobseeker, begin registration for Microsoft Training Program by clicking on **Online Training>Microsoft DigiSaksham** from left navigation panel. Upon clicking the given course link from the given course page, you will be redirected to external login page where you need to enter your NCS User Name and Password again. Once correct NCS credentials have been entered, a registration page will open up with some pre-filled details and some details to be freshly filled in by the candidate.

Step 4:

Once candidate has registered for the Program, he/she will be able to view course of his choice under "My courses".

III. Program Completion Certification

Upon successful completion of DigiSaksham Training Program, user will be felicitated with a Certificate of Participation/Completion by Microsoft.

Microsoft will also provide Job placement assistance post successful completion of the instructor led classroom training that is to be conducted through selected Model Career Centers.



NCS New Features

NCS Portal is undergoing continuous enhancement of its user interface for best utilization of its Online Services and for better user experience. In the month of August, 2021 some key enhancements have been made in the Portal features for the Employer type Users.

For Employer Type Users-Sub User Feature Enhancement

Employer type users (Placement Organization/Government Department/Employer) registered on NCS Portal have the provision to create multiple sub-users (or recruiters) under their NCS account who can post jobs and take action on posted jobs by searching and shortlisting eligible candidates, scheduling interviews and closing jobs. So, in order to ease tracking and management of jobs' responses that are posted by respective sub-users that are there under an Employer's NCS account, NCS has created separate Jobs Dashboard for each sub-user with following features:

- i. The new Sub-user/Member's Jobs Dashboard will show the total count (of the jobs posted by himself alone) of Draft, Published, Expired and Closed jobs.
- ii. On the sub-user specific Jobs Dashboard, the jobs posted by that sub-user and their responses shall be made available. This has been done to help the sub-user to track the status and manage responses of the jobs posted by him without any mixing with jobs that are posted by other sub-users.
- iii. Having complete access to his Dashboard, a sub-user can perform Action of searching and shortlisting eligible candidates, Scheduling Interviews and closing jobs on Jobs posted by him. Related NCS notifications (through SMS/Email) would also be sent to that particular sub-user.

An organization's Primary or Owner user's Jobs Dashboard continues to show the total count of (jobs posted by all sub users under it) Draft, Published, Expired and Closed jobs. He can perform all the Actions like "Copy", "Edit", "Shortlist Profile", "Search Candidate", "Preview Job" and "Share Feedback" on all the jobs (posted by different sub-users under it) showing on his Job Dashboard.



IT and Communication sector being one of the largest Employer in the Private sector, around 16.6 lakh of total vacancies from IT and Communication sector have been reported to be mobilized on NCS Portal since the Project Inception till 30th August, 2021. Also, the count of Active vacancies on NCS Portal is high for IT related jobs and is found to be nearly 42,200 as on 30th August, 2021. The Bar graph shows some of the top IT related Job Titles against which maximum job vacancies have been mobilized on the NCS Portal (since inception) by its registered Employers. This is a key insight for IT and technical students professionals who are planning their careers in IT sector.

Glimpses of Job Fairs & Events

Amid the COVID-19 Pandemic, NCS has been continuously working to provide employment and career related services to its registered users. On one hand, NCS has been using its online Platform to conduct online Job Fairs & Career Events and on the other hand its wide network of Model Career Centers is also conducting on ground career events as and when feasible in the current pandemic situation. Glimpses of some of the major Career Events and Job Fairs are listed below:

Placement Drive by Model Career Center, District Employment Exchange, Tumkur, Karnataka

Model Career Center, District Employment Exchange, Tumkur conducted Placement Drive in association with TVS Electronics Limited at Company premises from 5th to 7th August, 2021. The Placement Drive was organized for the job role of Assembly Operator & Voice Process Executive for candidates with qualification, ITI (any trade), Graduation, Diploma & B.E. Around 14 candidates participated in the Placement Drive & 4 candidates got shortlisted for the final round of selection to happen soon.

Online Placement Drive by Model Career Center, Virudhunagar, Tamil Nadu

Model Career Center, District Employment and Career Guidance Center, Virudhunagar, Tamil Nadu organized an online Placement Drive through NCS Portal, on 6th August, 2021 for candidates with qualification ITI, 12th Pass, Diploma and Graduation. Around 3 companies participated in the online Placement Drive for hiring candidates under varied Job roles like Technician, Sales Person, Mechanic, Field Executive etc. In this Placement Drive, 28 candidates participated out of which 16 candidates got shortlisted and 4 candidates got provisionally selected. Final selection results will be declared soon by the Employer after completing subsequent interviews and document verification of the shortlisted candidates.

Placement Drive organized by Model Career Center, Banswara, Rajasthan

Model Career Center, Banswara organized a Placement Drive on 7th August, 2021 for company L & T Finance Services for the job role of Field Officer, requirement for which was, Graduate male candidates in the age group of 21 to 31 years. Around 60 candidates participated in the Placement Drive and 11 candidates got shortlisted in the first round of interview. Final round is scheduled to happen soon in the first week of September, 2021.



Glimpses of Job Fairs & Events

Placement Drive by Model Caree Center, Ferozepur, Punjab

Model Caree Center, Ferozepur, Punjab organized a Placement Drive for a leading Company for the job role of delivery boy on 9th August, 2021. Around 25 candidates with 12th pass qualification participated in the Placement Drive, out of which 5 candidates got provisionally selected.

Inaugural session of Youth Employability Training cum Placement Program by Model Career Center, Khammam, Telangana State

Model Career Center, District Employment Exchange, Khammam, Telangana State, in collaboration with TCS started Youth Employability Training cum Placement Program in online mode with the formal Program inauguration on 9th August, 2021. It is 100 hours of online Employability Training cum Placement Program that is targeting Graduate candidates below the age of 28 years, from SC/ST/OBC and economically backward classes who have passed out from non-engineering streams. So far around 36 candidates from across Telangana State (both male and female) have got enrolled in this program. It is a certificate Training Program where participants get Certificate of Program completion once they successfully complete the training. Its key focus areas are teaching Communicative English, Corporate etiquettes and soft skills, resume building and interview facing skills, analytical and reasoning skills and basic computer knowledge. Post the completion of Training Program, TCS will also provide job placement assistance to the Program beneficiaries through its industry connects.

Online Job Fair by Model Career Center, Ayodhya, Uttar Pradesh

The newly started Model Career Center at Regional Employment Office, Ayodhya organized an online Job Fair through NCS Portal on 10th August, 2021 for 10th, 12th and Graduate candidates in the age group of 18 to 35 years. Around 7 companies participated in this Job Fair with around 600 open positions for varied job roles like Sales, Marketing, Computer Operator, HR Executive etc. Approximately 400 candidates participated in this Job Fair and 47 candidates got provisionally selected.

Free Career Webinar by Model Career Center, Ahmedabad, Gujarat

Amid the job crisis situation created by the COVID pandemic, Model Career Center, Ahmedabad organized a webinar on Career guidance and NCS Portal awareness on 10th August, 2021. The intent was to give career guidance to participants with special focus on career services that are offered by NCS Portal. In the webinar, participants were given demo on how to use NCS Portal for availing its various career and Employment services especially the job search feature. Around 40 candidates attended the webinar, they appreciated the program content and found it quite informative.

Online Placement Drive organized by Model Career Center, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh

Model Career Center, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh organized an online Placement Drive through NCS Portal on 12th and 13th August, 2021 for Reliance Nippon Life Insurance Company Limited for the job role of Life Planning Officer. The Employer was looking for Graduate Female candidates with age 29 years and above to fill the mentioned job positions. More than 40 candidates participated in the Placement Drive and around 6 candidates got shortlisted for the final round of interview, the date for which is yet to be declared by the Employer.

National Institute for Career Service (NICS), Noida organized Online Training Program for staff members of National Career Service Centers (NCSCs) for Differently Abled (DA)

NICS, Noida organised online training programme for staff of NCSCs for DA (VRCs) on 17th and 18th Aug, 2021. In total, around 30 staff members from different NCSCs for DA situated across India participated in this training programme that was addressed by Smt. M. L. Gautam, Director I/C, NICS, Sh. R. Aswani Kumar, Joint Director, NICS and Mrs. Kanta, ADE, NICS. The session majorly covered valuable information on the topics like "Latest updates on NCS Portal", "Career Counselling Services on NCS Portal", "How to conduct online Job Fairs using NCS Portal", "Recruitment Practises in Private organization" etc.

In its ongoing training efforts, NICS also organized an Online Refresher Training Program on 26th and 27th August, 2021 for Employment Personnel from Jammu and Kashmir. The focus of training was "Self-Employment and Entrepreneurship Development" in which around 25 Employment Officers participated.
