



National Career Service

National Career Service is a Mission Mode Project launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on 20th July, 2015. It is a one-stop solution that provides a wide array of employment and career related services to the citizens of India. National Career Service is a vibrant platform which aims to transform and strengthen the public employment services in the country. It brings together Job Seekers, Employers, Skill Providers, Career Counsellors, Local Service Providers (LSP's), Career Centers, Placement Organizations, Households and Government Departments on a common platform through the efficient use of information technology.


- Easy accessibility of employment services like staffing, placement and recruitment to all the stakeholders
- Enhancing employability of the workforce by providing them information on training & skilling
- Provisioning of career counselling services
- NCS Portal provides links to Public Disclosure of scores and ranking of candidates in Government recruitment examinations
- Providing information related to job profiles, career paths & employers
- PAN verified institutions and rich database of job seekers
- Career planning and rich career content on over 3500 occupations across 52 sectors
- NCS has partnerships with various private organizations like TCS iON, Quess Corp, HireMee, CSCs, Microsoft etc.
- Around 200 Model Career Centers (MCCs) have been set up across the country till now
- National Career Service Centers for Differently Abled (NCSCs-DA) are being run by DGE across the country
- National Career Service Centers for SCs and STs (NCSC SCs/STs) for providing employment related training and guidance are also being run by DGE

As on 1st March, 2022, a total of 1,39,97,401 active jobseekers are registered on the NCS Portal. More than 1,81,600 employers are registered on the Portal and the active vacancies count as of the mentioned date is 2,64,831.



Above graph shows the gender wise percentage of new jobseekers registrations on NCS Portal under different qualification levels. It can be seen that around 50% and more of new jobseekers registrations on Portal across different qualification levels are of male candidates. For higher qualification like Graduation and above, female jobseekers also share more than 40% of total new jobseeker registrations on NCS Portal. Even for qualifications 10th and 12th pass, male and female ratio of new jobseeker registrations is good enough for employers who require both female and male candidates to fill their vacant job positions.

*Above graph does not include data of jobseekers who have not specified their Highest Qualification and/or Gender. It also does not show separate figures for Jobseekers in "Transgender" category as their registration figures are very low.

Above graph shows the gender wise percentage of new jobseekers registrations on NCS Portal under different age groups. It can be seen that the percentage of male jobseeker registrations are higher than female jobseekers across all age groups. But even female jobseekers have more than 30% share in new jobseeker registration numbers across all age groups. Age groups of 15 to 24 and 25 to 34 that are most active working age groups, account for more than 40% new female jobseekers registrations on NCS Portal.

*Above graph does not include data of jobseekers who have not specified their Age and/or Gender. It also does not show separate figures for Jobseekers in "Transgender" category as their registrations figures are very low.



Career Information-Agriculture Sector

Agriculture is the primary source of livelihood for about 58% of India's population. Agriculture and allied activities accounts for about 15.7 % of country's GDP and is estimated to employ about 124.7 million people as cultivators and 106.8 million as agricultural labour (Census 2001).



Besides this Agriculture Industry employs a large number of people in the Organized and the Unorganized sector. The Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) data shows that the share of the labor force engaged in agriculture rose to 45.6 per cent in 2019-20, up from 42.5 per cent in 2018-19. Agriculture Skill Council of India (ASCI) under the aegis of Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE) has been given the responsibility of transforming Indian Agriculture through developing the skills of country's manpower in emerging areas of agriculture.





The Bar graph shows some of the top Functional Areas in the sector of Agriculture and related activities, against which maximum job vacancies have been mobilized on the NCS Portal (since inception) by its registered Employers. It can be seen that the Functional area of Human Resources has maximum requirement in the Agriculture sector followed by Forestry and Fishing, Marketing and Sales, Livestock, Agriculture and Farm Production and Water Supply and Waste Management. This graph gives a good insight to the jobseekers who are planning their careers in the sector of Agriculture and related activities.

Series of career sessions by Model Career Center, Ahmedabad, Gujarat



Reports reveal that Model Career Center, Ahmedabad has been actively organizing career events and job fairs since it started its operations. 

Ministry of Labour and Employment

Meeting with Top Job Portals of the Country for strengthening the "Employment and Skilling Ecosystem"

The Ministry of Labour and Employment is implementing the National Career Service (NCS) Project as a Mission Mode Project for transformation of the National Employment Service to provide a variety of employment related services like job matching, career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses, apprenticeship, internships etc. The services under NCS are available online which was dedicated to the Nation by Hon'ble Prime Minister in 2015. All the services available in the portal are free of cost for all stake holders including jobseekers, employers, training providers and placement organizations. The NCS portals can be accessed directly or from Career Centres (Employment Exchanges), Common Service Centres, Post Office Network, mobile devices, cyber cafes etc.

Shri Sunil Barthwal, Secretary, Ministry of Labour and Employment held a meeting today i.e. 10th February 2022 with representatives of the top private Job Portals of the country for discussion towards strengthening the "Employment and Skilling Ecosystem" in India.

The Secretary, Labour & Employment briefed about the vision of the Ministry to strengthen the ecosystem to enhance job and skilling opportunities for its users and also informed the participants that the Udyam, e-Shram, NCS and ASEEM portals will be interlinked as per the Budget announcement made by the Honorable Minister of Finance.

The representatives from top private Job Portals like Naukri, Monster, LinkedIn, Indeed, TimesJobs, Quess Corp Limited, HT Shine, Freshersworld (A TeamLease Company), QuikrJobs, Portea, Freshers Live, HireMee, FirstJob enthusiastically participated in the meeting and appreciated the transformational vision of the Ministry of Labour and Employment.

Further, Secretary, Ministry of Labour and Employment informed that the top industry associations namely the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI) and the National Association of Software and Services Companies (NASSCOM) are also onboard on the theme of strengthening the "Employment and Skilling Ecosystem", in the country.


