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National Career Service is a Mission Mode Project launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi on 20th July, 2015. It is a one-stop solution that provides a wide array of employment and career related services to the citizens of India. National Career Service is a vibrant platform which aims to transform and strengthen the public employment services in the country. It brings together Job Seekers, Employers, Skill Providers, Career Counsellors, Local Service Providers (LSP's), Career Centers, Placement Organizations, Households and Government Departments on a common platform through the efficient use of information technology.


- Easy accessibility of employment services like staffing, placement and recruitment to all the stakeholders
- Enhancing employability of the workforce by providing them information on training & skilling
- Provisioning of career counselling services
- Self-help & assessment tools of capabilities & vocational guidance services to jobseekers
- Providing information related to job profiles, career paths & employers
- PAN verified institutions and rich database of job seekers
- Career planning and rich career content on over 3500 occupations across 52 sectors
- NCS has partnerships with various private organizations like TCS iON, Monster, HireMee, CSCs etc. and the data exchange on the portal helps connecting job seekers with more number of prospective employers
- In total 170 Model Career Centres (MCCs) have been set up across the country till now
- National Career Service Centres for Differently Abled (NCSC-DA) are being run by DGE across the country
- National Career Service Centres for SCs and STs (NCSC – SCs/STs) for providing employment related training and guidance are also being run by DGE
- NCS has a multi lingual call center where the users can call the NCS Toll Free Number 1800-425-1514 for any support. The services of the call center are available from Tuesday to Sunday from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM in seven different languages i.e. Hindi, English, Bengali, Kannada, Malayalam, Tamil and Telugu

As on 30th Nov, 2020, a total of 1,02,52,640 active jobseekers are registered on the NCS Portal. More than 68,400 employers are registered on the portal and the active vacancies currently available are 68,811.

NCS Portal is undergoing continuous enhancement of its user interface and other changes for best utilization of its online Services and for better user experience. Some of the enhancements made in the Portal features and other key changes implemented in Nov'2020 have been shared below.

1 For Employers/POs/Government Organizations

Highest Education Refiner has now been added under "Search Jobseeker" section on NCS Portal to help employer type users refine their jobseeker search results on the basis of Highest Education Refiner. Using this refiner, Employer user will be able to filter his list of candidate profiles to be viewed and shortlisted as per his required education qualification.



2 For Employers/POs/Government Organizations

For the benefit of both Employer and Jobseeker type users, below fields have been made mandatory on "Post Job Page" to make the job posting more detailed and specific:

I. "Gender Preferences" - Any/Female/Male/Transgender- This field will help the employer to specify his gender preference if any.

II. "Ex-serviceman preferred"- Yes /No- This field will help the employer notify if a particular job is preferably for ex-serviceman.

3 For Jobseeker, Local Service Provider (LSP), Counsellor

Mobile Number Uniqueness

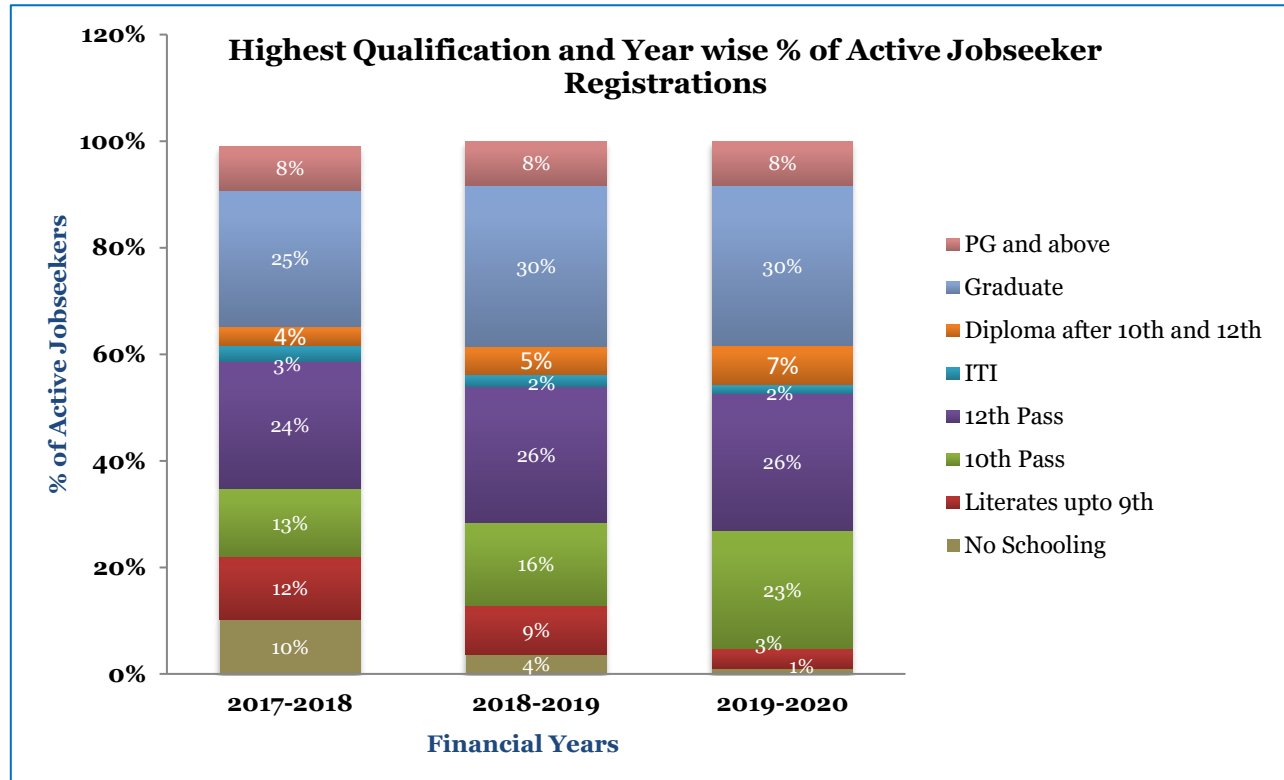
For the purpose of registration on NCS Portal as a Jobseeker or LSP or Counsellor, NCS has now made it mandatory to register using a unique mobile number, which means that creation of multiple user accounts within and across the stakeholder types Jobseeker, Local Service Provider and Counsellor using the same mobile number will not be allowed anymore. This has been done to avoid duplicity of Profiles on NCS Portal and also to ensure that important notifications reach the correct recipient.

For existing Jobseeker/LSP/Counsellor type users that have multiple NCS Profiles with same mobile number, will undergo mobile OTP verification whenever they first log in to their NCS account from Nov'20 onwards. Once done with the OTP verification, the verified account will be linked to the given mobile number and all other NCS accounts which were previously linked to this particular mobile number can be accessed by the user by verifying them with a different/new mobile number.

NCS Key Achievement

NCS Integration with ESIC

As part of its constant ongoing efforts to enrich its database of registered Employers, National Career Service has taken a remarkable leap by integrating with Employee's State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) Portal. Under this integration, Employers who are already registered under ESIC and are willing to register on NCS as well, have been given a pop up on the log out screen of ESIC Portal to seek their consent for registration on NCS Portal. This means that upon giving their consent to register on NCS Portal, these Employers will get automatically registered on NCS Portal through API integration and they will not have to fill any separate registration form. This integration will enhance both quality and quantity of Employer database on NCS Portal. With more and more registered Employers on NCS, its jobseekers will get to browse more number and a wider range of job opportunities. NCS also integrated with Employees' Provident Fund Organization (EPFO) in Dec'2019 on similar lines leading to huge database of EPFO employers getting registered on NCS Portal.

Above graph represents highest qualification wise % of active jobseekers on NCS Portal against the financial year in which they got registered. The reported data which is for last 3 financial years shows that 25 -30% of the total active jobseekers registered on NCS Portal in a given financial year, are Graduate candidates which indicates that NCS Portal is a potent source of hiring for meeting manpower requirements for most Employers. Even the % of 12th Pass active jobseekers is equally high on NCS Portal, which makes it a rich hiring platform for sectors like manufacturing and retail that usually have bulk requirements of 12th pass candidates for trainee/apprentice and other similar job roles that require trainable young manpower.

The COVID-19 Pandemic could not stop NCS from providing employment and career related services to its registered users. Committed to serve Jobseekers and Employers, NCS has been using its online Platform to continue conducting Job Fairs & Events. Glimpses of some of the major Career Events and Job Fairs are listed below

National Institute for Career Service (NICS), Noida organized series of Online Refresher Training Programs

NICS organized 3 batches of 2 day online training programs for Employment officers from various Employment Exchanges at Assam & Chhattisgarh on 5th -6th Nov, 2020, 19th -20th Nov., 2020 and 26th – 27th Nov, 2020. In total, around 60 Employment Officers participated in these training programs that were addressed by Smt. M. L. Gautam Director I/C, NICS, Sh. R. Aswani Kumar, Joint Director, NICS and Sh. M.S Ashok Kumar, Joint Director, NICS. The sessions majorly covered valuable information on the topics like “Latest updates of NCS Portal”, “Career Opportunities post COVID-19”, “How to organize Online Job Fair through NCS Portal”, “Importance of Career Counselling during COVID-19” etc.

Online Job Fair by Model Career Centre, Osmania University, Hyderabad

Model Career Center, Osmania University, Hyderabad organized an Online Job fair using NCS Portal on 7th Nov’2020 for 2 employers namely SANTA EVENTZ & EXHIBITIONS PRIVATE LIMITED and for SARVCON Training & Consultants Private Limited for job roles of Field Sales Executive and Trainee. More than 30 candidates with qualifications ITI, Diploma and 8th to 12th Pass, participated in this online Job Fair and around 11 candidates have been shortlisted for the final round of selection to be held in first week of Dec’20.

ITI Campus Recruitment Drive by Model Career Center, Salem

Model Career Center, Salem along with Government Industrial Training Institute (ITI), Salem conducted On-Campus Placement Drive from 9th to 12th Nov’2020 for their current Final Year Students from various trades like Fitter, Welder, Painter, MMV, MR & AC, Electrician, Wiremen, COPA, SSA. In total around 20 companies participated in this Placement Drive including Ashok Leyland, L.R.N Motors (Salem) etc. for various job roles like Technician, Trainee, Operators, Mechanic etc. In total, around 500 candidates participated in this Placement Drive against more than 250 job vacancies and around 300 candidates got shortlisted for final round. Final selection results will be declared post completion of recruitment by all companies in December 1st week.

Free Webinar on Career Planning and CV Development by District Employment Exchange, Model Career Centre, Banswara, Rajasthan

District Employment Exchange, Model Career Centre, Banswara organized a webinar in collaboration with Aravali Post Graduate College, Banswara on Career Planning & CV Development on 10th November, 2020 for its Graduate students. Objective of webinar was to inform the candidates about various career options available after Graduation, about National Career Service Portal and also to guide the participants on tips for CV development. Around 27 candidates participated in the Webinar.

Free Vocational Guidance and Training Program by Model Career Center, Agartala

Model Career Center, Agartala started with a free Vocational Guidance and Training Program on soft skills to enhance employability of the youth. The program started with a formal inauguration ceremony on 10th Nov'2020 with a batch of more than 20 candidates in the age group of 20 to 25 years. Job Drive organized by Model Career Center, Durgapur, West Bengal

Model Career Center, Durgapur, Sub-Regional Employment Exchange, Paschim Bardhaman, West Bengal organized an offline Job drive at its premises for company Godrej & Boyce Mfg. Co. Ltd. on 5th Nov'2020 for the job roles of Sales Executive and Senior Sales Executive with around 10 openings. Approximately 30 male candidates with qualification 10th and above in the age group of 18 to 30 years participated in this Job Drive and around 7 candidates have been provisionally selected.

Online Placement Drive by Model Career Center, Jalore, Rajasthan

Model Career Center, Jalore organized an online Placement Drive through NCS Portal on 19th to 20th Nov'2020 for multiple job roles like Field Relationship Officer, Construction technician trainee etc. Companies like Swan Crew Pvt. Ltd, L&T Construction Ltd. and few others participated in this Placement Drive with more than 300 job openings. More than 400 candidates with qualification 12th and above participated in this Placement drive and around 170 candidates have been shortlisted for next round of interview.

The Capital Goods and manufacturing sector is of strategic importance in Indian Economy. Capital Goods Sector comprises of plant and machinery, equipment/ accessories required for manufacture / production, either directly or indirectly, of goods or for rendering services, including those required for replacement, modernization, technological up gradation and expansion.



It also includes packaging machinery and equipment, refrigeration equipment, power generating sets, equipment and instruments for testing, research and development, quality and pollution control.

The capital goods industry contributes 12% to the total manufacturing activity which translates to about 1.8% of GDP. If the goal of achieving 9% growth in GDP during the 12th Five Year Plan has to be realized, then it is important for the manufacturing industry to grow at least by 11-13% per annum. This further requires that the Capital Goods sector, which is considered to be the core of manufacturing, should grow at around 17-19% per annum.

India, on its quest to become a global superpower, has made significant stride towards developing its engineering and capital goods industry. The Government has appointed Engineering Export Promotion Council (EEPC) as the apex body in charge of promotion of engineering goods, products, and services from India. India export transport equipment, capital goods, other machinery/equipment, and light engineering products such as castings, forgings, and fasteners to various countries of the world. Turnover of the capital goods industry was estimated at US\$ 92.00 billion in 2019 and is forecast to reach US\$ 115.17 billion by 2025. टीसीएस की ओर से बेरोजगारों को मिलेगी ट्रेनिंग, प्लेसमेंट की भी सुविधा

टीसीएस यानी टाटा कंसल्टेंसी सर्विस अब बेरोजगार युवाओं को ट्रेनिंग देकर उनकी स्किल को बेहतर करेगी। इसके लिए उन्हें ऑनलाइन ट्रेनिंग दी जाएगी। इस ट्रेनिंग का नाम टीसीएस अफरमेटिव एक्शन है। इसमें शामिल होने के लिए बेरोजगार युवकों को अवर प्रादेशिक नियोजनालय सह मॉडल कॅरिअर सेंटर से संपर्क करना होगा। सभी वर्गों की छात्राओं और एससी-एसटी और आर्थिक रूप से पिछड़े वर्ग के छात्रों को ही यह ट्रेनिंग मिलती है। बीए, बीएससी, बीकॉम से लेकर बीबीए कर चुके वर्ष 2018 और 2019 के स्टूडेंट्स को ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण की व्यवस्था है। मॉडल कॅरिअर सेंटर के वार्डपी यानी यंग प्रोफेशनल जय ने बताया, यहां आवेदकों का नाम रजिस्ट्रेशन कराने के बाद इसकी सूची दिल्ली भेजी जाती है। फिर निदेशालय से उन्हें शॉर्टलिस्ट कर सूची टीसीएस को भेजी जाती है। कोरोना संकट के कारण ऑनलाइन ट्रेनिंग कराई जा रही है।

टीसीएस के आईओएन ट्रेनिंग से जान सकते हैं इंटरव्यू स्किल्स, कराना होगा रजिस्ट्रेशन

टीसीएस की ओर से छात्र-छात्राओं के लिए आईओएन की ऑनलाइन ट्रेनिंग कराई जा रही है। इसमें आवेदक पर्सनैलिटी डेवलपमेंट, अंग्रेजी, इंटरव्यू स्किल्स से लेकर अन्य जानकारी हासिल कर सकते हैं। यह सभी के लिए है। इसके लिए उन्हें ncs.gov.in पर रजिस्ट्रेशन करना होगा। इसका पूरा नाम एनसीएस यानी नेशनल कॅरिअर स्क्रीम दिया गया है। इसकी शुरुआत 2015 में हुई है।

100 घंटे की कराई जाती है ट्रेनिंग

प्लेसमेंट भी साथ-साथ टीसीएस की ओर से चुने गए अभ्यर्थियों को ट्रेनिंग कराई जाती है। इसमें उन्हें 20 दिनों तक यानी कुल 100 घंटे का प्रशिक्षण दिया जाता है। इसके बाद उनके स्किल की जांच करने के लिए कंपनी की ओर से इंटरव्यू लिया जाता है। अगर अभ्यर्थी उसमें पास होते हैं तो उन्हें नौकरी का ऑफर दिया जाता है।

Digital recruitment drives bring back jobs for Covid-hit youth

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Visakhapatnam: With the pandemic hitting employment opportunities, the state and central employment and training departments have come up with the idea of digital recruitment drives.

The drives will also check fraudulent practices adopted in the name of employment by some private firms. Besides, the drive is expected to build confidence among youth who have lost their jobs, said K Sudha, Visakhapatnam district employment officer.

Sudha said the National

Career Service (NCS) affiliated to the Union ministry of labour and employment has recently sanctioned three Model Career Centres (MCC) for the state at Visakhapatnam, Kurnool and Vijayawada. The MCC coordinates with state employment and training departments to generate employment opportunities for all eligible youth in different companies.

"Accordingly, the first digital drive was started in September this year. This digital drive helps both the employer and the candidate, who need not wait in long queues. Everything will be done with a smartphone. We

check the authenticity of the employer," Sudha, also manager for the MCC, told TOI.

Prafull Dass, the NCS officer for MCC Visakhapatnam, said 249 employers have officially registered with the MCC Visakhapatnam. A total of 3,075 vacancies were posted through the centre on behalf of 11 employers and 2,331 candidates applied for the vacancies. Finally, 97 candidates got offer letters.

"Now, we are conducting this digital drive for nearly 900 posts in the city. Around 250 candidates have registered for the drive. Another drive will be held on November 23," Dass told TOI.
