INCREASE IN EMPLOYMENT VIS-À-VIS GDP GROWTH

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of increase in Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth vis-à-vis growth in employment in the country during the last three years and the current year;**
- (b) whether there is a perceptible increase in productivity of enterprises during the last three years and if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) whether there is no proportional increase in employment to commensurate with productivity in the last three-four years and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (d) the number of employment opportunities created/provided during the last four years, year-wise/State-wise/ scheme-wise including Uttar Pradesh?**

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT

(a) to (d) : As per the results of available Labour force surveys on employment and unemployment conducted by Labour Bureau, an attached office of the Ministry of Labour & Employment, the estimates of Worker Population Ratio (WPR) based on Usual Principal and Subsidiary Status (UPSS) approach for persons aged 15 years and above was 51.0% in 2012-13, 53.7% in 2013-14 and 50.5% in 2015-16. As per estimate released by Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, the corresponding growth rates of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) at Constant Prices (Base Year 2011-12) in the country during 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2015-16 was 5.5%, 6.4% and 8.2% respectively. Data on impact of productivity increase of enterprises on employment for the economy as a whole are not available.

Employment generation coupled with improving employability is the priority of the Government. The Government is implementing various programs in this direction like fast tracking various projects involving substantial investment and increasing public expenditure on schemes such as Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Pt.Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), Deendayal Antodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) and Rural Self Employment and Training Institutes (RSETI). The detail of employment generated through these major schemes in the States/UTs including Uttar Pradesh are given in Annexure I, II, III IV(a),IV(b), IV(c) and V.

Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY) has been initiated by Government interalia for facilitating self-employment. Under PMMY collateral free loans upto Rs. 10 lakh, are extended to small/micro business enterprises and to individuals to enable them to setup or expand their business activities. Till 25th January, 2019, total 15.59 crore loans have been sanctioned under the Scheme.

Pradhan Mantri Rozgar Protsahan Yojana (PMRPY) has been launched by the Ministry of Labour & Employment for incentivizing employers for promoting employment generation. Under this scheme, Government is paying entire employer's contribution (12% or as admissible) towards EPF and EPS for all eligible new employees for all sectors for three years. Till 04.02.2019, more than 1.06 crore employees have been benefitted through 1.31 lakh establishments under this scheme.
