CREATION OF JOBS AFTER INITIATIVE OF 'MAKE IN INDIA'

1175. SHRI P.L. PUNIA:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of new jobs created and people employed since the start of 'Make in India' initiative in September, 2014 to till date, the year-wise, State-wise and sector-wise data thereof;**
- (b) whether Government is planning to revamp the 'Make in India' initiative to increase job creation in the country, if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) which labour intensive sectors will be made the focus of such a revamped initiative; and**
- (d) how Government will ensure that labour laws are strengthened in order to prevent exploitation of workers in the name of ease of doing business?**

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT
(SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

(a) to (d): Employment generation coupled with improving employability is the priority concern of the Government. Government of India launched the Make in India initiative in 2014 for promoting India as an important investment destination and a global hub for manufacturing, design and innovation. Investment promotion activities are undertaken by several Central Government Ministries/Departments and various State Governments from time to time.

Government has taken various steps for generating employment in the country like encouraging private sector of economy, fast tracking various projects involving substantial investment and increasing public expenditure on schemes like Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) run by Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGA), Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) scheme run by Ministry of Rural Development and Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) run by Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs. Details of the employment generated through these schemes/ programmes are given in Annexure.

Government has decided to strategically promote labour-intensive manufacturing and expand employment opportunities by promoting tourism and agro-based industries.

Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY) has been initiated by Government for facilitating self-employment. Under PMMY collateral free loans upto Rs. 10 lakh, are extended to small/micro business enterprises and to individuals to enable them to setup or expand their business activities. Till 25th January, 2019, total 15.59 crore loans have been sanctioned under the scheme.

Pradhan Mantri Rojgar Protsahan Yojana has been initiated by the Ministry of Labour and Employment in the year 2016-17 for incentivizing employers for employment generation. Under this scheme, Government is paying the entire employer's contribution (12 % or as admissible) towards the EPS and EPF for all sectors w.e.f. 01.04.2018 to all eligible new employees for the next 3 years from the date of registration of the new employee. Till 4th February, 2019, these benefits have been given to 1.31 lakh establishments covering 1.06 crore beneficiaries.

Government has also initiated labour reforms to create an enabling environment to facilitate ease of doing business, ease of compliance, transparency, accountability and extending the social security coverage of the unorganised workers. It is expected that the enabling environment which the labour reforms would create, would facilitate investment and job creation.
