- (c) the number of persons who have been provided employment directly and indirectly in the country including Uttar Pradesh during the last three years?**

**(a) to (c) : The data on Employment and Unemployment is collected through Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) conducted by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) since 2017-18. The survey period is July to June of the next year. As per the latest available Annual PLFS report 2020-21, State/UT-wise estimated Unemployment Rate (UR) on usual status for persons of age 15 years and above during 2020-21 is at Annexure.**

**The estimated Worker Population Ratio (WPR) for persons of age 15 years and above indicating employment during the last three years is as follows:**
