UNEMPLOYMENT RATE IN THE EDUCATED POPULATION

1386. PROF. MANOJ KUMAR JHA:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the State-wise unemployment rate among those who have earned any postsecondary qualification;
- (b) whether Government has collected data on the State-wise rate of underemployment among the educated population; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the measures in place to address unemployment among the educated population, and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) & (b): As per latest annual Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) report for 2019-20, the State/UT-wise details of the estimated unemployment rate among educated population including those with post-secondary qualification (age 15 years and above on usual status basis) are given at Annexure-I.

Ministry of Labour & Employment has launched National Career Service (NCS) portal as a digital platform that brings together job seekers and employers on a single platform for job matching in dynamic, efficient and responsive manner. State/UT-wise details of the educated job seekers including those with post-secondary qualification (age 15 years and above) registered on NCS portal as on 07.12.2021 are given at Annexure-II.

(c): Employment generation coupled with improving employability is the priority of the Government. Accordingly, the Government of India has taken various steps for generating employment in the country. The Government of India is encouraging various projects involving substantial investment and public

expenditure on schemes like Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) of the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) & Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) of the Ministry of Rural Development, Deen Dayal Antodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) of the Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs and Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) of the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE) etc.

The Government of India has announced Aatmanirbhar Bharat package to provide stimulus to business and to mitigate the adverse impact of Covid 19. Under this package, the Government is providing fiscal stimulus of more than Rs. Twenty Seven lakh crore. This package comprises of various long term schemes/programmes/policies for making the country self-reliant and to create employment opportunities.

Aatmanirbhar Bharat Rozgar Yojana (ABRY) has been launched with effect from 1st October, 2020 as part of Aatmanirbhar Bharat package 3.0 to incentivize employers for creation of new employment along with social security benefits and restoration of loss of employment during Covid-19 pandemic. This scheme being implemented through Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO), seeks to reduce the financial burden of the employers and encourages them to hire more workers. The terminal date for registration of beneficiaries has been extended from 30.06.2021 to 31.03.2022. As on 4.12.2021, benefit has been provided to 39.72 lakh beneficiaries through 1.17 lakh establishments.

Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY) is being implemented by the Government for facilitating self-employment. Under PMMY, collateral free loans upto Rs. 10 lakh, are extended to micro/small business enterprises and to individuals to enable them to setup or expand their business activities. Under this scheme 31.28 crore loans were sanctioned till November 2021.

Besides these initiatives, various flagship programmes of the Government such as Make in India, Digital India, Smart City Mission, Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation, Housing for All, Infrastructure Development and Industrial corridors and Production-Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme are also oriented towards generating productive employment opportunities.
