**(a) & (b): 'Make in India' is an initiative to facilitate investment, foster innovation, build best in class infrastructure, and make India a hub for manufacturing, design, and innovation. The 'Make in India' initiative is not a state/district/city/area specific initiative, rather it is being implemented all over the country.**

**(c) & (d): Under Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS), 14,953 Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) are functioning in the country with total seating capacity of 25,82,271 out of which 50 ITIs are functioning in Jammu & Kashmir with a seating capacity of 10,900.**
