EMPLOYMENT IN ODISHA THROUGH NCS

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the aims and objectives of launching the National Career Services (NCS);
- (b) the challenges faced by Government while implementing NCS;
- (c) the total number of job-seekers that have been employed through the NCS portal during each of the last three years and the current year in the State of Odisha; and
- (d) the total number of persons from the State of Odisha who have secured jobs through the portal in the public sector and private sector during each of the last three years and the current year?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (d): The National Career Service (NCS) project is being implemented by the Government to provide a variety of employment related services like job search and matching, career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses etc. through a digital platform [www.ncs.gov.in]. The NCS project aims to provide seamless access to Jobseekers and employers, decent employment opportunities to the aspiring youth of the country and to facilitate career development assistance. The NCS Portal brings together Jobseekers and employers on one platform. Since the confirmation of final hiring figure is not mandatory on NCS Portal, the job hiring data is available only to the extent as voluntarily reported by the employers. However, the number of vacancies mobilised on NCS Portal in which Odisha is one of the State during each of the last three years and the current year are as under:
