INCREASING UNEMPLOYMENT RATE IN 15-24 AGE GROUP

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that according to International Labour Organisation (ILO) the unemployment rate in 15-24 age group is much higher;
- (b) if so, what are the details in this regard; and
- (c) what has been the rate of unemployment in this age group between 2014 and 2019?

(a) to (c): As per the results of annual Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) conducted by National Statistical Office (NSO), Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation during 2017-18 and employment–unemployment survey conducted by Labour Bureau, Ministry of Labour and Employment, the estimated unemployment rate on usual status (principal status+subsidiary status) basis to the extent available is given below:
