**Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of the job fairs conducted in the State of Uttar Pradesh during the year 2022 along with the district-wise details thereof;**
- (b) whether the Government has the details of the number of jobs awarded to people from fairs;**
- (c) if so, the details of sectors in which these people got jobs from all the districts of Uttar Pradesh;**
- (d) whether the Government has assessed the impact of such job fairs on the employment rate of the country; and**
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?**

**ANSWER**

**(a) to (e): Regular Job Fairs are being organized under various schemes by the State Governments/Ministries/Departments etc. As per the information received from the State Government of Uttar Pradesh, in the year 2022, 1,528 Job fairs were conducted and 1,84,502 jobs were provided to the job seekers thereby. The prominent sectors in which jobs have been awarded include security, sales and marketing, textile, finance and insurance, healthcare, construction, e-commerce and online food delivery, etc. The details of the District wise job fairs conducted and the candidate selected in the year 2022 is at Annexure.**

**The official data on Employment and Unemployment is collected through Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) which is conducted by the Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MoSPI) since 2017-18. The survey period is July to June of next year. As per the latest available Annual PLFS Reports, the estimated Worker Population Ratio (WPR) on usual status for persons of age 15 years & above was 50.9% and 52.6% during 2019-20 and 2020-21, respectively, which shows that employment rate in the country has increased. This increase in employment rate includes the impact of job fairs.**
