Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has prepared any plan with the State Governments to organize job fairs at district level across the country ; and**
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the number of job fairs organized in Madhya Pradesh during the last three years, district-wise and the outcome thereof?**

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (b) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. *92 DUE FOR REPLY ON 08-02-2021 BY DR. VIRENDRA KUMAR REGARDING "JOB FAIRS IN MADHYA PRADESH".

(a) to (b): Government is implementing the National Career Service (NCS) Project to provide a variety of employment related services like job matching, career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses, etc. The NCS project comprises three components:

- 1) National Career Service (NCS) Portal (www.ncs.gov.in).**

- 2) Model Career Centres (MCC) having state of art infrastructure to provide all employment related services including outreach activities and job fairs in collaboration with States/UTs and other institutions. The Government provides financial assistance to these centres for an amount up to Rs. 50 Lakh per centre based on the proposal of State/UT/Institutions as per scheme guidelines. As of now the Government has approved 207 Model Career Centres (MCCS) (including 7 on Non-funded basis).Out of the total 207 MCCs, 10 MCCs have been approved in Madhya Pradesh.**

- 3) Interlinking of Employment Exchanges- Under this component, funds have been provided to States/UTs to interlink Employment Exchanges with NCS Portal and to organize job fairs. Till date, funds have been released to 28 States/UTs as per scheme guidelines.**

The details of the job fairs organized through NCS in collaboration with States/UTs including Madhya Pradesh is attached at Annexure. Besides this, State Governments also organize job fairs from their resources as per their requirements.
