**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (f) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. \*106 DUE FOR REPLY ON 11.12.2023 REGARDING “NATIONAL CAREER SERVICE (NCS) PROJECT” BY SHRI P.P. CHAUDHARY AND SHRI ANURAG SHARMA:**

**(a) to (f): Ministry of Labour and Employment is implementing the National Career Service (NCS) project to provide a variety of career related services like job search and matching, career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses etc. through a digital platform [www.ncs.gov.in].**

**Establishment/Expansion of Employment Exchanges is under the purview of the State/UT Governments. As on 30.11.2023 there are 1005 Employment Exchanges in the country. Under the NCS project, the Government has targeted to establish 400 Model Career Centres (MCCs) and all 400 MCCs have been approved including 370 in Employment Exchanges. State-wise details of Employment Exchanges and Model Career Centres are provided at Annexure I and Location-wise employment exchanges of Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh where Model Career Centres have been approved are provided at Annexure-II.**

**The number of beneficiaries/Jobseekers/Employers registered on NCS portal of Pali, Jhansi, Deoria and Pratapgarh districts as on 30th November 2023 are given below:**

**In order to increase the registration of employers on the NCS portal, the Government has taken the following initiatives:**

- i. NCS portal has been integrated with Udyam portal of Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) for seamless registration of Udyam registered MSMEs as employers on the NCS portal. More than 16.81 lakhs Udyam registered MSMEs are registered as employers on NCS portal.**
- ii. Ministry of Labour and Employment has signed Memorandum of Understandings (MoUs)/ partnerships with various job portals/ private organizations like Monster.com, Freshersworld, Ques Corp Limited, HireMee, TCS-iON, UNICEF YuWaah etc to enhance job opportunities on NCS for the job seekers.**
- iii. NCS portal is also interlinked with EPFO and ESIC portals for connecting with the employers.**
- iv. Further, to popularize NCS and for connecting with job seekers and employers, Information Education and Communication (IEC) activities and outreach activities are regularly organized.**
