

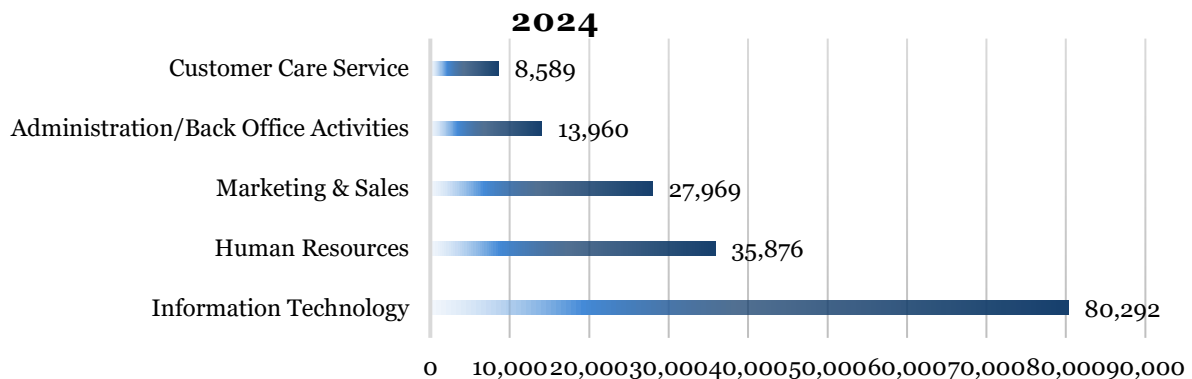
CAREER INFORMATION – IT & COMMUNICATION SECTOR

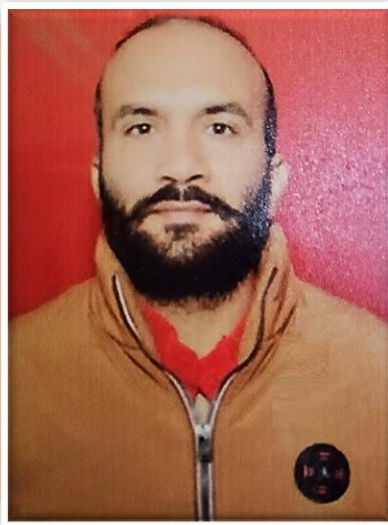

Upgraded National Career Service portal to give job market a fillip

May leverage AI, ML to make it more efficient; launch in 6-8 mths

The Centre plans to upgrade the nine-year-old National Career Service (NCS) portal to link millions of youths with prospective employers in a bid to prepare a future-ready workforce, two government officials said.

The ministry of labour and employment, which is working on the upgraded version of the portal — NCS 2.0 — plans to leverage artificial intelligence (AI) and machine learning (ML) to make it more efficient.

The launch may take six–nine months, one of the officials cited above told *Business Standard*.

नौ साल पुराने पोर्टल का नया अवतार 6 से 9 महीने में लॉन्च होगा युवाओं को जॉब के लिए करियर पोर्टल अपग्रेड होगा, इसमें एआई का भी प्रयोग

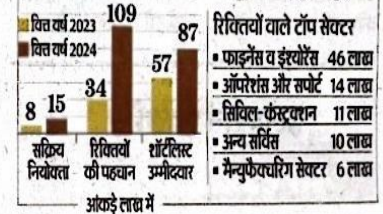

नई दिल्ली | केंद्र सरकार ने नौ साल पुराने नेशनल करियर सर्विस (एनसीएस) पोर्टल को अपग्रेड करने की योजना बनाई है। इसका उद्देश्य लाखों युवाओं और नियोक्ताओं को एक प्लेटफॉर्म पर लाना और भविष्य की वर्कफोर्स तैयार करना है। एनसीएस 2.0 के अपग्रेडेशन पर काम कर रहा केंद्रीय श्रम एवं रोजगार मंत्रालय पोर्टल को ज्यादा प्रभावी बनाने के लिए आर्टिफिशियल इंटेलिजेंस (एआई) और मशीन लर्निंग की मदद लेगा। एनसीएस 2.0 पोर्टल लॉन्च होने में छह से नौ महीने लग सकते हैं। नए वर्जन में राज्यों व जिलों की माइक्रो-साइट होगी। जिले, राज्य और देश का सेंट्रलाइज्ड आंकड़ा एक ही पोर्टल पर होगा। टीमलीज सर्विसेज की को-फाउंडर रितुपर्णा चक्रवर्ती ने इस फैसले का स्वागत किया है।

50 से ज्यादा पोर्टल से जुड़ा

एनसीएस नौकरी चाहने वालों, नियोक्ताओं, करियर काउंसलर, प्लेसमेंट संगठनों, सरकारी विभागों को एक डिजिटल प्लेटफॉर्म पर लाएगा। अभी एनसीएस 50 से ज्यादा पोर्टल से जुड़ा है। इनमें एमएसएमई के लिए उद्यम पोर्टल, ईपीएफओ, ईएसआईसी, ई-श्रम, टीमलीज, मॉन्टर डॉट कॉम जैसे पोर्टल के साथ कई अन्य संस्थान शामिल हैं। फिलहाल 22 राज्यों के जॉब पोर्टल एनसीएस के साथ जुड़े हैं और सात राज्य सीधे इसका इस्तेमाल कर रहे हैं।

Naukri, other job websites face a new rival: Centre's employment portal

The National Career Service (NCS) portal aims to connect employers and job seekers, hosting a diverse array of job opportunities reflecting a 214% rise in vacancies in FY24 across various sectors.

According to the India Employment Report 2024 jointly published last month by the International Labour Organization (ILO) and the Institute of Human Development (IHD), India's youth continue to face high unemployment rates, with nearly 83% of the jobless population belonging to this demographic.

India has strongly objected to the ILO about its report, insisting that it has misinterpreted the data on youth employment as it has ignored international mobility as well as gig and platform workers data.

Amid this, the NCS website has seen more than 10 million jobs posted till March, with the number of job providers going up to 2.6 million. The portal has an extensive user base of over 40 million registered job seekers from every corner of the country and every section of society.

On a monthly basis, the portal hosted around one million active job vacancies, reflecting a diverse array of opportunities spanning sectors like finance and insurance, operation and support, construction, manufacturing, IT and communication, health, education and others, said one of the persons familiar with the developments.

Queries sent to the spokesperson of the labour and employment ministry and Naukri.com CEO Hitesh Oberoi remained unanswered.

Vacancies on NCS in finance, insurance, construction, manufacturing, transportation, storage and supply chain, have grown as much as 214% in FY24 compared to the last fiscal.

Opportunities galore

"However, data from the National Career Service indicates a significant rise in job opportunities, mainly in the unorganized sector," said the person mentioned above, adding that the labour department plans to collaborate with international job providers and premium sector employers to enhance opportunities for Indian jobseekers.

Reacting to the ILO's report released on 26 March, India's labour and employment secretary Sumita Dawra called senior ILO officials and conveyed the government's displeasure. The government has stated that the ILO failed to collaborate with India or seek its input.

Countering the ILO data, India's labour ministry said youth (aged 15-29 years) unemployment rate had reduced to 5% in 2022 from 7% in 2019, while unemployment rate for adults (aged 30-59 years) was just 1% in both the years.

"The prime objective of NCS is to revolutionize the national employment service by providing a wide range of employment-related services, including job matching, career counselling and employability enhancement facilities, all conveniently accessible online," the second person said.

The NCS project operates as a standout initiative focused on bridging the gap between employers and job seekers, this person said.

India Witness Significant Growth In Jobs & Decline In Unemployment, Suggests Govt Data

A leading news agency of India tried to analyze data from five different sources to find that there has been significant growth in jobs over the last few years under the PM Modi government. The data derived from Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS), EPFO, RBI, National Career Services or NCS portal and various job-intensive schemes, reveals that India has witnessed a growth in jobs and a decline in the unemployment rate over the last few years. Periodic Labour Force Survey of the last six years indicates an improving trend in labour participation rate and worker population ratio. The data further showed that employment has increased in the country from 46.8 % in 2017-18 to 56 per cent in 2022-23. Similarly, the labour force participation has also gone up from 49.8 per cent to 57.9 per cent in 2022-23. The unemployment rate has declined from 6% in 2017-18 to 3.2% in 2022-23. Analysis of Employee Provident Fund Organisation data suggests that over last six years, 6.1 crore new members have joined the EPFO site. The latest Reserve Bank of India's database also suggests that in last 9 years, estimated employment in the country have gone up from 47 crore in 2013-14 to 55.3 crore in 2021-22. Similarly, the National Career Service or NCS portal witnessed a remarkable surge of 214% in job vacancies in 2023-24 as compared to 2022-23. To talk about the numbers on a daily basis, the NCS Portal hosted around one million active job vacancies on an average. In addition to that, various government schemes show that a significant number of jobs are added to their profiles. For example under the Atmanirbhar Bharat Rojgar Yojana, total benefits of Rs 10,188.5 crore have been given to 60.49 lakh beneficiaries as on March 2024. Various other schemes like MGNREGS, PM SVANidhi, PMEGP have also helped in generating jobs. Employment opportunities were also created through various flagship programmes of the government like, Make in India, Start-up India, Digital India, Smart City mission, Housing for All, Infrastructure development and Industrial corridors. The concerning thing, however, is a staggering 83% of India's unemployed workforce comprises youth.

Govt portal offered more jobs than applied for in FY24: 1.09 crore Vs 87.27 lakh

Synopsis

In the fiscal year 2023-24, the National Career Service (NCS) job portal displayed a notable trend in job vacancies surpassing the number of job seekers. According to NCS data, there were 87,27,900 registered job-seekers compared to 1,09,24,161 job vacancies. This marks a significant increase in job availability, with vacancies rising by 214 percent over the previous year.



Vacancies listed on the government's job portal National Career Service (NCS) displayed an interesting trend. The NCS data shows that in the fiscal year 2023-24 **jobs** available through the portal were significantly higher than **job seekers**.

The number of job-seekers registered through the portal in FY24 is 87,27,900 as against **job vacancies** of 1,09,24,161, as per NCS data.

Top online courses in Business, Marketing, Programming Languages

The data also suggests that in FY24 the number of jobs available on the portal saw a 214 per cent or almost three time jump over the previous year. Job vacancies posted on the portal by employers were 1,09,24,161 in FY24 as against 34,81,944 in FY23. However, opposed to this job-seekers growth was mere 53 per cent from 57,20,748 in FY23 to 87,20,900 in FY24.

"You had three quarters of growth above 8 per cent, and hopefully, the fourth quarter which ends tomorrow, will also be 8 per cent or above 8 per cent, resulting in 2023-24 having a GDP growth of 8 per cent or above 8 percent," Sitharaman had said.

In FY24, the highest number of job vacancies listed on the **NCS portal** was in the finance and insurance sector at 46,68,845 vacancies, a 134 per cent jump over the previous year. This was followed by operations and support sector at 14,46,404 listed vacancies, which was 286 per cent jump over previous year. Civil and construction sector saw a booming 11,75,900 vacancies as against a mere 9396 vacancies in FY23. Job vacancies in other service activities saw a 199 percent jump in FY24 at 10,70,206 vacancies as against 3,58,177 vacancies in FY23.

NCS data also shows that growth in job vacancies for manufacturing saw a jump of 526 per cent in FY24 over FY23 at 6,89,466 vacancies verses 1,10,175. Similarly, significant growth was seen in job vacancies in other sectors like IT & Communications, Transport & storage, Education and specialised professional services.

Jobs were posted on the NCS portal by employers for people with different skills and educational qualifications.

For 12th pass 68,77,532 jobs were posted which was 179 per cent up from FY23. For 10th pass or below there were 27,04,280 jobs were posted which was 452 per cent up from previous year. For ITI and diploma holders 4,02,192 jobs were posted in FY24 which was 378 per cent up from the previous year.

For graduates the number of jobs posted on the portal were 7,33,277 which was 129 per cent more than FY23. Those who were post graduate, PhD or PG diploma holders for them 60,531 jobs 123 per cent up from FY23.

The data on the **government portal** suggests that there were enough jobs available for every category of job seekers. More demand were for low skilled and low paid jobs. The number of active employers on the NCS job portal stands at 15,64,800, which is 89 per cent more than FY23. (ANI)

Government's Job Portal National Career Service Offered More Jobs Than Applied for in Fiscal Year 2023-24: 1.09 Crore vs 87.27 Lakh

A senior government official told ANI that the surge in job vacancies signifies a higher growth in the economy.



New Delhi, April 27: Vacancies listed on the government's job portal National Career Service (NCS) displayed an interesting trend. The NCS data shows that in the fiscal year 2023-24 jobs available through the portal were significantly higher than job seekers. The number of job-seekers registered through the portal in FY24 is 87,27,900 as

against job vacancies of 1,092,4161, as per NCS data. The data also suggests that in FY24 the number of jobs available on the portal saw a 214 per cent or almost three time jump over the previous year. Job vacancies posted on the portal by employers were 1,092,4161 in FY24 as against 34,81,944 in FY23. However, opposed to this job-seekers growth was mere 53 per cent from 57,20,748 in FY23 to 87,20,900 in FY24.
