INTRODUCTION

The National Institute for Career Service (erstwhile Central Institute for Research and Training in Employment Service) was set up in October 1964 under Directorate General of Employment (DGE), Ministry of Labour & Employment for imparting Research & Training in Employment Services. With the implementation of NCS scheme under Employment Exchange Mission Mode Project of National E-Governance plan (Ne-GP), the then Central Institute for Research and Training in Employment Service (CIRTES) was renamed as National Institute for Career Service (NICS) in July 2016. NICS was designated as nodal institute for capacity building of all stakeholders of NCS project and for professional inservice training of Officers of National Employment Services working with the Central & State Government. Under NCS project, NICS also implements Young Professional Scheme of M/o Labour and Employment and provides Employment related Services to the jobseekers and job providers through its Model Career Centre (MCC).

Vision

To be a National Centre of Excellence and to provide enhanced employability through Training, Research & Capacity Building Programme in the area of Employment under National Employment Services.

- Enhancing human and organizational excellence in Employment/ Career Services by organizing various capacity-building programmes.
- Effective implementation of various schemes of National Employment Service/ National Career Service for the benefit of various stakeholders.
- Monitoring & evaluation of various schemes of National Career Service project on a sustainable basis.
- Strengthening & improving the quality of Employment services by empowering and enhancing the capacities of the Employment Personnel with regular capacity building trainings.
- Enhanced efficiency and productivity of employment/ career service personnel by developing innovative strategies for career counselling, job mapping and placement.

Implementation of NCS Project and YP Scheme: NICS is also playing a major role in implementing the Young Professional Scheme of M/o Labour and Employment and is also coordinating the activities of Model Career Centres established in various parts of the country under NCS project. Organizing Training Programmes for Employment Officers working in various States/UTs. Capacity Building: As a Nodal institute for capacity building NICS is responsible for imparting training to all stakeholders of NCS project, viz. YPs, job seekers, employers, counsellors etc. Functioning of Model Career Centre established at NICS, Noida.









Capacity Building Training Programme for Officers & Officials of National Employment Service



To enrich the efficiency of training programmes, external lecturers apart from the in-house Officers are also invited from the prestigious organizations of India. These training programmes comprises a wide array of subjects that range from Employment Market Information Service under NES & NCS, Labour Market Analysis, Career Counselling, etc. in collaboration with premier institutes like Indian Institute of Foreign Trade (Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Govt. of India), V.V. Giri National Labour Institute (Ministry of Labour & Employment, Govt. of India) etc. The aim of these training programmes is to update the knowledge and skills of Employment Personnel/Young Professionals. The training programmes helps them to understand the nature of employment market at various levels and the role of NCS in Employment Market/Labour Market related areas.

The Objective of these training programmes is to instill a critical understanding of administrative matters and related intricacies in Employment Service Personnel so as to improve their efficiency and help them immerse in their roles unreservedly.



YP Correspondence Management System

National Institute for Career Service communicates with the Young Professionals via emails, telephonic exchanges, WhatsApp Groups and through official letters. Internal correspondence takes place between NICS and the Nodal Officers of Young Professionals. Sometimes direct communication takes place with the Young Professionals, which includes issuing instructions regarding the allotted tasks, protocols, memorandum, appointment letter, letter of approval, NOC, relieving letter, experience letter, written reprimand, formal requests, and notice to provide explanations.

The process of recruiting Young Professionals across India too comes under the management of NICS. A professional workforce has been considered essential for the efficient operationalization of the Model Career Centres which are located across India. Considering the current staffing patterns of the Labour Market Scenario in India and in order to assist in carrying out NCS-related activities and to infuse new perspectives and professionalism into the work environment, the recruitment of Young Professionals takes place from the headquarters of NICS. The Directorate General for Employment (DGE) established the 'Young Professional Scheme' in the format of the erstwhile Planning Commission with an objective of imparting the skill sets, enthusiasm, and entrepreneurial spirit in promising young talent in order to improve the dynamics of India's workforce and also career counselling aspect. In accordance with the program, one YP must be stationed at each MCC.

This YP Correspondence Management system of NICS also keeps a track record of all the activities performed by the Young Professionals across the country by receiving, recording, logging, suitably processing and responding to their queries and creating an assessment trajectory of the received correspondence. This system provides digital communication for data preservation, storage, and forwarding for authorization and evaluation.

The MCC helps jobseekers to make the best career decision by providing Career Counselling sessions and also assist jobseekers with all employment-related information, ranging from apprenticeships to job opportunities in reputed companies, via organising job fairs, mega job fairs and placement drives.

The MCC works towards bridging the gap among all stakeholders, so that they come together and interact with each other for the employment of the jobseekers. A model career centre enables creation of a completely integrated employer-employee association.

Model Career Centres connect local youth and other job-seekers with all possible job opportunities in a transparent and effective manner through the use of technology as well as through counselling and training. While the state-of-the-art technology driven National Career Service Portal provides information in a sustained manner about available job opportunities and resources, the MCCs are still the pivotal liaison and counselling interface of the National Career Service project for teaming millions of aspiring youth from rural, semi urban areas as well as from disadvantaged sections of the society.
