MODEL CAREER CENTRE:

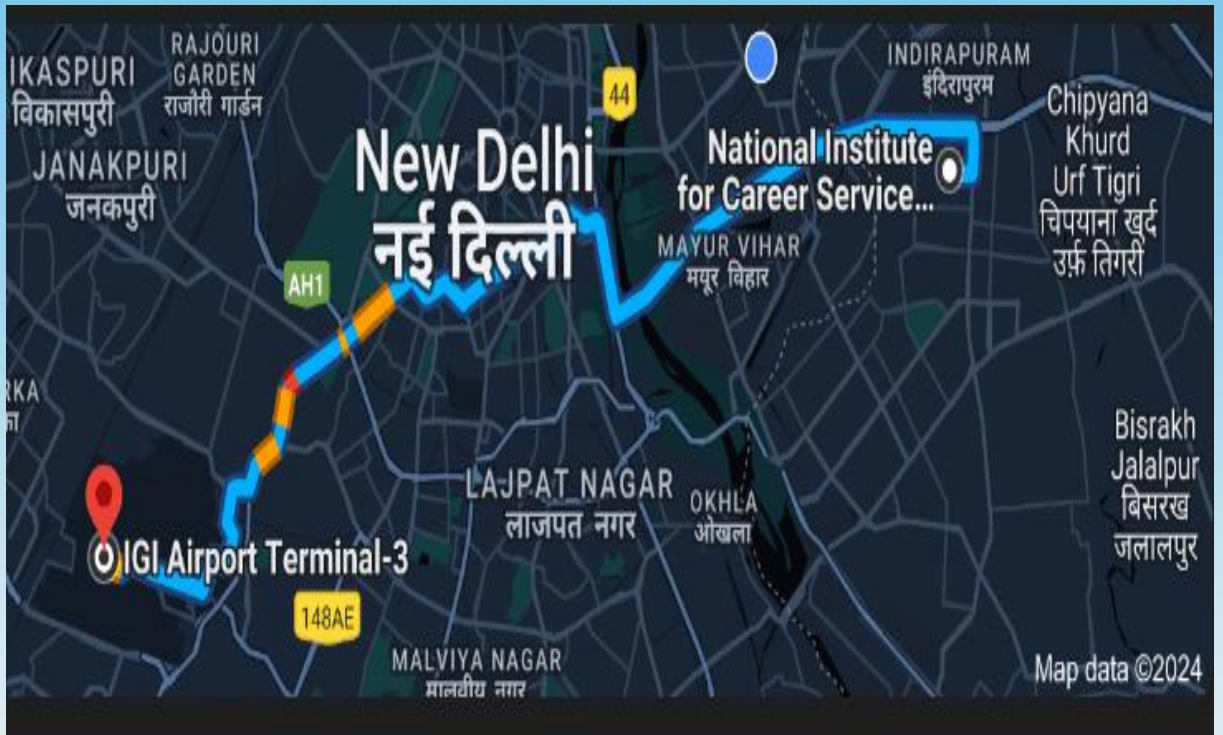
