Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has data on the number of people employed in the manufacturing sector over the last five years, if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) whether it is a fact that there has been job losses in the unincorporated units of the manufacturing sector over the last five years, if so, the reasons therefor;**
- (c) whether it is also a fact that there has only been a marginal increase in the number of people employed in the unincorporated, non-agricultural enterprises, since 2010-11; and**
- (d) the details thereof?**

(a) to (d): The KLEMS (K: Capital, L: Labour, E: Energy, M: Materials and S: Services) database published by Reserve Bank of India (RBI) provides employment estimates, including manufacturing sector, at all India level. As per the latest data of the database, employment in the manufacturing sector increased to 6.31 crore in year 2022-23 compared to 5.52 crore in 2018-19. Total increase in employment during 2018-19 to 2022-23 is about 79.17 lakh in the manufacturing sector.

Annual Survey of Unincorporated Sector Enterprises (ASUSE), which is conducted by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI), exclusively measures various economic and operational characteristics of unincorporated, non-agricultural establishments in manufacturing, trade and other services sector.
