Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that as per the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI's) KLEMS data, employment opportunities for eight crore people have been generated in the country during the years 2018-22;
- (b) the number of persons who got jobs therein along with number of persons who took up self-employment, sector-wise, district-wise, State-wise and year-wise; and
- (c) whether this estimate of eight crores is based on a sample study, if so, the details of the sample size and sample geography?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

(a) to (c): The KLEMS (K: Capital, L: Labour, E: Energy, M: Materials and S: Services) database published by Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) provides employment estimates at all India level. As per the latest data of the database, total employment was 49.26 crore in the year 2018-19 and 59.67 crore in the year 2022-23 in the country.

The official data source on Employment and Unemployment is Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) which is conducted by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) since 2017-18. The survey period is July to June every year. As per the latest available Annual PLFS reports, the estimated Worker Population Ratio (WPR), i.e. employment on usual status for persons of age 15 years and above in the country, State-wise is at Annexure-I.

Further, the percentage distribution of workers on usual status by broad industry division during 2022-23 is at Annexure-II.
