INTRODUCTION

The National Institute for Career Service (NICS) erstwhile Central Institute for Research and Training in Employment Service (CIRTES) was set up in October, 1964 under Directorate General of Employment (DGE), M/o Labour & Employment for imparting Research & Training in Employment Services. The Institute was later expanded in 1970 with additional function of publishing career literature and again in 1987 with added responsibility of occupational research & promotion of self-employment. With the implementation of NCS Project under Employment Exchange Mission Mode Project of National e-Government plan (Ne-GP) in 2015, the Central Institute for Research and Training has been revamped as Nodal institute for Capacity Building for the employment service personnels working under National Employment Service at Central/State Government and has been renamed as National institute for career service on July 2016, NICS has also been given added responsibility of Young Professional (YP) Scheme and Model Career Centre (MCC) to provide the direct benefit to the jobseeker of India.



Professional Training & Capacity Building Program

The National Institute for Career Services (NICS) has been responsible for imparting professional in-service training to employment personnel, officers & staff from DGE & state government since its inception in 1964. The training programs includes induction and refresher training for employment service personnel, specialized training in vocational guidance and career counseling, self-employment and entrepreneurship development, National Career Service Portal management, data management and analysis on Employment Market Information (EMI) and Labour Market Analysis (LMA), mandatory training for DGE officers as per RR. collaborative programs with other institutes like VVGNLI, and training on e-governance portals, administrative matters, RTI, Sparrow, e-bhavishya, GFR and other related topics.

However NICS has been assigned with the additional task of conducting capacity-building programs for officers and staff of Model Career Centres (MCCs) and Young Professionals (YPs) etc. Since 2015 under the ages of NCS Project, NICS is providing capacity building to other stakeholders of the NCS portal, including jobseekers, employers, training providers, students, counsellors, and placement organizations.







Training Program for officers of DGE


Glimpse of Webinar on Recommendation System (11th Sep 2024)

In this session, our expert Ms. Garima Gakhar, Assistant Professor, Indraprastha Engineering College will help the viewers explore different career paths in this domain.


























Webinar on Interview Skills & Resume Building (26th Sep 2024)

In this session, our expert Prof. Ranjana Sharma, HRIT College will guide you on tips to refine your interview skills and resume presentation.





















Young Professional Scheme

One of the key role of NICS is handling the formulation of YP Scheme and its implementation in the form of recruitment, deployment, capacity building, remuneration, and contract extensions for all Young Professionals across India. Accordingly, NICS is responsible for Deployment, transfer, resignation, training, leaves etc of YPs posted across India at MCCs. In the month of September 2024, with reference to YP Scheme following activities were under taken:

- YP Coordination (Deployment, transfer, resignation, training, leaves etc.)
- YP Remuneration of 250 YPs disbursed for August 2024 along with salary slips.
- Issued 2nd Increment orders for 17 YPs of 6th Batch.
- Issued Extension orders to 49 YPs of 6th Batch.
- Disbursed arrears of Increment to 17 YPs of 6th Batch.
- Proposal submitted for 8th, 9th and 10th batch for increment of 60 YPs as per approved ROD for increment.
- Three (3) NOCs have been issued to YPs upon request.
- Two (2) work experience and relieving letters have been issued.
- Data on YPs up to September 2024, including details of existing YPs, those who have resigned or been terminated, those on long leave, and transfer data, has been compiled and shared with the NCS Coordination Team, DGE.

ACTIVITIES OF MODEL CAREER CENTRE, NICS

The Ministry of Labour & Employment has established a few Model Career Centres (MCCs) that operate directly under the supervision of the Ministry. One such MCC was approved at the National Institute for Career Services (NICS), since its establishment, MCC NICS has been dedicated to effectively implementing employment services. It organizes job fairs, supports jobseekers making informed career decisions by providing comprehensive employment-related information, conducts career talks and seminars, offers career guidance and counseling, and provides employability training.

Key activities at MCC NICS include facilitating the registration of job seekers, employers, and other stakeholders on the NCS portal, conducting job fairs and placement drives, offering individual and group career guidance sessions, organizing workshops and orientation programs to raise awareness about NCS, creating video success stories of beneficiaries, and hosting webinars on new and emerging job roles to provide essential career insights and guidance.

From July 2024 MCC has initiated a new program career cum job fairs. The aim of these events is to offer students in their 1st and 2nd years of study a comprehensive understanding of various career paths and job opportunities available to them. Through these fairs, students can explore potential career options, interact with professionals from different industries, and gain valuable insights into the skills and qualifications required for their desired fields. This initiative seeks to empower students with the knowledge and resources they need to make informed decisions about their future careers.

Organizing Job Fairs/Placement Drives



As mentioned above from July 2024 NICS has launched an initiative to conduct career cum job fairs in order to provide 1st & 2nd year students with a better perspective on future career opportunities.

Outreach Activities

Outreach activities conducted by the Model Career Centres (MCCs) aim to increase awareness about the NCS Portal, identify potential job seekers, and build relationships with employers. These activities include collaborating with employers, establishing industry partnerships to identify job vacancies and training needs, organizing skill development programs to enhance employability, and conducting awareness campaigns to educate the jobseekers about career options and MCC services. Additionally, MCCs use digital outreach through social media and online platforms to reach a broader audience.

These efforts contribute to a robust ecosystem supporting employment and skill development in the region. For job seekers, these activities enhance employability through skill development programs and career counseling, increase awareness about career options, provide direct access to potential employers through job fairs and placement drives, and boost confidence through workshops and counseling sessions, making them more assertive in job interviews. Overall, the outreach activities of MCCs have a significant impact on both job seekers and employers, positively influencing the employment landscape.
