BACKGROUND NOTE ON NCSCs for DA


The Government of India, Ministry of Labour & Employment, Directorate General of Employment has established 24 National Career Service Centres for Differently Abled (earlier known as Vocational Rehabilitation Centres for Handicapped) with a view to evaluate the residual capacities and provide the rehabilitation services to persons with disabilities irrespective of their educational backgrounds and as per benchmark disabilities. The Centres also provide vocational guidance, career counselling, non-formal vocational training and extend referral services. Also conduct outreach activities and assist PwDs in the process of vocational rehabilitation. The Centres impart in-house training to PwD candidates in various trades. During the training, the PwD candidates get stipendiary support of Rs. 2500/- per month through DBT-MIS portal. The PwD candidates are also assisted in the process of economic rehabilitation through job fairs, distribution of aids and appliances, loan release etc. The Centres are being managed by their own standard sanctioned resources.

Job Fairs

NCSCs for DA organize Job Fairs and career events. During the month, 1865 candidates and 182 employers participated in 37 Job Fairs organized by the Centres. Glimpses of some of the major Job Fairs are:



NCSC for DA, Chennai

National Career Service Centre for DA, Chennai organized 3 job fairs with 28 employers. A total number of 322 job seekers participated in the job fairs, out of which 171 candidates were shortlisted.

NCSC for DA, Patna

National Career Service Centre for DA, Patna organized a job fair with 47 employers. A total number of 252 job seekers participated in the job fair, out of which 94 candidates were shortlisted.



NCSC for DA, Bengaluru

National Career Service Centre for DA, Bengaluru organized 2 job fairs with 4 employers. A total number of 96 job seekers participated in the job fairs, out of which 24 candidates were shortlisted.



NCSC for DA, Puducherry

Vikili Assumi, a young woman with 100% visual impairment, hails from a humble background. Despite the challenges she faced, she joined training program in the Secretarial Practice trade. Her dedication and perseverance bore fruit when she secured a position with the Nagaland Social Justice Department under the Samagra Shiksha project. In addition to her job, Vikili now manages and provides guidance at the Thikava Centre, a facility dedicated to empowering visually impaired individuals.



Ludhiana:

My name is Surinder Singh. I am 37 years old. My disability percentage is 60%. My educational qualification is 5th grade. I received one year of training in Dress Making from the National Career Service Centre, Ludhiana for the Differently Abled . After the training, I was provided with a sewing machine free of cost. With this sewing machine, I started my work in sewing men's clothes.



Puducherry:

Miss. R. Narmada, D/o E. Ragupathy aged 26 years is a Locomotor disabled person with 90% disability. Miss. R. Narmada registered with NCSC for DA, Puducherry in the year 2024. She was recommended for Wage Paid Employment through NCSC for DA, Puducherry, at Integra Software Pvt. Ltd., Puducherry. She was selected as Incoming Inspection Trainee and presently undergoing 3 months training programme at Integra Software Pvt. Ltd. and living a positive life with dignity.



Ranchi:

Mr. Mukesh Kumar, S/o Meghan admitted in Consumer Electronics Trade at NCSC for DA, Ranchi. During training suitable Guidance and Counselling was rendered to him by the Centre. He has opened his own general store.

NCSC for DA, Shillong


