# BACKGROUND NOTE ON NCSCS for DA

The Government of India, Ministry of Labour & Employment, Directorate General of Employment has established 24 National Career Service Centres for Differently Abled (earlier known as Vocational Rehabilitation Centres for Handicapped) with a view to evaluate the residual capacities and provide the rehabilitation services to persons with disabilities irrespective of their educational backgrounds and as per benchmark disabilities. The Centres also provide vocational guidance, career counselling, non-formal vocational training and extend referral services. Also conduct outreach activities and assist PwDs in the process of vocational rehabilitation. The Centres impart in-house training to PwD candidates in various trades. During the training, the PwD candidates get stipendiary support of Rs. 2500/- per month through DBT-MIS portal. The PwD candidates are also assisted in the process of economic rehabilitation through job fairs, distribution of aids and appliances, loan release etc. The Centres are being managed by their own standard sanctioned resources.



# **Job Fairs**

NCSCs for DA organize Job Fairs and career events. During the month, 1969 candidates and 179 employers participated in 39 Job Fairs organized by the Centres. Glimpses of some of the major Job Fairs are:

# NCSC for DA, Bhubaneshwar

National Career Service Centre for DA, Bhubaneshwar organized 3 Job Fairs with 22 Employers. A total of 226 candidates participated in the Job Fairs, out of which 118 candidates were shortlisted.

# **NCSC for DA, Delhi**

National Career Service Centre for DA, Delhi organized 2 Job Fairs with 6 Employers. A total of 192 candidates participated in the Job Fairs, out of which 87 candidates were shortlisted.



# NCSC for DA, Mumbai

National Career Service Centre for SC/ST, Delhi organized 2 Job Fairs with 20 Employers. A total of 217 candidates participated in the Job Fairs, out of which 64 candidates were shortlisted.







# NCSC for DA, Hyderabad

National Career Service Centre for DA, Hyderabad organized a Job Fair with 12 Employers. A total of 167 candidates participated in the Job Fair, out of which 12 candidates were shortlisted.

# NCSC for DA, Chennai

National Career Service Centre for DA, Chennai organized 2 Job Fairs with 11 Employers. A total of 126 candidates participated in the Job Fairs, out of which 43 candidates were shortlisted



# NCSC for DA, Ahmedabad




