BACKGROUND NOTE ON NCSC-DAS

"

The Government of India, Ministry of Labour & Employment, Directorate General of Employment has established 24 National Career Service Centres for Differently Abled (earlier known as Vocational Rehabilitation Centres for Handicapped) with a view to evaluate the residual capacities and provide the rehabilitation services to persons with disabilities irrespective of their educational backgrounds and as per benchmark disabilities. The Centres also provide vocational guidance and career counselling, non-formal vocational training, extend referral services. Also conduct outreach activities, and assists PwDs in the process of vocational rehabilitation. The Centres impart in-house training to PwD candidates in various trades. During the training, the PwD candidates get stipendiary support of Rs. 2500/- per month through DBT-MIS portal. The PwD candidates are also assisted in the process of economic rehabilitation through job fairs, distribution of aids and appliances, loan release etc. " The Centre is being managed by its own standard sanctioned resources".



Job Fair / Placement Drive

NCSC-DA organizes Job Fairs and career events. During this month, 1506 candidates and 98 employers participated in 36 Job Fairs organized by the centers. Glimpses of some of the major Job Fairs are:



NCSC for DA, DELHI National Career Service Centre for Differently Abled, Delhi organized 2 Job fairs with 6

Abled, Delhi organized 2 Job fairs with 6 Employers. In the Job fair 192 candidates participated in the interview, out of which 87 candidates were shortlisted/ placed.

NCSC for DA, DEHRADUN

Due to which I started earning and the financial condition of my family also started improving. I would like to take this work forward in future. At present, I earn about Rs.8000-9000/- per month from this work. National Career Service Centre, Ludhiana has been a special contributor to my success.



MILI PRADHAN, NCSC for DA, BHUBANESWAR

"I am Mili Pradhan, daughter of Bhagaban Pradhan. A graduate Visual Impaired with 100% diability from Angul District. I am very happy and satisfied working at my current place of posting i.e Odisha Govt. High school. I am immensly thankful to NCSCDA, Bhubaneswar for guiding me through my journey and enabling me to secure this golden opportunity with a CTC of 2.6Lac P.A. Earlier my society vied me as disabled and a burden on my family but with this opportunity I have proved myself to be the strength of my family. in future I wish to be an example to others like me."

She received effective training exposure and after training , she started her self-employment venture by running a Typing and Net centre near to her residence. At present she is earning an amount of Rs. 15000/- per month and living a positive life with dignity and supporting her Family.

2)Sh.G. Iyyanar, aged 36 years is a Locomotor disabled person with 90% disability. He has passed ITI(Turner) . He hails from a lower middle-class family . G. Iyyanar has been registered with NCSC for DA, Puducherry in the year 2022 and after evaluation he was admitted for Skill training in Consumer Electronics trade, w.e.f 01/09/2022. He was regular and punctual during training and completed the course by 31/08/2023 . He received effective training exposure and after training he is recommended for Wage Paid Employment through NCSC for DA, Puducherry, at Worth Trust Industry, Puducherry he is working as Machine Operator and earning an amount of Rs19000/- per month and living a positive life with dignity and supporting his Family.





BANTEILANG SANGLYNE, NCSC for DA, SHILLONG

Banteilang Sanglyne, a locomoter disabled person from Umpling, Mylliem, District-East Khasi Hills, Meghalaya. After thorough evaluation, he was admitted in the Computer Application Trade in the year 2022-23. He had appeared in many competitive examination, interviews but could not get success. After being enrolled in NCSC-DA, Shillong, the Instructor of the said trade helped him to learn MS-Office, Internet, Adobe Photoshop etc.This in turn results in enhancing his knowledge on Computer. Besides this, the Motivational as well as leadership quality classes taken by the Head of Office along with other staff helped him to boost his cofidence. The centre further helped him to apply for the post of MTS in the District Legal Service Authority, Shillong, Govt. of Meghalaya and he got selected.Now the entire family members are very happy for his success and extended their thankfulness to the entire NCSC-DA team for the support and guidance in shaping his career.


