
BACKGROUND NOTE ON NCSC-DAS

The Government of India, Ministry of Labour & Employment, Directorate General of Employment has established 24 National Career Service Centres for Differently Abled (earlier known as Vocational Rehabilitation Centres for Handicapped) with a view to evaluate the residual capacities and provide the rehabilitation services to persons with disabilities irrespective of their educational backgrounds and as per benchmark disabilities. The Centres also provide vocational guidance, career counselling, non-formal vocational training and extend referral services. Also conduct outreach activities, and assists PwDs in the process of vocational rehabilitation. The Centres impart in-house training to PwD candidates in various trades. During the training, the PwD candidates get stipendiary support of Rs. 2500/- per month through DBT-MIS portal. The PwD candidates are also assisted in the process of economic rehabilitation through job fairs, distribution of aids and appliances, loan release etc. The Centre is being managed by their own standard sanctioned resources.

Job Fairs

NCSCs for DA organize job fairs and career events. During the month, 2745 candidates and 224 employers participated in 61 job fairs organized by the Centres. Glimpses of some of the major job fairs are:



NCSC for DA, Bhubaneshwar


