#### **ADDITIONAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES**

#### 2341. SMT. MAUSAM B NOOR:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether additional employment opportunities have been created in the country as a result of development schemes implemented during the last five years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of number of unemployed persons as per Government's record during the last five years and areas in which jobs have been created under the National Urban Youth Employment Programmes launched by Government to promote employment generation in rural and urban areas?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

(a) to (c): Employment generation coupled with improving employability is a priority of the Government. Accordingly, Government is implementing various employment generation schemes/ programmes in the country. These inter-alia include Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), Rural Self Employment and Training Institutes (RSETIs), Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM), Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY), etc. The details of various employment generation schemes/programmes being implemented by the Government may be seen at https://dge.gov.in/dge/schemes\_programmes

The employment generated through select schemes of Central Government across the State/UT for the last five years is at Annexure.

The official data source on Employment and Unemployment is Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) which is conducted by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) since 2017-18. The survey period is July to June every year. As per the data available in latest Annual PLFS Reports, the estimated Unemployment Rate (UR) on usual status for person of age 15 years and above years during the year 2019-20 to 2023-24 are as follows:
