the details of the pattern of rural employment in the country in terms of primary, secondary and tertiary sectors of employment, gender and Statewise particularly in Tamil Nadu?

ANSWER

The official data on Employment and Unemployment is collected through Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) which is conducted by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) since 2017-18.

As per the latest available Annual PLFS reports, the estimated Worker Population Ratio (WPR), indicating employment, on usual status for persons of age 15 years & above in rural areas in the country and in Tamil Nadu during 2019-20 to 2023-24 are as follow:

The data indicates that the employment in rural areas has increasing trend over the years. The estimated WPR, indicating employment, in rural areas has increased from 53.3% in 2019-20 to 62.1% in 2023-24. Also, in Tamil Nadu, WPR has increased from 59.8% to 63.1% during the same period.
