**(a) to (b): The Aatmanirbhar Bharat Rojgar Yojana (ABRY) was launched with effect from 1st October, 2020 to incentivize employers for creation of new employment and restoration of loss of employment during Covid-19 pandemic. The terminal date for registration of beneficiaries was 31.03.2022. As on 05.12.2023, an amount of Rs. 10,043.02 crore has been disbursed to 60.49 lakh beneficiaries through 1.52 lakh establishments. The State-wise and sector-wise beneficiaries under the scheme is at Annexure-I & II, respectively.**
