## NICS: AN INTRODUCTION

The National Institute for Career Service (NICS) erstwhile Central Institute for Research and Training in Employment Service (CIRTES), was set up in October, 1964 under the Directorate General of Employment (DGE), M/o Labour & Employment with an aim of imparting Research & Training facilities in Employment Services. The Institute was later expanded in 1970 with additional function of publishing career literature and again in 1987 with added responsibility of occupational research & promotion of self-employment.

The Ministry is implementing the Employment Exchange Mission Mode Project under National e-Government plan (Ne-GP). Under this Project, NICS-NOIDA, has been designated as the nodal institute for capacity building.

NICS is responsible for imparting training to all stakeholders of National Career Service project like Employers, Job Seekers, Training Providers, College Students/ Counsellors/ Placement Organisations/Govt. Organisations etc and also imparting professional in-service training for officers of National Employment Services working in Central & State Govt.

NICS also plays a significant role in implementing the Young Professional Scheme of the Ministry of Labour and Employment and in coordinating the activities of Model Career Centres established across country under the NCS project. Since 2015 Model Career Center also functions under NICS, MCC approved under NCS Project of Ministry of Labour and Employment.

# OUR PROGRAMMES

National Institute for Career Service (NICS) being nodal institute for capacity building under NCS Project is organising training program for Employment Personnel on different areas of NCS. The training methods incorporate practical examples, presentations, group sessions, audio-visual slideshows, and modern management in an efficient manner. To enrich the efficiency of training programmes, external lecturers apart from the in-house Officers are also invited from the prestigious organizations of India. These training programmes comprises a wide array of subjects that range from Employment Market Information Service under NES & NCS, Labour Market Analysis, Career Counselling, etc. in collaboration with premier institutes like Indian Institute of Foreign Trade (Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Govt. of India), V.V. Giri National Labour Institute (Ministry of Labour & Employment, Govt. of India) etc. The aim of these training programmes is to update the knowledge and skills of Employment Personnel/Young Professionals. The training programmes helps them to understand the nature of employment market at various levels and the role of NCS in Employment Market/Labour Market related areas.

During the financial year 2023-2024, a total of **100** programs were approved. However, **107** programs were conducted, and **3813** participants attended the training programs by NICS Noida. Details of the conducted programs are as follows:

## Capacity Building Programmes for Employment Personnel

- 23 programmes conducted & 676 participants are trained

## Workshops For Employers, Counsellors & other stakeholders

- 20 Programmes are conducted & 279 participants are trained

## Orientation/ Seminars/ Webinars for Jobseekers

- 62 Programmes conducted & 2773 participants are trained

## Employability Training for Jobseekers

- 2 Employability Training programs conducted & 85 participants are trained

# PROGRAM

# CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMME

This is a comprehensive training program for newly recruited or promoted Employment Personnel provides an extensive understanding of the organization's functionalities and operational structure at different levels (Central, State, District, Rural). It introduces participants to the vision and mission of the NCS project and its flagship initiatives, and briefs them on relevant schemes such as the Apprenticeship training program, Entrepreneurship, Manpower planning, and ILO conventions. The course also covers the basic functionalities of the NCS Portal and MCC Management, ensuring officers are adept at using these tools to enhance the employment landscape and achieve a quality workforce.

Additionally, the program includes specialized training in various administrative matters, including GEM, E-Office, PFMS, GFR Rules, RTI, Administrative Vigilance, Roster Management, and Record Management. This training empowers officials to handle administrative tasks effectively, assess situations, identify gaps, and work towards resolutions.

The course also provides a fresh perspective on labor market analysis for employment personnel, Trade Unions, and NGOs, highlighting the friction between workforce entry opportunities, employability, labor competition, and associated time and cost factors. It underscores the significance of the NCSP.



Furthermore, the program focuses on Data Analysis and E-Governance, aiming to digitally empower the organization, enhance workforce efficiency, and align with current trends. Upskilling in E-Governance is emphasized as a step towards embracing the digital age and fostering a culture of growth and innovation.

The course also educates employment personnel on self-employment and Entrepreneurship Development, highlighting government initiatives and enabling participants to act as catalysts in these areas. Additionally, basic course in Career Counseling and Guidance is included, helping employment personnel facilitate informed decision-making for jobseekers by assessing their aptitude, personality, interests, and other relevant factors influencing career choices.

During FY 2023-2024, NICS has conducted 23 capacity-building programmes & 676 participants are trained under these programs.



# ORIENTATION/ SEMINAR/ WEBINAR/ WORKSHOPS/ CAREER GUIDANCE SESSIONS

This program is designed to raise awareness about the National Career Service Project and its role in providing employment, upskilling, and guidance opportunities for jobseekers and students. It aims to empower today's youth to make informed career choices and actively manage their career growth and future opportunities. The objective is to increase awareness about the National Career Service Project, the NCS Portal, and various free career-related services such as guidance and counseling available at Model Career Centres this can be delivered using lectures and presentation methods with the help of internal faculties and faculties from DGE.

Trainees will be nominated by Schools and Colleges, also all Jobseekers (data on NCS Portal or data collected by YP via outreach activity) will be intimated via mail or SMS about orientation programme.



The course covers topics including an overview of the NCS Portal and registration process, the importance of job fairs, career counseling using psychometric tests, skill development for jobseekers (both soft and hard skills), digital skills seminars, webinars on the gig economy and sustainability issues, career guidance on choosing a career path using the NCS Portal, effective resume building and skill mapping, future employment opportunities in the digital age, restarting a career after a gap, assessing employability skills and planning, the evolving landscape of green jobs, and the importance of skilling, reskilling, and upskilling. It also includes seminars on effective job hunting strategies.

During FY 2023-2024, NICS has conducted 62 orientation/workshops/career guidance Programmes & 2773 participants were trained under these programs.



# EMPLOYABILITY TRAINING/ SKILL GAP TRAINING

These training initiatives bridge the gap between job requirements and existing skills, empowering individuals with the competencies needed for workforce success. Through partnerships with industry, participants gain practical insights and relevant training, enhancing their employability in today's dynamic job market. The objective of Skill Gap Training and Employability Training with Industry is to equip individuals with the specific skills and knowledge demanded by employers, thereby increasing their readiness for the workforce. By collaborating with industry partners, these programs aim to reduce the gap between job requirements and available skill sets, ultimately boosting participants' employability and facilitating their successful integration into the labor market.



The training includes modules from programs like DigiSaksham (covering MS Excel, Power BI, Python, Azure, SQL, etc.), TCS-ion, and TCS YEP (focusing on Communicative English, corporate etiquette, resume building, interview skills, analytical and reasoning skills, and basic computer knowledge). The methodology involves classroom and computer lab training, targeting jobseekers and students, with instruction provided by both internal and industry faculty. The duration of the training is based on the schedule provided by the training providers or industry.

During FY 2023-2024, NICS has conducted 2 Employability Training programs & 85 participants are trained under these programs.

## Introduction

For supporting the professional assistance requirement of Model Career centres approved the MoLE, the Ministry launched a Scheme for Young Professionals with an aim to utilize the knowledge, energy and fresh way of thinking of these young social leaders to help better transform the emerging landscape of Employment Services and Career counselling in India. Young Professional are being deputed to these Model Career Centres to facilitate the integration and institutionalization of new processes. One of the major role of NICS Noida is the conceptualization and implementation of the Young Professional Scheme of the National Career Service Project of M/o Labor and Employment. Which includes Recruitment, Deployment, capacity building and disbursement of remuneration & grant of increments, conducting PAB meetings for contract extensions for all YPs posted across India.

## YP Recruitment & Deployment of YPs across India

Since 2015, NICS Noida has conducted 10 recruitment drives. During FY 2023-2024 total 1 YP recruitment drives were conducted, in which 2 thousand 4 hundred and 10 candidates have applied for the position of young professionals out of which 555 candidates were shortlisted for further recruitment process and selected 54 candidates. Finally, 38 candidates have joined as young professionals under the NCS project.


