NICS: An Introduction



The **National Institute for Career Service** (NICS) erstwhile Central Institute for Research and Training in Employment Service (CIRTES), was set up in October, 1964 under the Directorate General of Employment (DGE), M/o Labour & Employment with an aim of imparting Research & Training facilities in Employment Services. The Institute was later expanded in 1970 with additional function of publishing career literature and again in 1987 with added responsibility of occupational research & promotion of self-employment.

The Ministry is implementing the Employment Exchange Mission Mode Project under National e-Government plan (Ne-GP). Under this Project, NICS-NOIDA, has been designated as the nodal institute for capacity building. NICS is responsible for imparting training to all stakeholders of National Career Service project like Employers, Job Seekers, Training Providers, College Students/ Counsellors/ Placement Organisations/Govt. Organisations etc and also imparting professional in-service training for officers of National Employment Services working in Central & State Govt.

NICS also plays a significant role in implementing the Young Professional Scheme of the Ministry of Labour and Employment and in coordinating the activities of Model Career Centres established across country under the NCS project.

Our Programmes

National Institute for Career Service (NICS) being nodal institute for capacity building under NCSP is organising training program for Employment Personnel on different areas of NCS. The training methods incorporate practical examples, presentations, group sessions, audio-visual slideshows, and modern management in an efficient manner. To enrich the efficiency of training programmes, external lecturers apart from the in-house Officers are also invited from the prestigious organizations of India. These training programmes comprises a wide array of subjects that range from Employment Market Information Service under NES & NCS, Labour Market Analysis, Career Counselling, etc. in collaboration with premier institutes like Indian Institute of Foreign Trade (Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Govt. of India), V.V. Giri National Labour Institute (Ministry of Labour & Employment, Govt. of India) etc. The aim of these training programmes is to update the knowledge and skills of Employment Personnel/Young Professionals. The training programmes helps them to understand the nature of employment market at various levels and the role of NCS in Employment Market/Labour Market related areas.

A total of 100 programs have been proposed during the financial year 2022-2023, however, total 102 programs have been conducted & 5837 participants attended the training programs by NICS Noida. Details of conducted programme is as below:



I. Capacity Building Programme:

The aim of Capacity Building program is to strengthen the Employment Personnels capacity with all features of NCS portal and to make them understand the important role being played by NCS portal in NCS project & to update the knowledge and skills of employment personnel on fast changing Labour market dynamics


III. Employability Training/ Skill Gap Training:

Implementation of YP Scheme

For supporting the professional assistance requirement of Model Career centres approved the MoLE, the Ministry launched a Scheme for Young Professionals with an aim to utilize the knowledge, energy and fresh way of thinking of these young social leaders to help better transform the emerging landscape of Employment Services and Career counselling in India. Young Professional are being deputed to these Model Career Centres to facilitate the integration and institutionalization of new processes. One of the major role of NICS Noida is the conceptualization and implementation of the Young Professional Scheme of the National Career Service Project of M/o Labor and Employment. Which includes Recruitment, Deployment, capacity building and disbursement of remuneration & grant of increments, conducting PAB meetings for contract extensions for all YPs posted across India.


I. YP Recruitment & Development of YPs across India: Since 2015, NICS Noida has conducted 9 recruitment drives. During FY 2022-2023 total 4 YP recruitment drives were conducted, in which more than 30 thousand candidates have applied for the position of young professionals out of which 3425 candidates were shortlisted for further recruitment process and selected 437 candidates. Finally, 332 candidates have joined as young professionals under the NCS project.


Steps of YP Recruitment Process




6th Round Recruitment Stats




7th Round Recruitment Stats



8th Round Recruitment Stats





II. YP Coordination & Communication:

1. Joining formalities of newly joined YPs (Collection of Joining report, medical certificate, police verification certificate & other documents, sending Attendance format, Monthly/ daily report forms/ training material/ ID card format, KPIs to YPs & centre manager of MCCs)
2. Preparation of Personal File of 300+ YPs
3. Handling queries of field YPs on daily basis via mail/call & WhatsApp regrading KPIs, Remuneration, trainings, transfers, resignations, NOC, work experience certificate, reliving letters, issues they are facing at their MCCs etc.
4. Handling calls received from and Centre Managers/ Nodal Officers of MCCs regarding YPs & functioning of MCCs.
5. Maintaining various list in respect of YPs & MCCs such as list of all YPs along with their relevant contact details & place of posting, list of MCCs with (Address, contact details of Nodal officer & centre manager), list of MCCs with the remaining period etc
6. Tailor made Reports as an when required by DGE & NICS Officers such as weekly/ monthly/Annual activity report of NICS Noida, YP related data, MCC related data, any state specific data, etc.
7. Contract Extension YPs & Performance appraisal board etc.


YPs Deployed Across India



YP Monitoring: Performance of Young Professionals deployed in Model Career Centres across the country under National Career service Project is monitored by NICS, Noida on a daily and monthly basis. Performance reports of YPs are regularly maintained, analysed and submitted to higher authorities. Along with this, Young Professionals are sent advisories from time to time, which is based on their performance. Regular meetings are arranged with the YPs on the issues being faced in the State such as meeting for issues raised by Jammu & Kashmir's YPs regarding the KPIs, issues raised by Odisha's YPs regarding submitting reports to state directorate, meeting for under performer YPs to discuss the corrective action plan in order to improve the performance etc.


NICS HOSTEL BLOCK
